# Background

— — —

- Some of our coolest ideas *(and current code)* for the Wikipedia Portal rely heavily on JavaScript

e.g.



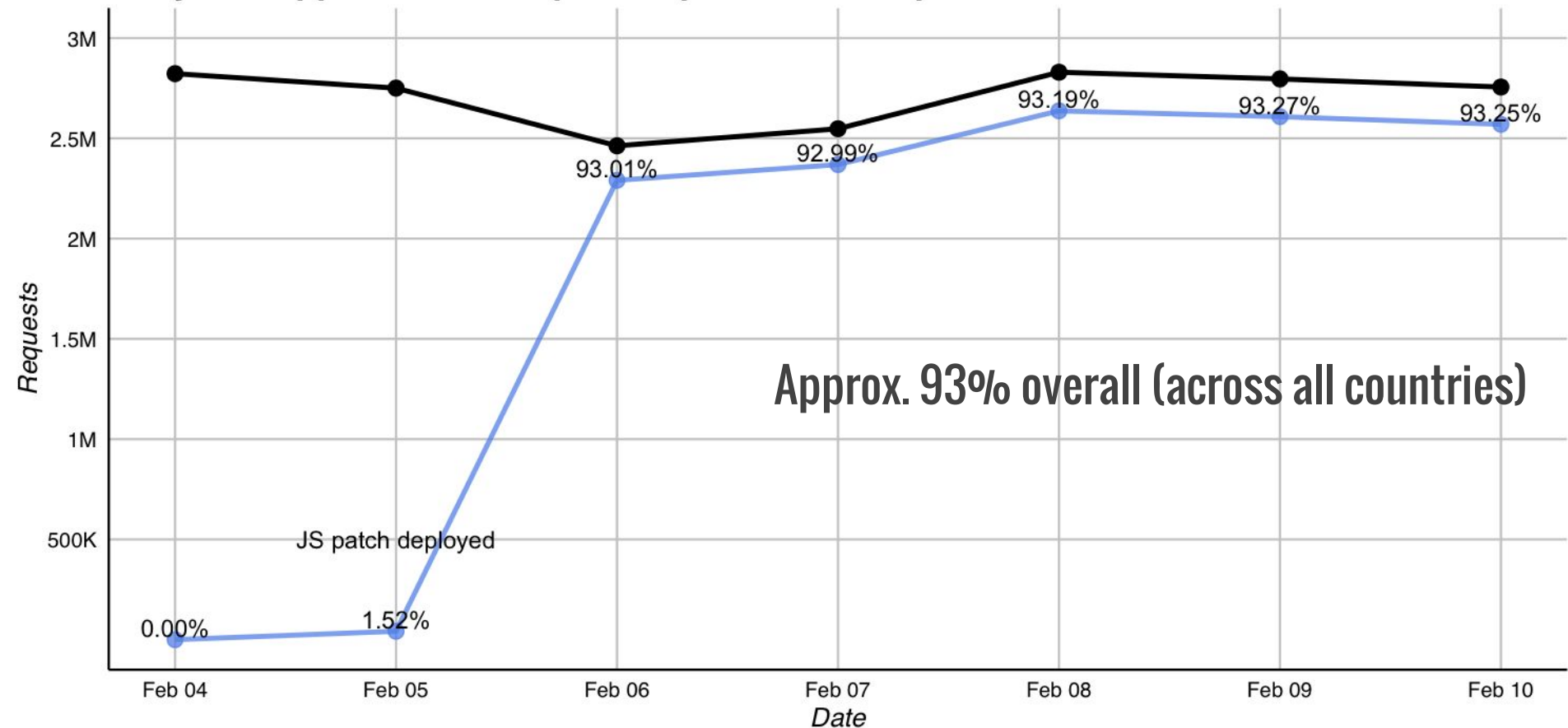
- All the JavaScript (JS) that was used previously on the Portal was source code (“inline”)
- We deployed a [patch](#) on 5 Feb 2016 to move all inline JS into a separate, trackable file
- We used the Wikipedia Wordmark ( **WIKIPEDIA** ) as reference point for analysis
- These findings cover web request logs from 5 Feb 2016 to 10 Feb 2016
  - *To track how many visitors downloaded the JS file and how many viewed the Wordmark image*

