REFERENCE(S)

1. Subject is a former German Intelligence officer (SD - Gestapo), living in Spain since the end of World War II. In 1943-45 he served in Lisbon where he developed a friendship with Nicolas FRANCO who was then the Spanish Ambassador. When Germany capitulated, Subject gave Nicolas some clandestine radio equipment and some other local assets (unspecified) and information. In gratitude, the Spanish Government permitted Subject to hide out in Spain. With leftover Nazi Party funds, Subject bought a house in Vigo and lived comfortably until the funds ran out in 1954. [ ] in 1952 suspected that Subject was engaged in espionage on behalf of East Germany and began a discreet investigation. [ ] also began to investigate Subject, and not only concluded that he was innocent, but the investigation officer, [ ] became his good friend. This week [ ] confidentially informed [ ] that Subject is in need of money and willing and eager to serve KUBARK against its enemies. [ ] interviewed Subject during a cafe meeting and this report contains biographic information freely given by Subject and biographic information passed in confidence to [ ] by [ ]

2. According to [ ] files, Subject was born in Budapest on 4 December 1901, son of Esteban and Caroline Josefa, married, has three children (one son born in 1930, a daughter born about 1936 and another daughter born in 1947), is an industrial engineer. Studied in a military academy in Budapest. Participated in the fight against the Communist Government established in Hungary in 1919 and later served as an officer in the Hungarian Army and then in Department "C" of the War Ministry. He moved to Germany during the twenties because he was part German. During WW II he served in the front until he was wounded, then was assigned to the intelligence service, detailed to Lisbon from 1943 to 1945. He has been living in Vigo, Spain, since 1946. He speaks Spanish, Portuguese, Hungarian, German, English, French. He is an expert photographer.

3. [ ] met Subject and his family when he was investigating them in 1952, and since then a strong friendship has developed between them. [ ] recommends Subject highly as an anti-Communist and as an honorable man, now suffering economically. "He is one of the few Germans who can be trusted unconditionally", says [ ]

4. During the meeting with [ ] at the Cafe Tropical, Calle Alcala, Madrid, on 20 September 1960, Subject volunteered the following: "I was born in 1899 in Budapest. My mother was part German and part Hungarian. My father was German. At 16 I enlisted in the Austro-Hungarian Army and later in the German Army and saw action during World War I. When the Communist Government was established in Budapest after World War I, I joined the opposition, was caught, sentenced to death, but was saved by Colonel RUSSINI from the Allied Commission. After the fall of the Communists in Hungary, I was released from prison and joined the most rightist party available. I moved to Germany in the mid-twenties and joined the N.A.S.D.P. immediately. In 1929 I joined the intelligence service of the party and thereafter served in clandestine Nazi Party operations in Austria and Hungary for many years. My basic tasks were to classify Austrians and Hungarians as to whether they were pro- or anti-German, and to recruit as many pro-Germans as possible in preparation for the German take-over of these territories. I used many false names, false documents and became very accustomed to illegal activities. During WW II I served in numerous operations against all the Allies. My last post was in Lisbon, where I served as a Colonel in the Hungarian Air Force for cover, but my real task was given to me by the Gestapo and it was to insure the loyalty of all Germans in Lisbon and to maintain clandestine radio communications with Party Headquarters in Germany. At the end of the war, the British accused me of inhumanity because my clandestine radio regularly relayed reports from our agents in England describing the precise location (and damage) where the U-1 and U-2 rockets were falling."

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The British also confronted me with a detailed report of all my life and with exact accounts of my Nazi activities. I did not deny anything but I did not nor do I feel guilty about anything I've done. I still believe in Nazism. I regret that some Nazis committed atrocities, but I realize that most of them were merely following official orders.

"I came to live in Vigo, Spain, because I felt not guilty. Until 1954 I lived on my savings and on certain confidential funds at my disposal at the end of the War. Also I had some money given my by a Mr. RABB who used me as a cutout for several years to pass monies to SKORZENY. But now I have had no income for several years other than what I make translating documents for my good friend MAZO, the director of a local fish cannery in Vigo, and what I make selling paintings I produce. I am tired of scrounging for a living and tired of the inactivity. I have often offered my services to the Spanish, but they have nothing for me.

"I am willing to work for the Americans against the Communists in any task given me. I have many friends whose past is similar to mine. I can seek their cooperation. I also have many relatives and friends in Hungary and in East Germany, and so does my wife and many of my former colleagues. I am willing to try any operation no matter how dangerous. I'll do it to make a living and to strike once more against the Communists. I would have returned to Germany long ago, but Germany refuses to recognize me, claiming that I am a Hungarian and must go through all the red tape involved in acquiring German citizenship. I live in Vigo, Avenida de Castrelos 240. Write to me or contact me as soon as you can."

