## INTRODUCTION

Wiki for Minorities was founded in October 2023. The group was founded to help close one big gap in Wikimedia projects: promoting the expressions on tangible and intangible heritage of the minority groups, including people with disabilities, religious, cultural and ethnic minorities, as well as the diaspora communities. We also partner with communities and institutions to train people from these communities as Wikimedians.

## OUR APPROACH

We organise various activities to promote the aforementioned minority groups by organising many activities: Photo contests, like that which happened in 2024 in the Arabic community, editathons, and various other activities such as collaborations with cultural institutions.

## OUR ACTIVITIES

The Wiki for Minorities has engaged with various communities and groups since its inception. Among others we organised the Arab contest in August and September 2024, capturing photos on disabilities in the Arab world.

In 27 March 2024, the first ever workshop-online activity for the Greeks in Germany took place.

Other activities, such as the Fulani project have been organised by WfMin. We have been providing support to the Fulani community, by supporting them with organising events and their strategic planning.

Meanwhile, the project supports the growth of content about disability, religious and ethnic minorities, while supporting minority languages to grow.