# JavaScript (JS) Support

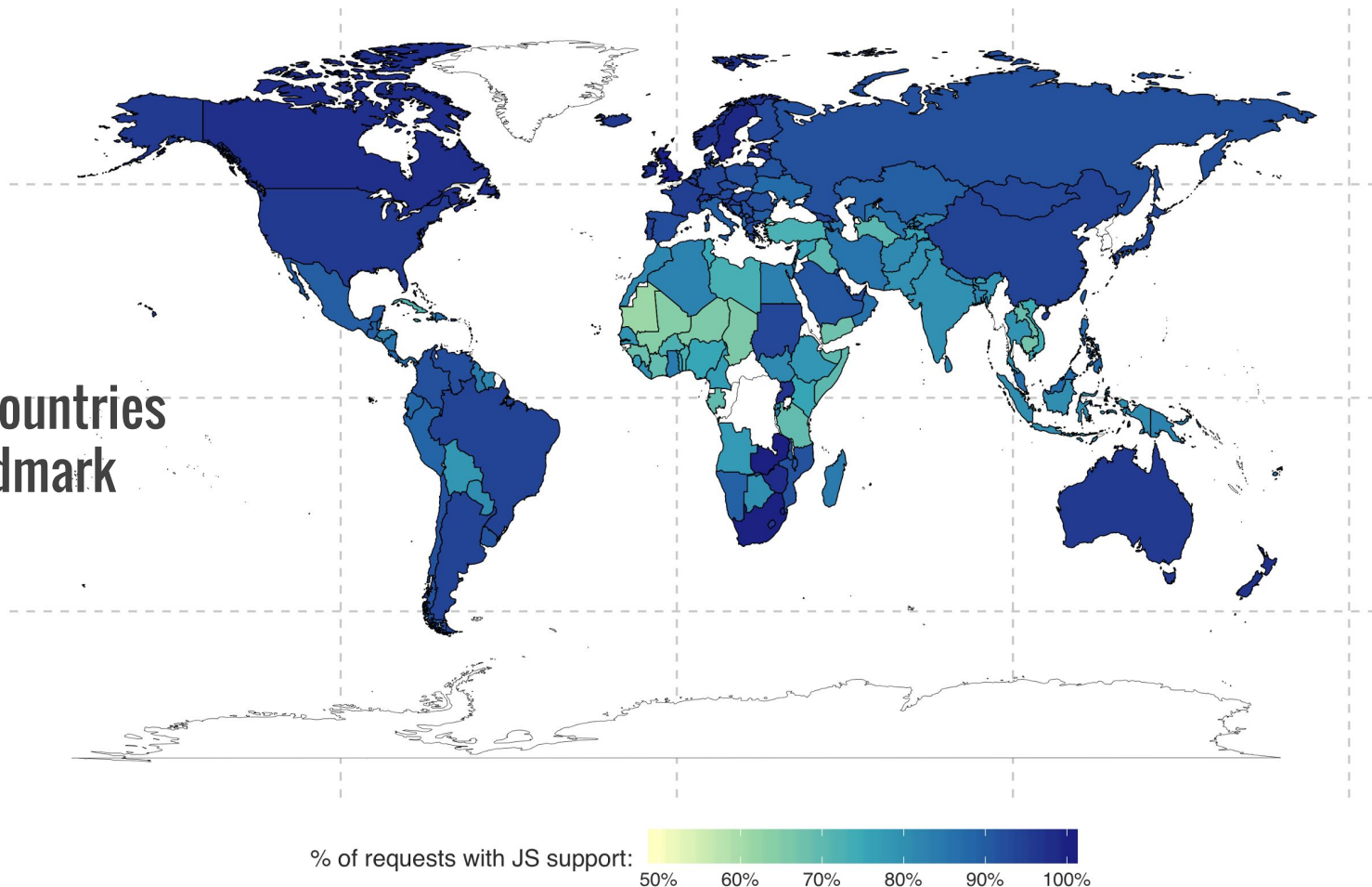

- | Min %  | 25th Percentile | Average % | Median % | 75th Percentile | 99th Percentile |

| 50.00% | 81.09%          | 86.53%    | 88.35%   | 93.77%          | 100.00%         |

