Teresa Gilmore, am archaeologist and finds liaison officer for Staffordshire and West Midlands based at Birmingham Museums, said : "This is an amazing find. The beauty of the Portable Antiquities Scheme is that people are finding stuff that keeps rewriting our history.

"This particular find has given us a new insight into early medieval activity in Coventry, which we still need to make sense of. Each find like this helps in filling in our jigsaw puzzle and gives us a bit more information."

When Senior sent her some photographs, she immediately saw its potential. She contacted Katherine Forsyth, professor of Celtic Studies at the University of Glasgow, who confirmed that it was an ogham script, that of an early style, which most likely dates to the fifth to sixth century but possibly as early as the fourth century.

Gilmore said such stones were "very rare and have generally been found in Ireland or Scotland ... so to find them in the Midlands is actually unusual."

She suggested it could be linked to people coming over from Ireland or to early medieval monasteries in the area. "You would have had monks and clerics moving between the different monasteries."

The stone, which is 11cm long and weighs 139g, is inscribed on three of its four sides.

Its purpose is unclear, said Gilmore, adding: "It could have been a portable commemorative item. We don't know. It's an amazing little thing."

Explaining its inscription, "Maldumcail/ S/ Lass", Gilmore said: "The first part relates to a person's name, Mael Dumcail. The second part is less certain. We're not sure where the S/ Lass comes from. It is probably a location. So something like 'had me made'."

### THE NEWSPAPER ARTICLE GIVES SOME INFORMATION, HOWEVER ...

"The angle with the most ogham stokes has what looks like **MOULDUMEAIL**. However, it makes more sense to read it as **MAELDUMCAIL** or perhaps **MAELDUMEAIL** - the problem is that the exact position of the stemline is uncertain and the vowel strokes are long like the consonant strokes. The initial M looks quite different to the other strokes (also slants the opposite direction to the other M) and may just be damage to the stone (hence the underdot in transcription).

On two other angles: S LASS

This could of course also be read the opposite direction."

### ... TRUST IN THE ARCHAEOLOGICAL EXPERTS.

The adjective **máel** (<u>https://dil.ie/31242</u>) 'crop-headed, shorn, tonsured' is a commonly found first element in early Irish (religious) personal names (examples here <u>https://dil.ie/31244</u>).

However, the second element **-dumeail** or **-dumcail** isn't clear. **Dumeail** is reminiscent of **DUMELEDONAS** (CIIC 368), **DUMELI** (CIIC 252), **DDUMILEAS** (CIIC 198) in ogham inscriptions, but the meaning is unknown and the element doesn't seem to be attested in later manuscript sources.

It's hard to say much about S and LASS but the sequence lass- is found in some later inscriptions, e.g. lassa·ndernad "for whom it has been made" (<u>https://emili.celt.dias.ie/LOU-001</u>).

There are also names that begin **lass**-, e.g. **Lassar** 'flame, fire' (<u>https://dil.ie/29600</u> or <u>https://www.dib.ie/biography/lassar-a4690</u>).









### Dumeledonas (Language: Goidelic; Gender: male)

Rhys/1907, 80--81: 'The name Dumeledo, genitive Dumeledonas, claims kinship with Dumelus of the stone at Llanddewi-brefi...The meaning of the name Dumel-, eludes me; and I have to make the same confession as to the ending -edu or -edo'.


