FOREWORD

The Iowa Crop and Livestock Reporting Service is the Iowa unit of a nation-wide organization which is entrusted with the responsibility of operating a standard statistical service for agriculture. The Division of Agricultural Statistics is a division of the Iowa State Department of Agriculture working in cooperation with the Agricultural Marketing Service of the United States Department of Agriculture. The year 1939 marked the one-hundredth anniversary of the collection of statistics of agriculture in the United States.

The general program of the Iowa Crop and Livestock Reporting Service is to meet the public needs and demands for summary data of an historical nature and for current statistical information of agricultural production in Iowa and the United States.

In recent years, there has been an increasing demand from agricultural organizations, commercial interests, teachers, legislators, and county, State and governmental agencies for agricultural data showing the trends of change in counties. Little has been done in the past to make available data for each county over an extended period of time. So urgent is the need for county data that some organizations have assembled such information at considerable cost. It is in response to these needs that this series is being issued.

The county data herein offered have been assembled from existing State and Federal documents and reports, under the supervision of Norman V. Strand, State-wide Work Projects Administration Supervisor of Agricultural Economics and Statistics projects. This is a report of work completed on Official Project 65-1-72-155 of the Work Projects Administration. Official Project 665-72-3-36 furnished the material for Tables 30 and 32.

The Iowa Agricultural Extension Service participated in the preparation of the materials in this report. Selected data from the files of the Iowa Agricultural Experiment Station have been released for publication in this series. Special credit is given to the Iowa assessors and tax officials who collect data on crops and livestock as required under the Iowa laws. Without these data by townships and counties detailed agricultural statistics would be less accurate and less complete.

IOWA AGRICULTURAL STATISTICS - JOHNSON COUNTY

Johnson County was established on December 21, 1837, and named for Richard M. Johnson, Vice-President of the United States at that time. It originally included all of township 77, Washington County, but on June 5, 1839, township 77, in ranges 6, 7 and 8 was set off to Washington County. On June 5, 1845, the part of township 77 lying east of the Iowa River was returned to Johnson County and the boundary has remained unchanged. 1/

In 1836 John Gilbert established a trading post in Pleasant Valley Township. Soon after this first post was established Philip Clarke and John Myers settled nearby and opened farms. In 1838 Gilbert and Clarke laid out a town which they named Napoleon; this place later became the county-seat. The county was formally organized by the authority of Governor Lucas in 1838. Napoleon remained the county-seat until Iowa City was established as the Territorial Capitol in 1841. The post office and county records were then removed to Iowa City and that place became the permanent county-seat. The cornerstone of the Capitol was laid in 1840, the first legislature met there in 1841, and the Capitol building was first occupied in 1842. The Capitol was moved to Des Moines in 1857.

The first railroad, the Mississippi and Missouri, was completed to Iowa City by January 1, 1856.

The State University was established at Iowa City in 1847, but instruction did not begin until 1855.

Robert Lucas, first Territorial Governor (1838-1841), and Samuel J. Kirkwood, former Governor of Iowa (1860-1864; 1876-1877), are buried in Oakland Cemetery in Iowa City. 2/

Area

Johnson County is approximately 24 miles square, with another township attached to it on the southeast corner, making a total area of 610 square miles, or 390,400 acres. 3/ Of this number, 367,644 acres are listed as farm land. 4/ There are 21 townships of various size in the county and it ranks eighteenth in point of size in the State.

Soils

The soils of Johnson County are grouped into 4 classes according to their origin and location; namely, drift, loess, terrace, and swamp and bottom-land. The drift soils comprise 8.9 percent of the surface of the county and are divided into Carrington loams--8.1 percent, and Shelby loams--0.8 percent. The loess soils cover 71.9 percent of the area and are divided into Clinton silt loam--45.9 percent, Tama silt loam--18.9 percent, Muscatine silt loam--5.5 percent, Scott silt loam--0.1 percent, and Knox sand--1.5 percent. The terrace soils cover 9.1 percent of the county and are divided into Waukesha loams--3.3 percent, Bremer loams--3.6 percent, Buckner loams--1.3 percent, Jackson silt loam--0.8 percent, and Chariton silt loam--0.1 percent. The swamp and bottom-land soils cover 10.1 percent of the area and are divided into the Wabash loams--7.2 percent, Cass silt loam--2.4 percent, Sarpy sand--0.2 percent, meadow--0.1 percent, muck--0.1 percent, and riverwash--0.1 percent. 5/