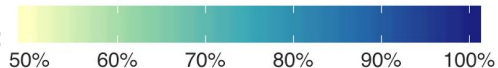
- Overall, 93% of the Wikipedia.org Portal browser requests support JS
  - USA accounts for 45% of the total traffic (with 95% JS browser support)
- 14 of 17 (82%) of the browsers surveyed had more than 93% JS support
  - In other words: less than 7% of those browsers' users had purposely turned off JS
  - Reasons for turning off JS include privacy / tracking concerns and bandwidth conservation



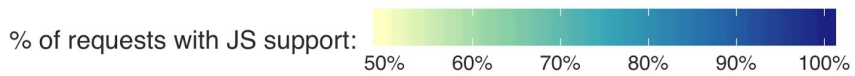
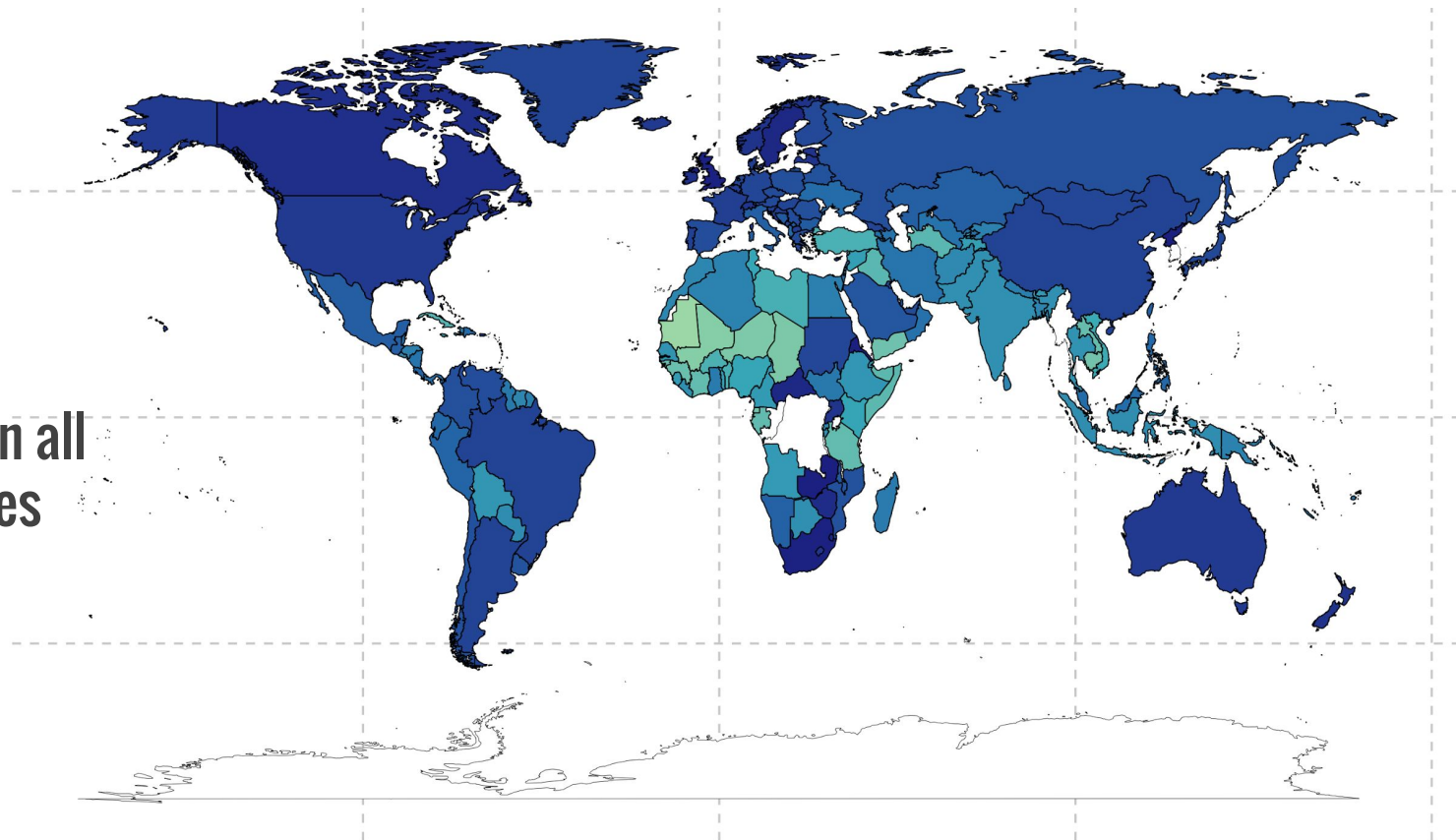
## JS support in countries with >100 Wordmark requests