5. [ ] was impressed with this unconverted Nazi operator. In spite of his age and experience, he is still craving action! Physically, he is not entirely spent, although a certain nervousness does show, probably due to his age. He has no "agent nets" to offer, nor does he have any suggestions on how he can be used. He presumes that if accepted he would be told what to do. It is obvious that Subject has never been properly debriefed by the Spanish services. The [ ] file on Subject secretly shown [ ] by [ ] contains only generalities and so does the [ ] file checked by [ ]. Although the Subject is too well known in Austria and Hungary, and although he has been a devoted Nazi for many years, he can probably still be of some operational use. Headquarters comments specifically on Subject and generally on the present possible usefulness of former German intelligence personnel now in Spain are requested.

1. Reference dispatch with its presentation of Subject's GIS past and his spirited plea for a role in the anti-Communist struggle was discussed at length with interested components of the German desk at Headquarters. At this stage reaction by both the German and Spanish desks was lukewarm to the operational use of ENDROEDY. However, this does not mean that [ ] should discontinue contact with Subject, only that as of now Headquarters has reservations about ENDROEDY's worth to the overall KUBARK effort in or out of Spain.

2. We are convinced that ENDROEDY is ideologically well motivated but suspect that [ ] in good faith is seeking a KUBARK subsidy for an old and trusted friend. Although it would be biased, an appraisal by [ ] of the true worth and present operational capabilities of ENDROEDY is in order. The nagging suspicion that financial motivation outweighs ENDROEDY's desire to aid KUBARK, plus the lack of concrete proposals by ENDROEDY, contributed to the unenthusiastic response. In summary, Headquarters at present lacks sufficient information about ENDROEDY, i.e., specifics on what (and through whom) he can contribute, to prepare any definitive advice to the Field. We have no strong feelings against the use of a convinced Nazi today, provided he has something tangible to offer and is kept under close control and direction. The question remains -- what has he to offer? The dispatch tells us little of this except that he apparently possesses a number of desirable skills of the trade -- languages, photography and perhaps W/T experience.

3. Since the desk has little interest in ENDROEDY unless future conversations develop additional information the Spanish desk suggests that the following moves be considered:

(a) That [ ] seek from [ ] his candid opinion on ENDROEDY -- where he could best serve, his strong and weak points, how serious is his financial distress and what he expects in the way of compensation if collaboration commences. Also, why hasn't greater use of ENDROEDY been made by [ ] or the [ ]

(b) Does the Field have any targets in the Vigo area, presumably the one area where ENDRÖDY could best serve our interests? Frankly, we fear that ENDRÖDY may be rusty and provincial in his outlook after many years of inactivity in a way station such as Vigo. Also, we are somewhat perplexed that a man with ENDRÖDY's past experience has no suggestions as to how he can be used.

(c) Debrief ENDRÖDY on his past intelligence contacts and history. We prefer that this not be considered a priority matter but that it be done on a time-available basis only.

(d) Given ENDRÖDY's apparent technical skills -- translator, expert photographer, W/T operator -- he may be a valuable across-the-board support type, provided that a need exists for such full-time or even part-time services.

4. Complete traces were run at Headquarters. German desk CE files were negative. RI traces confirm Subject's position with the Hungarian Legation in Lisbon and his SD position. One trace is worth forwarding, WELA-3688 dated 7 March 1950, source SHOTH.

According to (source) the whole German colony in Madrid is intrigued by ENRODY's apparent success and is of the opinion that he is financed from the Argentine. The Spanish police, however, who are also interested in ENRODY, are said to believe that he is in contact with Eastern Germany.

5. Regarding your request in paragraph five for a general comment on the present possible usefulness of former German intelligence personnel now in Spain, both the German desk and this desk agree that each case must be reviewed on its individual merits and that no blanket Headquarters comment is possible. Otto SKORZENY and his contacts with KURABK in Madrid illustrate the need for individual scrutiny of each single former G13 agent or official.

1. On 3 December 1960 Subject contacted [ ] to inquire what action KUBARK had taken in his case and to describe his operational plans on behalf of KUBARK against Hungary. Subject had been notified by mail by [ ] who had informed him that [ ] would see him again. Subject claims that he borrowed money to travel to Madrid to see [ ] personally because he fears that his mail is being intercepted in his home town and he did not wish the local [ ] to know that he is trafficking with KUBARK.

2. Subject proposed to engage in the following activity on behalf of KUBARK. He will move to Eisenstadt, Austria (Burgenland) and from there develop espionage nets into Hungary. He claims to have several relatives and many former political friends living in various cities and towns in Hungary. He believes that some of these could become valuable assets, because they are all well motivated against Communism, having suffered under the present regime. Also, they have had experience in clandestine operations during and before World War II. Subject would leave his family in Madrid where his son is employed and would come to visit them if the circumstances permitted. In Austria he believes he would have no trouble with the local authorities if he is provided with some false documentation. He paints pictures regularly and he believes that he could pass as an older gentleman who has retired in a town to paint.

