1. In a memorandum to the Central Liaison Office dated 19 Sep 1945, which originated in ESS, it was directed "that each industrial, manufacturing and mining company in Japan that had a total volume of one million yen or more in the fiscal year 1944, be required to furnish the information listed". The reports received in response to this memorandum are now being listed and analysed by ESS. This memorandum did not specifically mention government arsenals or government owned plants.

2. Paragraphs 5 and 6 of Directive No 3, 22 Sep 1945, refer both to government - and privately - owned plants. The requirements as to reports of government plants have not been met.

3. Suggest that this be called to the attention of the C.L.O., with instructions that the reports be prepared similar to those submitted for private companies. Inventories should be the latest available, not older than 1 Sep 1945.