# JS support in all 235 countries

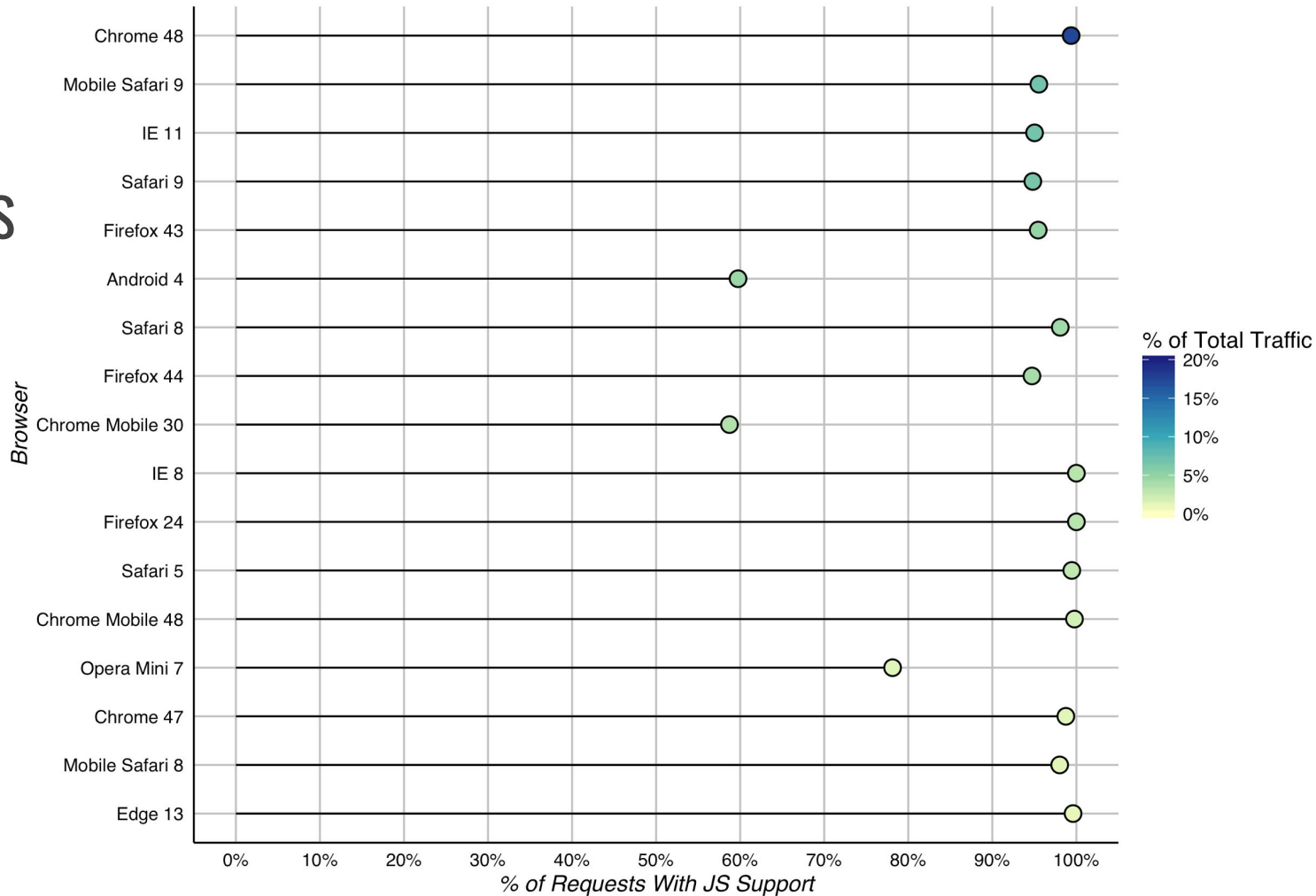


**Which browsers