Topography

The original surface of Johnson County was a broad, smooth plain, sloping gently toward the southeast. The drift soils are comparatively smooth to gently rolling and are bordered by low ridges. North of the Iowa River, in the "North Liberty" plain, which is cut by this river, the loess hills rise abruptly from the river and the surface is very rough for two or three miles until the "Iowa Drift Upland" is reached in the northern part of the county. South of Iowa City the uplands are rolling as they approach the streams, but the areas between the streams are gently undulating to almost flat. The loess hills along the Iowa River, west of the Cedar River, and along Clear Creek and other streams in the county, often rise 40 to 60 feet above the plain level, but they have been considerably modified by erosion. The Cedar River and its tributaries drain the northeast part of the county and the Iowa River drains the remainder of the area. 6/

Climate

The average temperature for 10 years (1930-1939) was 48.6 degrees. 7/ The average precipitation for 73 years (1857-1930) was 36.22 inches, and the growing season averaged 163 days between the killing frost dates of April 28 and October 8, recorded from 1892 to 1930. 8/

Population

The Territorial census of 1840 credited Johnson County with 1,491 residents. Population growth was greatly stimulated by the establishment of the State Capitol and State University at Iowa City. There was a slight decrease in population numbers after 1880, but there has been a steady increase since 1890. In 1930, the county had a density of 50 persons per square mile, as compared with the State density of 44. The following table shows the number of inhabitants recorded at 10-year intervals:

In 1930 the foreign born and native white inhabitants of foreign born or mixed parentage totaled 8,734, or 28.8 percent of the total population. Of this number, those of Czechoslovakian descent led with 2,914. There were 2,378 persons of German descent and 975 of Irish descent. Other nationalities had very small representations. 14/

Cooperatives

In 1937 there were 4 cooperative institutions in operation in this county--1 elevator, 1 milk depot, 1 livestock enterprise, and 1 merchandise establishment.

As a whole, they had 336 members, of which 291 were active, and 1,531 persons did business with the 4 concerns. The selling cooperatives had a business volume of \$301,763 and the purchasing cooperatives transacted \$164,714 worth of business.

Cooperatives may both buy and sell or they may perform one or the other function exclusively. Purchasing cooperatives buy non-farm commodities for distribution to their members and patrons, and selling cooperatives market farm commodities for their members and patrons. 15/

Fruit

In 1884, the record year for apples, there were 78,606 trees and 49,959 bushels recorded. The best year for peaches and cherries was 1909. In that year, 3,514 peach trees yielded 196 bushels and 16,567 cherry trees produced 6,087 bushels. The greatest number of plum trees, 14,970, was reported in 1909, but the greatest production, 1,593 bushels, was listed in 1894. In 1894, the peak year for grapes, 81,653 vines and 226,245 pounds of grapes were recorded. 16/

Note Regarding Yields of Corn

The crop assessors' statistical breakdown for corn acreage is as follows: (1) all corn, (2) corn husked for grain, (3) corn cut for silage, (4) corn cut for fodder and (5) corn hogged off. A total production is given for each farm which includes only that actually husked. In getting county totals of production, the acreage other than that husked is multiplied by the yield (derived by dividing total bushels corn husked by total acres husked) and added to summations of individual farm productions shown as husked. This assumes that acreage not husked would have produced the same yield as that actually husked.

In 1934 and 1936, both poor crop years, separate estimations of corn yield on acreage not husked were made by the State assessors' office because it was felt that farmers in those years would select their best acreages for husking and cut or hog off the rest, which would have a different and lower yield. This separate yield estimation was then multiplied by the acreage not husked and the total added to that reported as husked.

This was done by counties only and not by townships. The township yields for these two years, then, are somewhat high since they are based only on acreage husked for grain and bushels husked. The total corn acreage is shown by township with this yield, and any attempt to multiply it by the acreage shown to get total production will result in a too high figure. The county summary table figures for corn yield in 1934 and 1936 have been adjusted for poorer yields on that acreage not husked and these yields may legitimately be multiplied by the acreages shown there to arrive at total productions for the county.

In all other years actual township productions may be derived from the yield and acreage figures shown in the tables since corn yield has been assumed to be equal in all utilizations. The county yield and township yields are, therefore, consistent in all years except 1934 and 1936.

The figures in this table for the years 1870-1935, inclusive, have been derived from the Federal Censuses for Iowa. These enumerations have been made as of different dates. Some enumerations were for a base date of January 1, others for a base date of April 1, and others for June 1.

The census enumerations made in 1920, 1925 and 1935 were for January 1. For comparability the enumerations made for the base dates of April 1 and June 1 were adjusted to an equivalent January 1 base. This adjustment procedure places the livestock data of the above table on the one inventory date of January 1.

The figures for 1936, 1937, 1938 and 1939 for all cattle and milk cows are estimates of the Division of Agricultural Statistics of the Iowa Department of Agriculture and those for horses, mules, hogs and sheep are adjusted State farm assessors' figures.

The adjusted county figures for horses, mules, hogs and sheep for the last four years in the table are more nearly accurate than those in Table 26 and comparison with these figures will provide an estimate of the bias displayed by the unadjusted State farm assessors' figures.


