The growing importance of Africa in the international arena has made American scholars conscious of two basic, related facts: American writing on Africa is scant and American libraries even lack information about sources for African studies in other countries. The Committee on National Needs of the Association of Research Libraries, in the hope of remedying at least the second point, suggested to the Library of Congress the compilation of a list of scientific organizations that publish periodicals concerned with Africa. The survey was undertaken by the European Affairs Division, which had been made acutely aware of these problems in the course of the preparation of its recently published bibliographical guide, Introduction to Africa. We broadened the scope of the Committee's request to include organizations that publish regularly on Africa in monographic or pamphlet series, or in any other continuing form, as well as periodicals devoted in whole or consistent part to information relevant to African research.

The execution of the survey was difficult because knowledge of sources was frequently as scarce as the information on Africa itself; much of the data had to be established from secondary references. It became apparent that a useful list could be prepared only with help from leading institutions abroad. I acknowledge with gratitude the understanding and generous assistance I have received from Mr. H. V. L. Swanzy, editor of the Royal African Society journal, African Affairs, from Mr. Georges Grandidier, permanent secretary of the Academy of Colonial Sciences in Paris, and particularly from Mrs. B. E. Wyatt of the International African Institute in London who made special effort to advise us in great detail. Improved by their many emendations and additions, this survey is herewith submitted as a working paper. Data will have to be added and revised as information becomes available (to date no replies to our requests have come from Belgium, Spain and Portugal), but I hope that even in the present form it will be a valuable instrument.

The survey is organized in two chapters with a broad interpretation given to the descriptive titles. Part I is devoted to learned groups (private, semi-official and leading government research institutions) issuing serials, monographic series or otherwise publishing regularly in the African field. A few journals independently published but carrying related contributions of scholars are added. Standard official publications such as departmental reports and technical papers, for instance, those of geological or meteorological bureaus, are omitted. Classification is by area, beginning with a short section on international sources, followed by countries as outlined in the table of contents.

Part II is concerned with continuing published sources of a less scholarly nature, presented in two sections on an area basis. The first section names organizations of a commercial, educational or special interest character; the second section lists the better known independent periodicals and the more popular organs of official information services.

It was our intention to offer a reasonably comprehensive coverage and to list, where possible, publisher, periodicity and type of content, when the title was not self-explanatory. In a number of cases we have been unable to establish or verify facts through consultation of directories, special bibliographies in such publications as Africa, African Abstracts, Zaire, Bibliografia missionaria, and other reference sources, and the collaborating institutions abroad have had nothing to offer. In these cases a question mark indicates that we suspect rather than know something about a publication or group.