3. Subject's basic motivation appears to be his desire to provide a living for his wife and daughter. At present he has no income and no money and he and his family are living under extremely adverse economic circumstances. He has not stipulated income desired but has mentioned that he is willing to work for mere room and board for himself and family.

4. Regarding his previous experience he has mentioned the following general activities. In 1926 he was recruited by the Nazi Party to conduct clandestine political activities on its behalf. Prior to that, he had already participated in clandestine operations against the Leftist elements which assumed power in Hungary at the end of World War I. He worked in Austria as he says "identifying the friends and enemies" of the future Nazi Germany. He also worked underground in Hungary. The years immediately preceding World War II, he was assigned to work on targets in Poland, specifically his job was to incite the Poles to commit violent acts against Germans in Poland so that Germany might have an excuse to act against Poland. He claims that he was very successful in this assignment. He then served in Czechoslovakia on a similar mission. When World War II started, he was assigned to the region of Alsace-Lorraine. His mission there was to identify the inhabitants who would support Germany and "do away" with those who would violently fight Germany. Then he served several years during the War on special sensitive assignments which caused him to travel to Morocco, Egypt, and German-occupied territories. Sometimes his task would be to recruit clandestine assets abroad and sometimes his task would be to "silence" someone who was talking too much against Germany. In 1944 he was assigned to Lisbon as operations officer for all German intelligence activities in the area.

5. He claims to have had abundant experience in spotting, assessing, developing and recruiting agents. He obviously is familiar with the theories of operational security, paramilitary operations, clandestine communications, radio communications, disposal cases, information nets, counterespionage, etc. etc. To get a detailed account of his operational history as he tells it would require an interrogation lasting many days.

6. Subject is very bitter against the present-day German Government because it has refused to consider him a German citizen and has consistently

denied him the privilege of living in Germany in something other than in a displaced person status. He claims that he has submitted 156 separate papers to the German Embassy in Madrid in his attempts to be recognized and permitted to live in Germany as a German citizen. Since he is still an unrepented Nazi, he has trouble achieving rapport with present-day German Government officials.

7. [ ] considers Subject to be a desperate man with no hope of obtaining employment in Spain and tired of living on the pittance he makes selling his paintings and doing a few translations. He is still convinced that Hitler was basically correct in his theories and actions against the Soviet Union and Communism. He wants to avenge the deaths and mistreatments suffered by his relatives and friends at the hands of the Soviets after World War II. He has proposed many operations to [ ] during the past ten years, but he claims [ ] has never showed an interest. Now that he is in contact with KUBARK, he hopes to be able to get back into the operational saddle and in doing so provide food and shelter for his family. He is still strong physically, but operationally he has allegedly been dormant for many years. He shows no hatred towards PBPRIME--on the contrary. He actually shows no hatred towards any nation, but he is violent against Communism and against those Germans who worked against Hitler. He is in such economic difficulties at present that he would accept most any assignment offered him. His assurances that he can succeed are obviously based on need more than on realism. But he is also filled with conviction that he is still not too old to produce operations. He is bitter with Spanish industry for not hiring him as an engineer, claiming that he is too old. He is preoccupied with the idea that he can produce as much as any young man. Subject by nature seems to be very energetic, has strong definite ideas, and has had many years of experience working for a definite program he fully believed in. This might make him hard to control and he might not readily accept operational direction. On the other hand, he is highly motivated and apparently very courageous and presumably would conduct operations with a strong desire to succeed without requiring constant encouragement.

8. Following Headquarters' advice (para. 2 of reference), [ ] attempted to get "an appraisal by [ ] of the true worth and present operational capabilities of ENDROEDY." To this end, [ ] worked out a list of questions for [ ] to answer. However, [ ] then sent these questions to ENDROEDY to answer by mail. ENDROEDY, who is convinced that local [ ] have a daily quota of 300 letters to intercept, decided not to answer [ ] but rather travel to Madrid to speak to [ ] [ ] has now phoned [ ] to inform him that he has completed an assessment of ENDROEDY.

9. It is requested that Headquarters signify if ENDROEDY's offer to conduct operations against Hungary on behalf of KUBARK is acceptable. ENDROEDY is requesting a quick decision because of his pressing need for money. The [ ] has no targets in the [ ] or elsewhere in [ ] which can be satisfied by ENDROEDY.

At the present time there is no interest in the operational use of Subject against Hungary because of his age and long period of inactivity, his lack of specifics as to his relatives and friends in East Germany and Hungary, and doubt that they now would be effective assets. If any new detailed information comes forth from Subject, we will be pleased to examine again his possible KUBARK use.</p> <p>2. We wonder if Subject is aware of [ ] KUBARK role since he did travel from Vigo to seek out [ ] in order to avoid the [ ] mail censorship and possibly to make a deal for himself without the knowledge of his "trusted" friend, [ ].</p> <p>3. Because of the reasons given in paragraph 1 and the probability that Subject would be hard to control and direct, it is suggested that [ ] drop contact with him as soon as it is feasible unless specific information, as mentioned in paragraph 1, is obtained. **ACTION REQUIRED - REFERENCES**

Action Required: Traces and comments on plausibility of Subject's statement.

