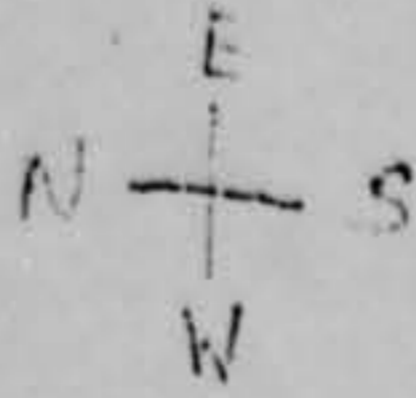
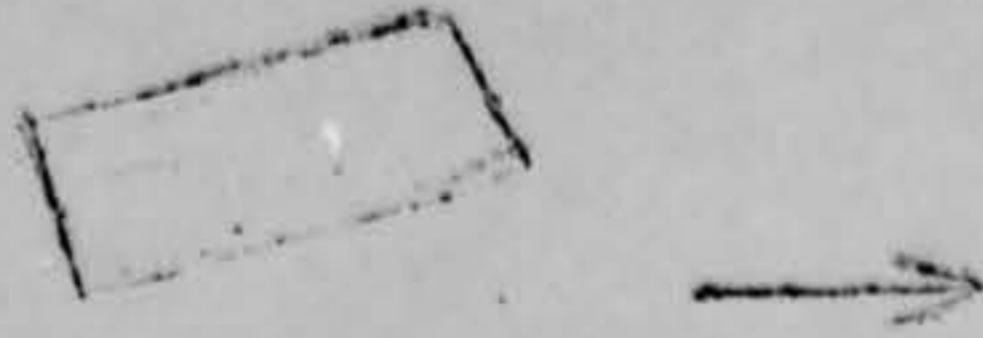



Reference your letter dated December 13, 1967 regarding an unidentified flying object (UFO) report from Ardmore, Tennessee, November 7, 1967 at approximately 4:10 pm CST.


Ardmore is located approximately 25 miles, 345 degrees from the new Huntsville-Madison County Airport, which opened October 29, 1967. Unless an incident out of the ordinary occurs, we do not normally retain records whereby we could reconstruct aircraft positions beyond fifteen days, which is the case in this instance.

Huntsville Airport Traffic Control Tower controllers did not observe a sighting such as reported, nor was a similar object reported to this office.

A direct route between Huntsville and Nashville passes approximately five miles east of Ardmore. A dog-leg route between Shelbyville, Tennessee and Huntsville is over the same general area. Aircraft from over Nashville landing Huntsville, would normally be descending from higher altitudes, and would probably be 6,000-10,000 feet at this point; aircraft from Shelbyville would normally be operating at altitudes of 3,500-5,000 feet. Although not heavily traveled, these routes were begun October 29, 1967, and for the most part relatively low ceilings were experienced for the first week of operation.

In the event that it might assist your investigation, Huntsville Airport weather on November 7, 1967 at 3:54 pm CST was clear, visibility more than fifteen miles, temperature 54, dewpoint 25, wind 270 degrees at seven knots. Sunset was at 4:47 pm CST.

I am writing this letter to you concerning an object I saw yesterday afternoon, the sky was clear wind from the NW at about 5 mph, ground temp at 50°.

When I was out hunting I observed what I thought first was a Hawk, I noticed it was much too large and moving very slowly south. I ran about 250 yds across a field to try to get a better look at it. It never really got any larger, it compared to the length of the Half Moon at its largest. It appeared to be flat but tilted at an angle toward the ground. It moved ~~slowly~~ quietly to the south and as it ^{MOVED} ~~turned~~ farther from me the sun reflected off its apparent metallic surface (TIME - 4.00). Thank you.