do Wikipedia.org Portal users use the most frequently?**

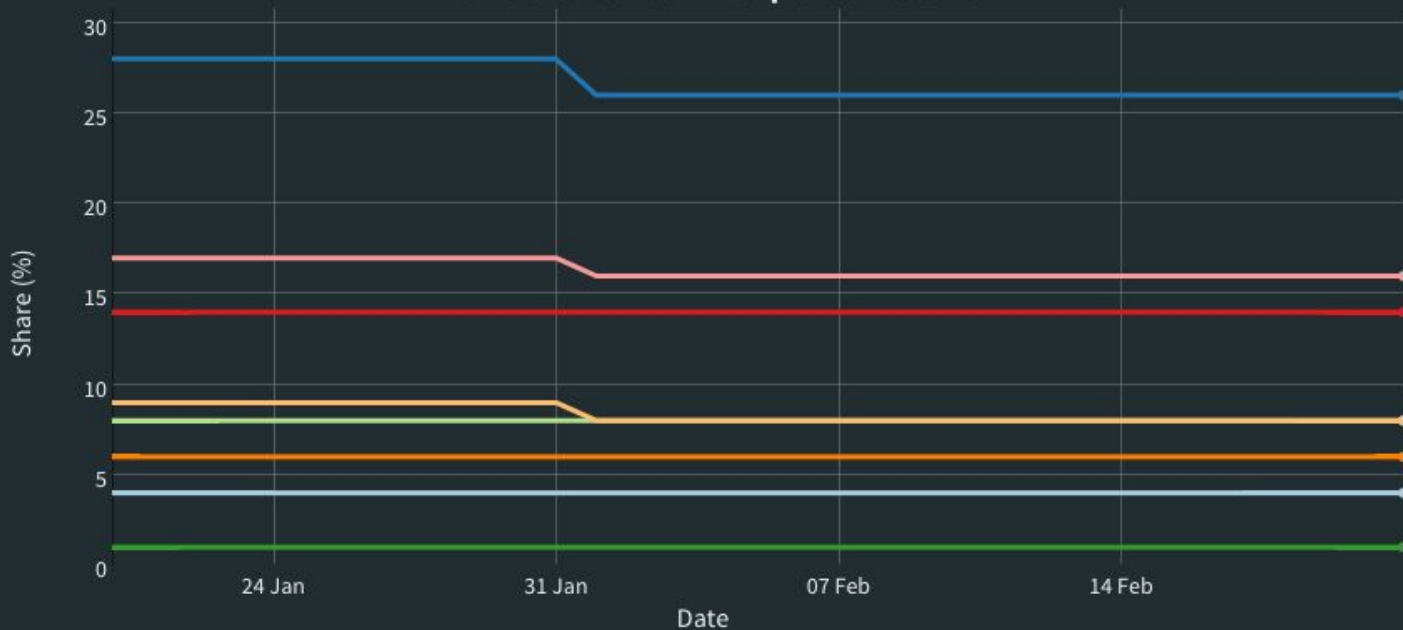