1. Attached is a copy of a Spanish-language statement given voluntarily to the [redacted] by Eugenio ENDRÖDY, an Hungarian-born German of uncertain citizenship who resides at Avenida Mediterraneo 13-D<sup>o</sup>, Madrid 7. The original of the attachment was provided to [redacted] by [redacted] on a loan basis, for whatever interest KUBARK might have in the contents.

2. Not knowing whether or not [redacted] has a Spanish-language capability, we will summarize here in free translation the major points in Subject's statement. He claims that in the early days of August 1964 he met quite by chance (a shared taxi ride) one Benabdallah BOUMEDIERE, an Attaché at the Algerian Embassy in Madrid. They exchanged cards, and some days later BOUMEDIERE called Subject to invite him for a cup of coffee at the Embassy. The two exchanged life histories over the coffee, Subject telling BOUMEDIERE that he is an engineer by profession, but has to work here as an artist and translator to maintain his family. BOUMEDIERE suggested that he might work as an engineer in Algeria, and the next day Subject was interviewed by the Ambassador with this end in mind. He suggested that Subject could go to Algeria with his family, work as an engineer and at the same time instruct young people in the operation and workings of radio transmitters and receivers. He would be

given a house and a salary of one thousand dollars (per month, presumably). Two or three days later, Subject returned to the Embassy to inform the Ambassador that neither his wife nor daughter wished to leave Spain, but he would accept the job if they would guarantee to pay a certain amount of his salary in pesetas to his family in Spain. This was accepted, and arrangements were made for his travel. Subject received his visa on 14 September, departing for Algiers by ship from Palma de Mallorca on 20 September.

3. Subject was not met at the ship as the Ambassador had promised, so he proceeded to the Hotel Regina. On 21 September he called at the Foreign Ministry to meet a Mr. BAKHTY, according to the instructions he had received in Madrid. He was unable to find this man, but after several hours of searching someone told him that the man he was looking for was Captain BAKHTY in the Ministry of National Defense. That afternoon he located BAKHTY, who checked his passport carefully and told him that he would be picked up at his hotel the following day at 1630 hours to return to the Ministry for the drawing up of the contract. He was picked up on schedule, and at the Ministry was met by BAKHTY in the company of three Arabs who were said to be lieutenants who would drive him back to the hotel to get his baggage and take him to the house that had been assigned to him. BAKHTY accompanied them to the hotel, where he refused to pay Subject's bill and left the baggage in the care of the hotel. They returned to the Ministry again, and BAKHTY then told Subject to go with the three lieutenants to see the "Chief" and sign the contract. Upon getting into a car with these three, Subject was blindfolded, called a "spying Fascist pig" and ordered to confess that he had been sent by the Spanish Fascists. After 15 or 20 minutes he was led, still blindfolded, into a building with interminable stairs and passages, and when the blindfold was removed he found himself in a subterranean cell of a military prison. He was stripped of his clothing, given some dirty military clothes, and left for three days without any explanations.

4. At the end of that time he was led blindfolded to the office of the civilian chief of the prison, where he asked the cause of his detention. He was told that it was simply to give time for the examination of his papers and establish bona fides, and that all would be completed in two or three days. That same day he was transferred to another cell, waiting five days before he again saw the civilian chief of the prison, who then told him that he would be set free in four or five days and that the arrest was for his own good. Eight or nine days later he was taken to the second floor of the prison, where he was photographed in three views and again told that he would be soon released. After a total of 20 days of detention, Subject was taken - blindfolded and barefoot - to the first floor of the "Chateau", as the prison is called, where he found himself in the "Torture Chamber." There, in the presence of a Spanish interpreter from the International Brigade, his interrogation began. Given a severe beating, he was then forced to drink ten liters of water, tied at the ankles and wrists, hung by his knees head-down from a bar, and given 220-volt electrical shocks for a period of 30 or 40 minutes. Subject cannot recall either the questions or the answers he might have given during this treatment, which was given to him on three separate occasions during a five-day period. At the end of that time he was transferred to another military prison, where he was treated more humanely and given medication by a cardiologist, as the torture had been too severe for a person of 65 years.

