MediaWiki

- MediaWiki is a free and open-source wiki application.
- Content Management and Archiving System
- Used to develop content through collaboration
- Used in all Wikimedia Projects
- Used by many Free Software projects for Documentation
- Used by organizations and NGOs for creating content





Installing MW, Prerequisites

- Webserver – Apache, nginx etc.
- Database Server – PostgreSQL, MySQL, SQLite, MariaDB
- PHP
- Parsoid and Node.js for VisualEditor





Steps to install MediaWiki

- Download MediWiki
- Extract in Document Root of webserver
- Set up the webserver configuration
- Create Database and Database user
- Launch a browser and give the URL pointing your MW directory
- Follow the instructions
- Download LocalSettings.php and place in MW directory





Installing Extensions

- Better to have SSH access to server
- Download your extension
 - Download Snapshot/Tarball/ZIP file
 - Clone from Wikimedia GIT Repo
 - Explained in Extension's Page
- Extract and Copy it to extensions directory
- Install your extension
 - In LocalSettings.php add `require_once "$IP/extensions/extension_name/extension_name.php";` for mw.v 1.24.x or less
 - In LocalSettings.php add `wfLoadExtension('<extension-name>');` for mw.v 1.25.x or above