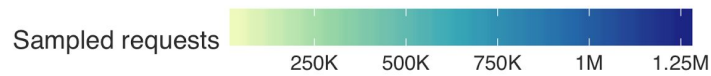
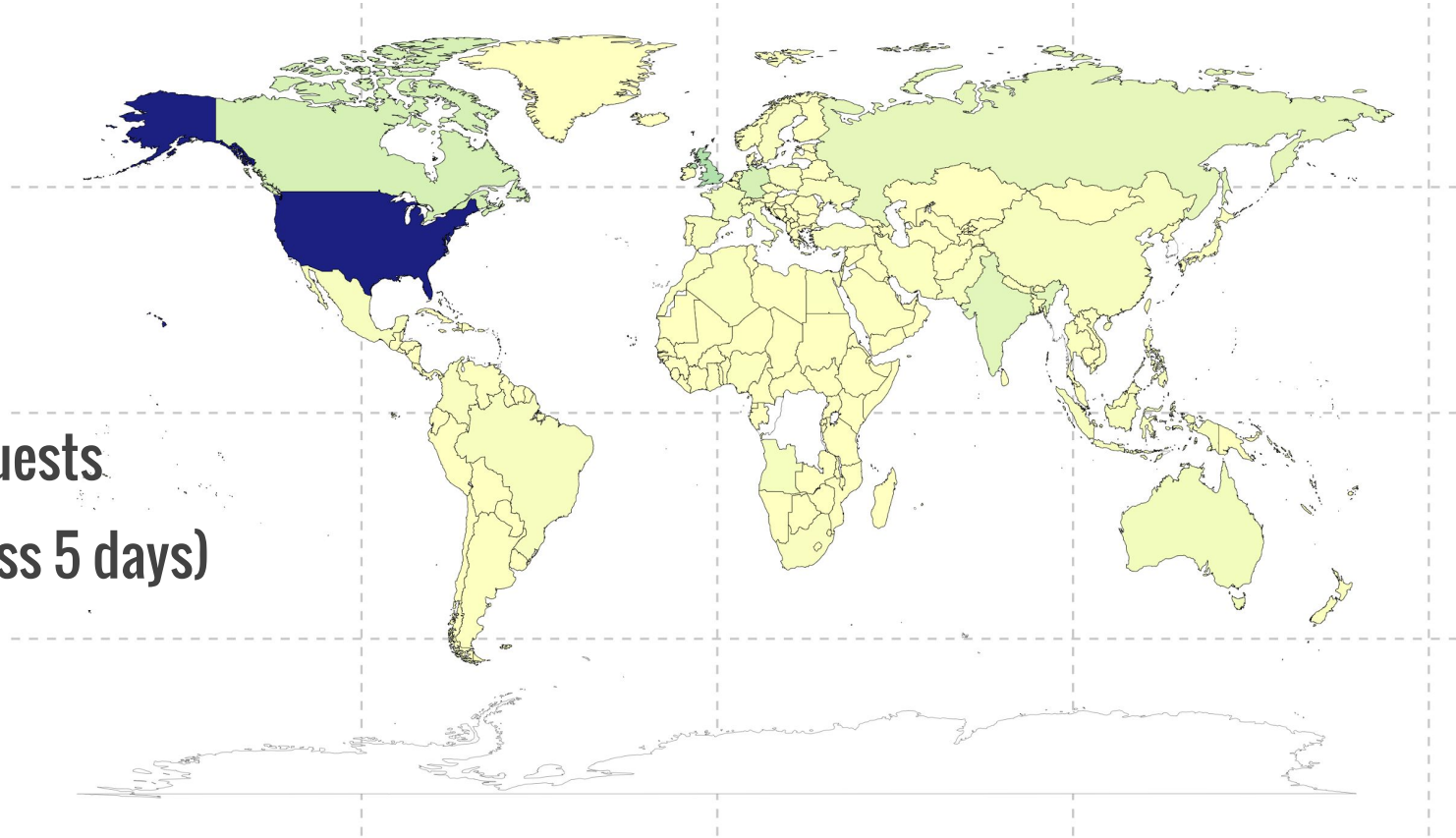