5. He received the medications for four days, then waited

a full month before being sent back again to the "Chateau." There he was again interrogated, without torture but with the threat of it. He was asked who sent him to Algeria and what were his espionage targets. He denied everything, but eventually signed a statement under threat of more torture, although he was unaware of its contents. After a total of 74 days in prison, he was taken by car to Oran on 3 December, kept in a military barracks until 5 December, then was sent by ship to Alicante. The official who accompanied him to Oran threatened to use his signed statement against him if he talked in Spain about his adventures in Algeria. Subject's basic report ends with the mention that he was shown a file card on [ ] and told that he would be dealt with someday; that a third of the contents of his baggage and also his money was missing when his effects were returned to him; and that threats were made to kidnap his wife and daughter if he did not cooperate.

6. A separate statement by Subject, also attached, reads as follows in literal translation:

"In the Algerian Embassy in Madrid the Counselor is Mohamed el MOULDI, but his real position is that of Political Commissar with Benabdallah BOUMEDIERE as assistant. MOULDI has been a member of the Communist Party for 16 years, and has spent much time in the USSR.

"All of the functionaries of the Algerian Embassy are Communists, with the exception of one who does not belong to the Party. This is Mr. YAHIA, who speaks good Spanish.

*employed in Algerian*  
"In Algiers, in the Ministry of National Defense,<sup>as</sup> the Chief of the 'training' Section (espionage) is (Major) (sic) BAKHTY. He is tall, about 180 cm., 30-35 years of age, wears thick glasses and <sup>was</sup> trained in the Soviet Union. His assistant is an individual of about 27-28 years, 160 cm. tall, Mongoloid features, and speaks very good Russian. Both are ardent Communists.

"In the interrogation they asked me what means I knew for killing people quietly (syringes and poisons in food and drinks).

"The translator was a Spanish Communist of the International Brigade, according to his own proud statement, called Juan GARCIA. *at Spain?*

*Spain Dec. 1915*  
He is a native of Navarra, about 50 years of age, gray hair, 170 cm. tall, and thin. This person is the official translator for the Ministry of National Defense *Algeria* about being bloodthirsty as he says he killed many Fascists during the civil war. He is an enemy of the Spanish regime. *Spanish Communist. Member of International Brigade*

"I remember having heard Juan GARCIA say that the Algerian Embassy in Madrid 'functions perfectly' because they had already sent to Algiers many 'Fascist spies' and that all had received the 'deserved punishment.' He added that these spies do not travel with Spanish passports, but under false names and as documentation use a safeconduct issued by the Embassy. As an example he mentioned the name of Ben Ali Mohamed SALAH, who, according to him, left Spain in late August.

"There must have been Spanish prisoners in the military prison, since conversations in our language were occasionally heard.

"One of the prisons is located in the suburb of Hydra, on the road to Blida. They call it 'The Chateau,' and it has 202 individual cells. During the month of September there were massive arrests, and there were 940 men occupying the cells. There were groups of prisoners in the passages, with eyes blindfolded and handcuffed day and night.

"In front of my cell, Number 3, there were nine men who stayed there for 23 days thrown on the floor and not even permitted to sit up. The food was bad and very scarce. It was so cold and there was so much dampness, that due to the scarcity of clothing most of us were sick. The conditions were the most inhumane that can be imagined. The doctor who examined me - the cardiologist - is easy to identify, since in all of Algiers there are not more than three doctors in the specialty who are Arabs.

"On three occasions prisoners were brought to my cell who belonged to the revolutionary parties of the Kabylie region. According to their statements, the battles are continuous and the government troops suffer numerous losses, as day by day the anti-government contingents are growing."

7. Not having expertise on the Algerian situation, [ ] is not in a position to evaluate the above report, though in general it seems to be lacking in authenticity. The only identifiable [ ] traces on any of the individuals mentioned are to Subject himself, who was put into contact with [ ] briefly in 1960. He is an unrepentant Nazi whose last post was as an intelligence officer in Lisbon. At the end of the war he took refuge in Spain, living on confidential funds entrusted to him in Lisbon until they ran out. He has apparently scrounged a living from painting pictures and translating ever since, meanwhile trying to interest [ ] in a variety of espionage schemes. [ ] put him in touch with the [ ] in 1960 in a vain attempt to get KUBARK to use him in one way or another. [ ] may have been unaware of this last point when he passed the paper to the [ ], as the file indicates that [ ] took this action on his own responsibility.

8. For [ ] [ ] does not intend to take any action on this case, but we would appreciate receiving [ ] traces on the individuals mentioned and your comments on the plausibility of Subject's story. Should you have sufficient interest in the matter, we would be happy to direct follow up questions to Subject through [ ] Liaison.

9. For Headquarters: Only one Spanish name has been marked for indexing, as we are too unfamiliar with Near Eastern names to mark them properly. As a matter of general interest, the only name appearing above which also appears in the Diplomatic List is that of Mohammed El MOULDI, who is listed as having arrived on 18 April 1964 as Counselor of Embassy.

bre las 15,30 horas de uno de los primeros días del mes de agosto del presente año, me encontraba en la Plaza de la Independencia donde, impacientemente, esperaba la llegada de algún taxi que permitiera llegar con tiempo a una consulta médica en casa del Dr. Azcona -otorrinolaringólogo- ya que estaba citado a las 15,45.

