- KEY POINTS:**
- Our community often is the one that "ISOLATE" itself: the broader community wants things from us, and we don't talk.
  - FRENCH WIKISOURCE does not put WIKILINKS on WIKISOURCE.
  - One of the BIGGEST VALUE of WIKISOURCE is ACCURACY (YOU CAN CHECK THE ORIGINAL SCAN). THE OTHER ONE is the POSSIBILITY to connect with other AUTHORS, BOOKS and PROJECTS.
  - WIKIMEDIA CANADA has a strong relationship with the NATIONAL ARCHIVES: archivists there CONTRIBUTE with 100s of pages per day.
  - CZECH REPUBLIC libraries could feel WS as "impetition": WS, in reality, should be a PARTNERSHIP.
  - Libraries (GLAMs) often think "PEOPLE SHOULD COME TO MY WEBSITE".
  - If we want to build "THE SUM OF ALL HUMAN KNOWLEDGE", we need a LIBRARY.

### CONCLUSIONS/RECOMMENDATIONS/ACTIONS (IF ANY):

- WORK MORE WITH GLAMs
- ADVOCATE FOR MORE DEVELOPMENT: WIKISOURCE can be a PLATFORM. It's NOT right now.