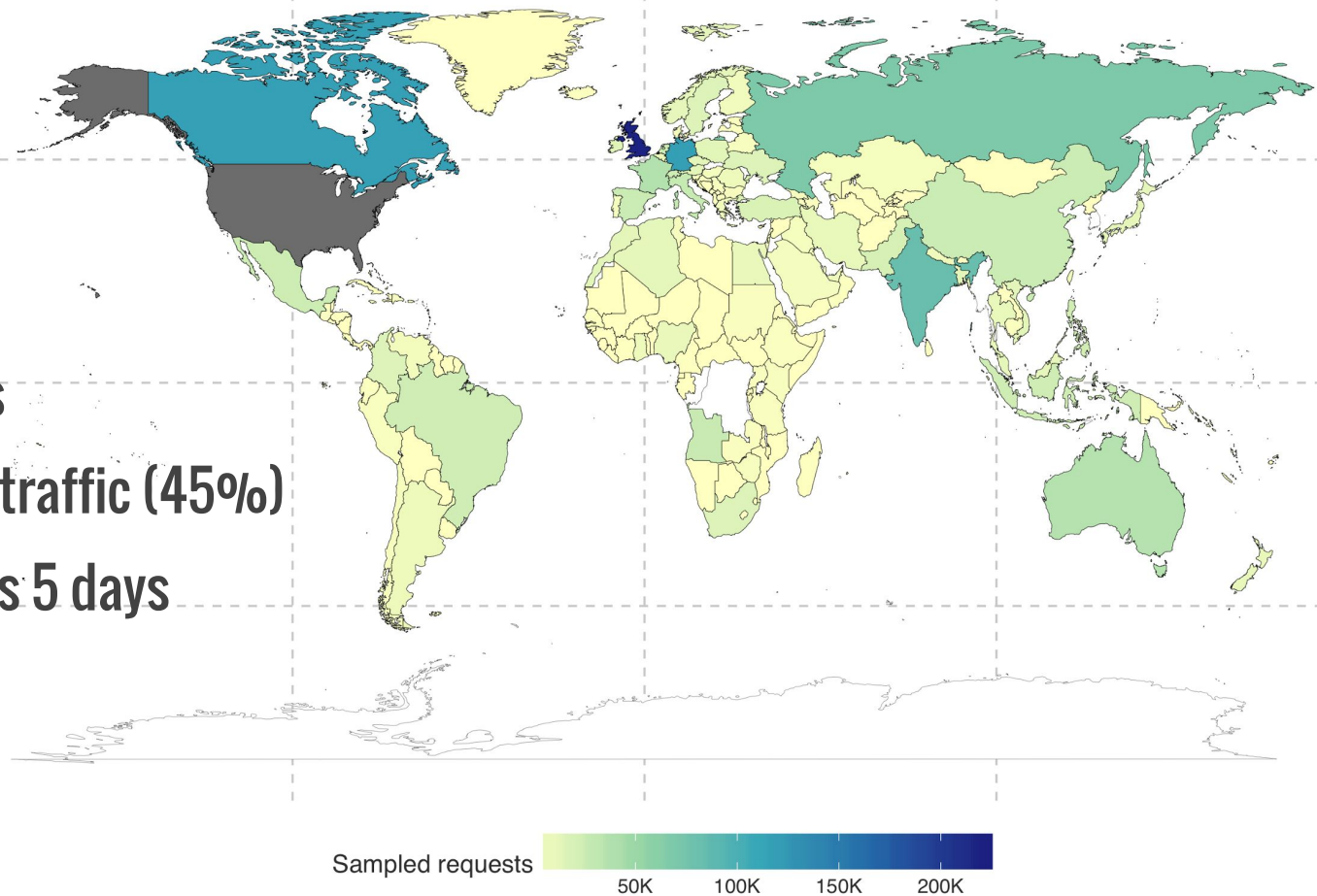


# Sampled requests (median across 5 days)