Llegó un taxi "libre" y al hacer la seña para su utilización, otro señor también requería sus servicios. Surgió una pequeña discusión sobre la primacía de derecho al empleo del taxi y, como quiera que yo tenía urgencia, le hice ver tal necesidad; el otro señor, al parecer, tenía prisa y no quería ceder, por lo que uno y otro se consultaron el destino de sus itinerarios; la coincidencia surgió ya que el señor iba a Zurbano 100 y yo a la misma calle, finca número 10. Decidimos emplear el mismo coche y una vez en el mismo nos cruzamos nuestras correspondientes tarjetas de visita después de despedirnos amablemente una vez que llegamos a mi destino continuando él su viaje.

Dicho señor BENABDALLAH BOUMEDIERE, Agregado de la Embajada de Argelia en Madrid, sita en la calle Zurbano número 100 que es, precisamente, donde se dirigía cuando el incidente del taxi.

Pasados unos días dicho señor me llamó telefónicamente para invitarme a tomar café. Acedí de manera correcta y nos reunimos en la Embajada en donde cada uno de nosotros referimos, a grandes rasgos, parte de nuestra vida. Yo, mencioné que era Ingeniero y que dada mi edad nadie quería contratar mis servicios como tal, por lo que veía obligado a pintar cuadros y hacer traducciones, a fin de obtener ingresos con los que poder sostener a mi familia. A todo esto, el señor contestó que podía hacer una visita a su Embajador pues sabía trataba de buscar algún Ingeniero para Argel, despidiendonos cordialmente.

Acudí otro día a la Embajada, entrevistandome con el titular - quien me preguntó si estaría dispuesto a trasladarme a Argelia - con mi familia, en donde podría trabajar como Ingeniero, al propio tiempo que podía instruir a jóvenes en el manejo y conocimiento de radiotransmisores y receptores. Agregó que se me facilitaría una villa (chalet) y que mi sueldo sería de MIL dólares en vista de que según sus propias palabras "desde que los franceses abandonaron Argelia hacían falta muchos técnicos". Dicho Embajador me aseguró que tenía plenos poderes de su Gobierno para poder contratar técnicos.

A todo ello y en atención a su propuesta le rogué esperara mi contestación ya que debía consultar con la familia la conveniencia de aceptar. Y así quedamos al despedirnos.

Pasados dos ó tres días le hice una nueva visita en el transcurso de la cual le dije que tanto mi señora como mi hija estaban dispuestas a no abandonar España y que si me garantizaba que cierta cantidad de mi sueldo podría pagarse a mi familia aquí en España, en pesetas, podríamos llegar a un acuerdo en cuanto al trabajo prometido. El Embajador contestó asegurando que todo ello se podía arreglar con el Ministerio, diciendome tramitara mi pasapor

te y que él pagaría el viaje.

El día 14 de septiembre me fué entregado Pasaporte con el correspondiente visado y ese mismo día inicié el viaje a Argelia vía Barcelona-Palma de Mallorca. En esta ciudad tuve que esperar cuatro días hasta que un barco francés, procedente de Marsella, llegase al puerto. Embarqué el día 20 a las nueve horas llegando a Argel ese mismo día a las 20,00 horas. A pesar de la promesa del Embajador no me esperaba nadie a mi llegada, en vista de lo cual me dirigí al hotel "Regina" donde pernocté.

Al día siguiente, lunes 21, me encaminé al Ministerio de Asuntos Exteriores en donde debía entrevistarme con el Sr. BAKHTY, tal y como me había señalado el Embajador en Madrid. Pregunté en casi todas las Secciones de dicho Ministerio sin lograr localizar a tal persona, hasta que después de varias horas un señor me dijo conocía al Capitán Bakhty, pero que éste trabajaba en el Ministerio de la Defensa Nacional.

El mismo día, por la tarde, pude ser presentado al Capitán BAKHTY en el Ministerio de Defensa Nacional. En su despacho me pidió el Pasaporte, mirandolo detenidamente. Habló durante unos minutos diciendome que al día siguiente, 22, sobre las 16,30 me recogería un coche en mi hotel para que me trasladara al Ministerio y en donde un alto funcionario extendería el correspondiente contrato.

