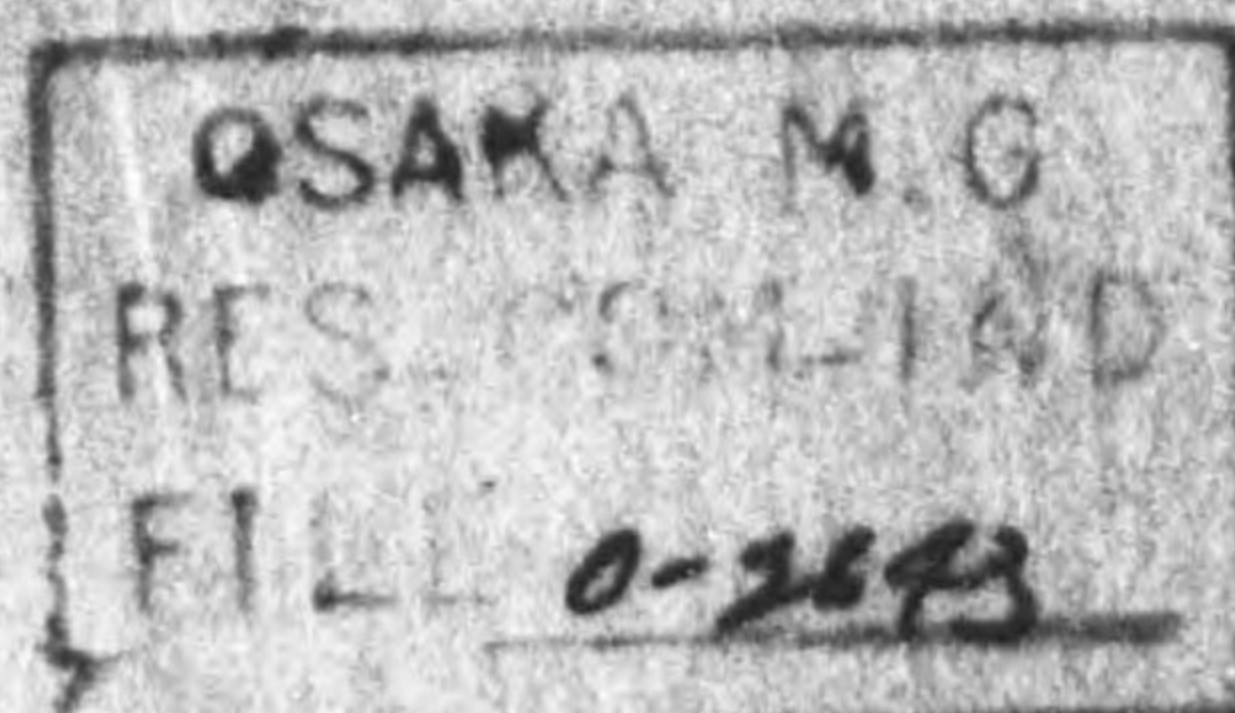

3. It is indicated by this survey that, without exception, the quota allocations were made to the guns, villages and towns. Further "breakdown", in every case, was held up at village, town or local farmers' buraku committee. According to information given by local officials, negative replies given by majority of the farmers can be attributed to the following reasons:

- a. Withholding quota til last minute hoping for adjustments.
- b. Loss of political prestige if quotas are enforced upon farmers resulting in reluctance to notify immediately.
- c. Notifying farmers during busy rice planting season results in lesser complaint registered at village or town office.
- d. Lethargy on the part of village, town or buraku officials.

1. Surveillance of rail shipments by Osaka Police and members of this headquarters has indicated recent changes in methods of evading the transportation control system. Several large shipments of staple foods from your prefecture have been disguised as apple shipments. Information relative to these shipments is as follows:

a. Thirty (30) koku of rice, disguised as an apple shipment, was forwarded from Kamada Shipping Firm, Namiuchi Station, Aomori-shi, to Tokutaro Torii, Vegetable Cooperative Association, Osaka Central Market, about 24 April 1949. This shipment was in 252 apple cases, of which, 130 cases were confiscated by Municipal Police, each case containing about 1.2 to of rice.

b. Thirty-one (31) cases of apples, shipped from Matsumae City, Aomori Prefecture, to Osaka Umeda Freight Station, were found to contain 429 kgs. of soy beans and 69.2 kgs. of red beans. Designated consignee and consignor were falsely listed. Items were confiscated by Municipal Police on 7 May 1949.

2. This headquarters is cognizant that information pertinent to shipments listed above are of little value due to the time element, however, this headquarters will, in the future, expedite information of this nature for whatever action you may deem necessary.



The diminution of salt would often occur to some extent not only due to the dispersion thereof at time of warehouseing and delivery, but also to evaporation of the hydro-content while being kept in store, in which case, the more hydro-content thereof (such as comparatively fresh salt extracted from sea water or the one absorbed bilge-water during transit) is the more the ratio of its diminution.

In general, the diminution of salt in storage ranges from 2% to 3% (according to the actual results in the past).

1. A check conducted by this headquarters of shipments from Tetteri Prefecture, as listed in inclosure 1, 2 and 3 disclosed the following:

a. As stated in Inclosure 1, the shipment consigned to Osaka Marine Products Ltd. called for 1,708 kan of boiled squid. Upon receipt, it was found that freight order #19 shipped 4 January in Car No. 7022 consisted of 1,627.8 kan of boiled squid and was received 5 January by Daisui K.K. It was sold by them at prices ranging from 100 to 190 yen per kan.

b. Freight Order #14, shipped 3 January in Car Re-6197, was received 4 January by the consignee in the quantity as stated in Inclosure 2. Prices were not ascertained.

c. Freight Order #49, shipped 7 January 1949 in Car Re-5018 comprised two shipments, one received 9 January by Osaka Fish Market Co., consisting of 281.2 kan boiled cuttlefish and 56 kan of oysters. The other received same date by Daisui K.K. consisting of 231.9 kan of boiled cuttlefish. It was sold at prices ranging from 125 to 200 yen less 5% commission.

1. Under the provisions of paragraph 13, Operational Directive No. 26/2, Headquarters Eighth Army, 2 May 1947, 23,142 kgs of sago starch, 3,194 lbs of canned food in D, E, F, and H classes, 235 kgs of corn flour and 163 lbs of canned goods from 10-in-1 ration have been released in Osaka Prefecture.

2. The foods mentioned in paragraph 1 have been released because of the following defects.

a. Sago starch contained some acidity which would be harmful if eaten in its natural form.

b. Canned food in classes D, E, F, and H was in imminent danger of spoilage from long period of storage.

c. Corn flour became wet during transit.

d. Canned goods from 10-in-1 rations spoiled because of long storage.

3. Distribution was made as follows:

a. Sago starch will be processed into miso.

b. Canned food in D, E, F, and H classes will be processed into fodder.

c. Corn flour will be processed into soy sauce.

d. Canned food from 10-in-1 ration will be processed into fodder.

4. Distribution has been made through official channels.
