MEMORANDUM FOR: JAPANESE GOVERNMENT

SUBJECT: First, Third and Fifth Supplemental Requests for  
Permission to Use Precious Metals for Domestic  
Consumption in the Second Quarter of 1948

1. Reference is made to:

2. Application for permission to use pigment containing gold and  
silver, as requested by reference 1a above, is approved, as altered, in  
the amounts and by the companies listed below. Pigment from stocks in  
the pooled reserve under custody of the Ministry of Finance will be drawn  
upon to supply the amounts authorized. The firms listed may be used to  
further process the pigment as noted:

The Tokuriki Honten is authorized to process the released metals into proper commercial forms.

4. Application for permission to use liquid gold, as requested by reference 1c above, is approved, as altered, in the amounts and by the companies listed below. Liquid gold stocks in the pooled reserve under custody of the Ministry of Finance will be drawn upon to supply the amounts authorized.