Efectivamente el martes 22 se presentó el conductor de un coche oficial en el hotel, trasladandome a una dependencia del Ministerio distinta a la que había estado el día anterior a la que, después de una corta espera, llegó el Capitán Bakhty acompañado de tres jóvenes árabes diciendo eran Tenientes a sus órdenes y con los que iría a mi hotel para recoger el equipaje y llevarlo al chalet que me tenían asignado. El grupo compuesto por Bakhty, los tres Tenientes y yo llegamos al hotel en donde se exigía el pago incluido el día siguiente, por lo que Bakhty muy enfadado no efectuó el abono de la factura dejando allí mi maleta. Con el coche regresamos nuevamente hacia el Ministerio, en donde se quedó Bakhty al propio tiempo que decía riendo: "Ahora vayase con estos señores junto al gran Jefe, para hacer el contrato". Los tres supuestos Tenientes, abriendo la puerta de un gran turismo, me empujaron hacia dentro y sin que hubiera recuperado el equilibrio fui esposado, mientras otro de ellos me vendaba los ojos con un paño. El coche partió con gran velocidad y los tres individuos al tiempo que se reían me preguntaron: ¿Na, cerdo espía fascista, confiesalo, no te enviaron aquí los fascistas españoles..? Yo, ni les contesté pues sé que con esta clase de individuos todas las palabras son vanas. Transcurridos unos 15 ó 20 minutos, el coche paró; me sacaron y con los ojos tapados me llevaron por interminables escaleras y pasillos hacia un lugar en donde me quitaron la venda de los ojos. Me di cuenta de que habíamos llegado a una celda pequeña y subterránea en una prisión militar. Se lanzaron sobre mí y sin escrúpulos de ningún género me dejaron completamente desnudo, dejandome tan solo la camiseta y los calzoncillos, arrojando sobre el piso una sucia prenda militar y unos pantalones, también terriblemente sucios, para que me vistiera. Acto seguido se marcharon dejandome solo.

Tres días después me llevaron, con los ojos vendados, a la oficina del Jefe civil de la prisión para tomar mi filiación. Pregunté al Jefe las causas de mi detención, contestandome: "Nada, -



nada, solo para tener tiempo de examinar sus papeles y tener la seguridad de que son auténticos"; "en dos ó tres días todo habrá terminado".

Aquel mismo día me trasladaron a otra celda, transcurriendo cinco fechas sin que nadie me preguntara nada. Se presentó el Jefe civil, preguntandome de nuevo por qué me encontraba en esta situación, diciendome que pasados cuatro ó cinco días sería puesto en libertad y que dicho arresto era en mi propio beneficio.

Ocho ó nueve días mas tarde me llevaron al segundo piso, donde me hicieron fotografías en tres posiciones distintas y asegurandome el Jefe que, como no habia alguna acusación concreta contra mí, sería puesto en libertad en pocos días.

Al cumplirse los veinte días de mi detención, me trasladaron al primer piso del "Chateau", -como ellos lo llaman- descalzo y con los ojos vendados. Me quitaron el paño de los ojos y me encontré en "La chambre de torture". Allí, en presencia de un traductor español de las Brigadas Internacionales -como el mismo me reconoció-, quien con palabras contra España, imposibles de reproducir, y acusaciones contra el Caudillo, comenzó mi "interrogatorio".

Después de grandes palizas me hacian beber unos 10 litros de agua; me pegaban en todo el cuerpo y me ataron los tobillos y las muñecas, colgandome debajo de mis rodillas a un palo muy grande que salia de unas de las paredes, con la cabeza hacia abajo. Las palizas continuaban mientras continuaba en dicha posición y no conformes con todo ello comenzaron a darme corrientes de 220 voltios, causandome heridas grandes y profundas en todo mi cuerpo.

El tratamiento de la corriente electrica duraba de 30 a 40 minutos y yo no sabia ni lo que preguntaban ni lo que contesté, si és que contesté algo. Se me hizo esto tres veces en cinco días, es decir el primero, tercero y quinto y las consecuencias fueron las de que em encontraba medio muerto. En vista de ello me trasladaron a otra nueva prisión militar en donde, a pesar de mi estado, aprecié mas humanidad. Un médico -cardiologo- me hizo dos visitas, recetando medicamentos para fortalecer mi corazón. Las palizas y corrientes habian sido tan fuertes que cada mi edad, 65 años, apenas pude soportar.

Los medicamentos me fueron administrados durante cuatro días y despues...nada. Al cabo de casi un mes, me llevaron de nuevo al "Chateau", donde, con "ayuda" de varios comunistas que actuaban como traductores, durante cinco días siguieron los interrogatorios, esta vez sin torturas, pero sí con la amenaza de ellas. Querían saber quien me mandó a Argelia, si el S.I.M. ó la Policía y que es lo que tenía que espiar. Fué en vano que yo les dijera que nadie me habia enviado y que mi viaje obedecia a la propuesta hecha por el Embajador de su país en Madrid. Todo fué inútil. Por fin pusieron ante mí un "Protocolo" para que lo firmara y como quiera que yo recabara mis gafas para poder leerlo y después firmarlo, me dijeron: "O lo firmas ó vas de nuevo a la cámara de tortura". En vista de ello no tuve otro remedio que firmar, ignorando en que podia consistir mi "declaración".



Después de 74 días de prisión, el día 3 de diciembre actual, me transportaron en coche a Orán; permanecí por espacio de dos días en un cuartel militar y el día 5 fui embarcado hacia Alicante llegando a las ocho de la noche. Durante el camino hacia Orán el Oficial que me acompañaba me advirtió lo siguiente: "Y cuidado con lo que hablas en España, porque nosotros enviaremos el protocolo que has firmado a la Policía española y no te librarás tan fácilmente como de aquí"

meta/3 Durante los interrogatorios del "Chateau" me fué mostrada la ficha del [REDACTED], tomada en Tetuán, al propio tiempo que me decían: "De este "cerdo fascista" también nos ocuparemos algún día".

En la oficina de la prisión me desapareció la tercera parte del contenido de mi maleta así como también dinero.

Por último y para hacerse cargo de la carencia de escrúpulos de toda esta gente, figura el hecho de que al recordarles la proposición que me había sido hecha en Madrid, yo alegué que mi familia no quería salir de España. El Comandante que presidió el "interrogatorio", dijo riéndose a carcajas: "Como que tu familia no quería venir a Argelia?". "Has de saber que en seis horas estarían aquí". Al decir yo que eso era imposible, me contestó: " Por qué? ¿No has oído hablar nunca del "KIDNAPPING"? - Nosotros nos encargamos de raptar dentro de dos horas a tu mujer é hija y en otras dos horas están aquí! !No hace falta preguntar a las mujeres!.

En la Embajada de Argelia en Madrid figura como Consejero MOHAMED EL MOULDI, pero su verdadero cargo es el de Comisario Político, figurando como ayudante el Sr. BENABDALLAH.

MOULDI es miembro del Partido Comunista desde hace 16 años y estuvo mucho tiempo en la URSS.

Todos los funcionarios de la Embajada de Argelia son comunistas y tan solo hay uno que no pertenece al Partido. Se trata del Sr. YAHIA que habla correctamente el español.

En Argel; -Ministerio de la Defensa Nacional- el Jefe de la Sección "Formación" (espionaje) es el Comandante BAHETY. Es un hombre alto, de 1,80 aproximadamente, de unos 30-35 años, con gafas gruesas é instruido en Rusia. Su Ayudante es un individuo de unos 27-28 años, 1,60 de estatura, cara de mongol y habla muy bien el ruso. Tanto uno como otro son comunistas íntegros.

En su interrogatorio me preguntaron cuántos medios conocía para matar hombres empleando sistemas no alarmantes. (Jeringa y veneno en alimentación y bebidas).

Figuraba como traductor un comunista español -de las Brigadas Internacionales, según dijo orgullosamente- llamado JUAN GARCIA, natural de Navarra, de unos 50 años, pelo gris, de 1.70 estatura, delgado. Este individuo es el traductor oficial del Ministerio y alardea de ser un sanguinario pues dice haber matado a muchos fascistas durante la guerra civil. Es enemigo del Regimen español.

Recurda haber oído decir a Juan GARCIA que la Embajada de Argelia en Madrid "funciona perfectamente" porque ya ha enviado a Argel bastantes "espías fascistas" y que todos han recibido el "merecido castigo". Agrega que estos espías no viajan



con pasaporte español, sino con nombres y apellidos falsos y como documentación un salvoconducto expedido por la Embajada. Como ejemplo citó el nombre de BEN ALI MOHAMED SALAH que, según él, salió de España a finales de agosto pasado.

En la prisión militar debe haber presos españoles ya que en ocasiones se oyen conversaciones en nuestro idioma.

Una de las cárceles se encuentra en el barrio HYDRA, en la carretera que va a Blida. La llaman "El Chateau" y tiene 202 celdas individuales. Durante el mes de septiembre se produjeron detenciones masivas y fueron 940 hombres los que ocuparon las citadas celdas. Por los pasillos había grupos de presos amontonados, con los ojos vendados y esposados día y noche.

Frente a mi celda numerada con el 3, había 9 hombres que permanecieron por espacio de 23 días tirados en el suelo y sin que se les permitiera ni sentarse. La alimentación era mala y muy escasa. Se pasaba mucho frío y había mucha humedad que, debido a la poca ropa que teníamos, nos hacía enfermar a casi todos. Las condiciones eran de lo más inhumano que puede concebirse. El Médico que me examinó -cardiologo- es fácil de identificar ya que en todo Argel no existen nada más que 3 doctores de esta especialidad que sean árabes.

En tres ocasiones han llevado a mi celda detenidos pertenecientes a las partidas de revolucionarios de las kabylias, a los que habían hecho prisioneros con armas. Según sus manifestaciones las luchas con continuas y los gubernamentales tienen pérdidas cuantiosas, así como de día en día aumentan los grupos de contingentes anti-gubernamentales.