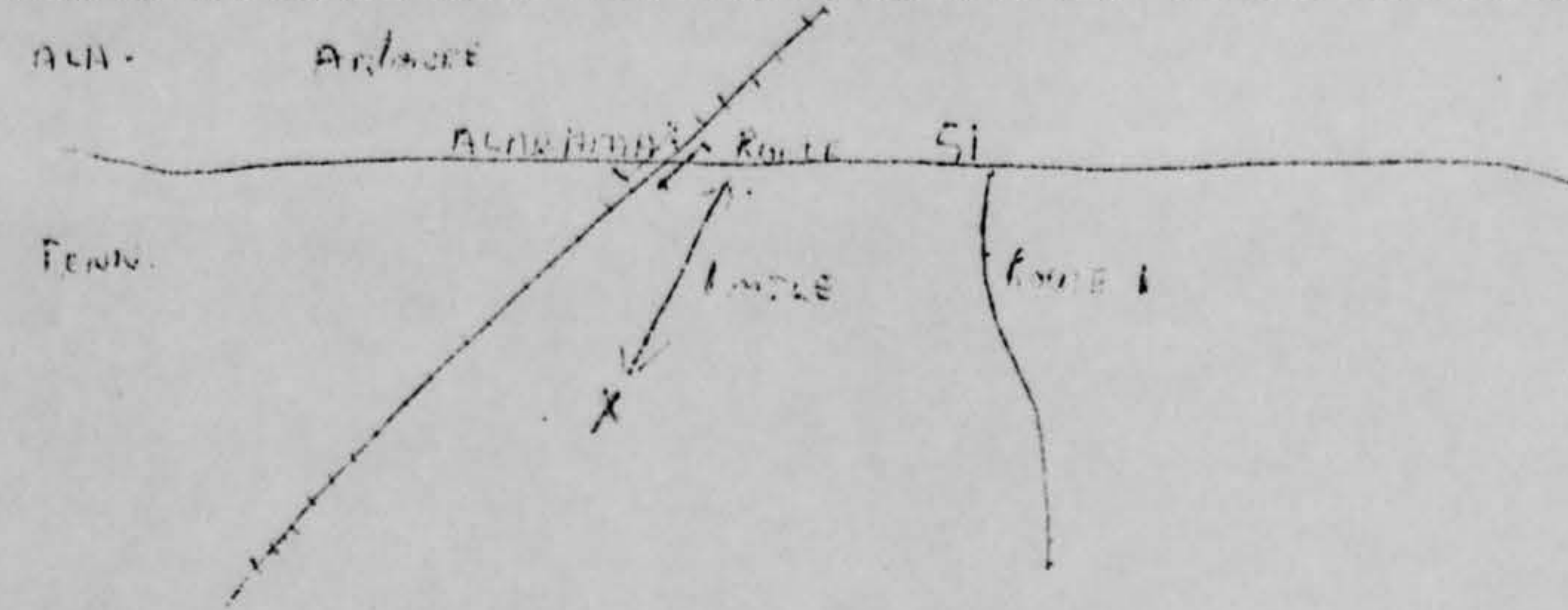

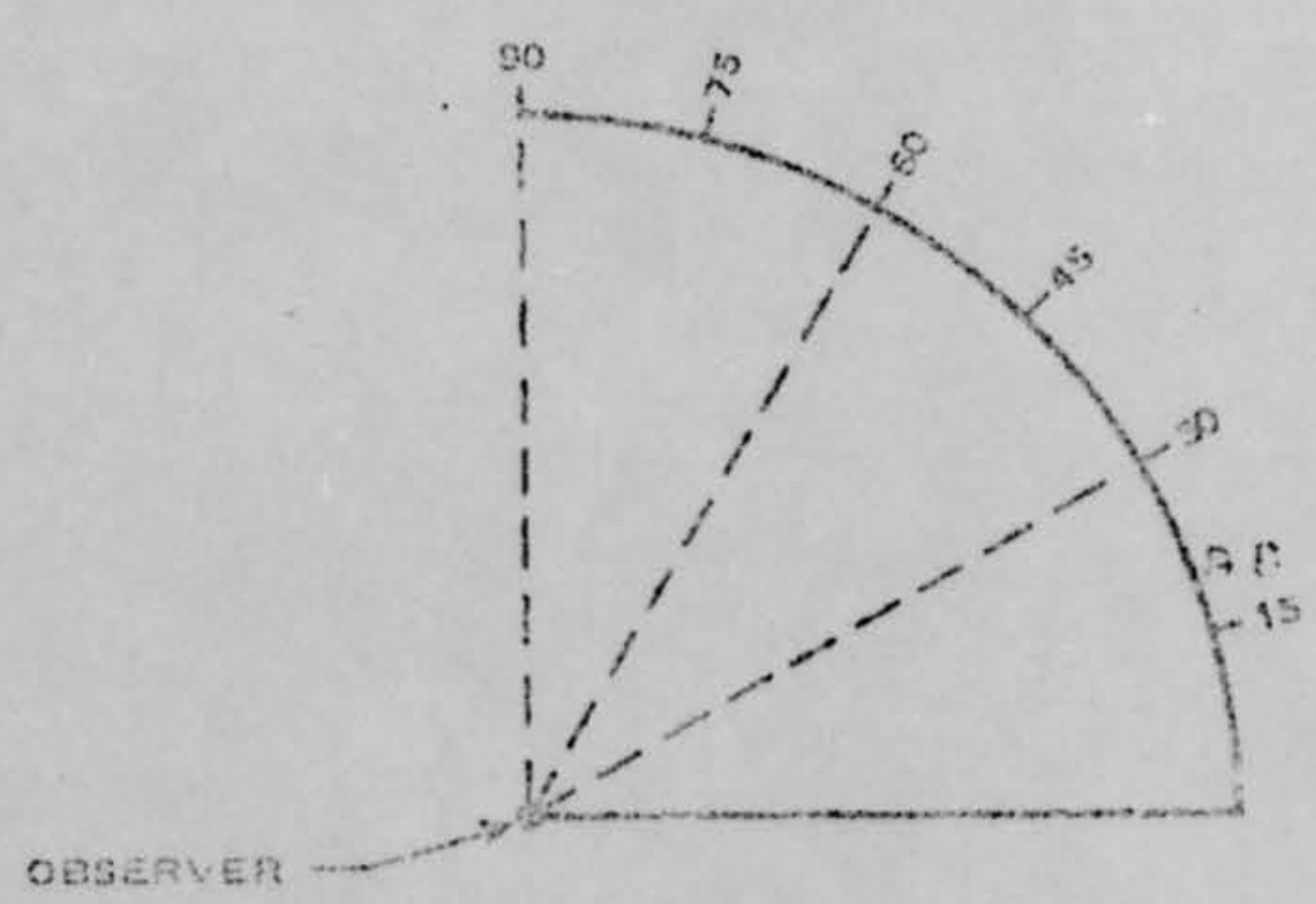

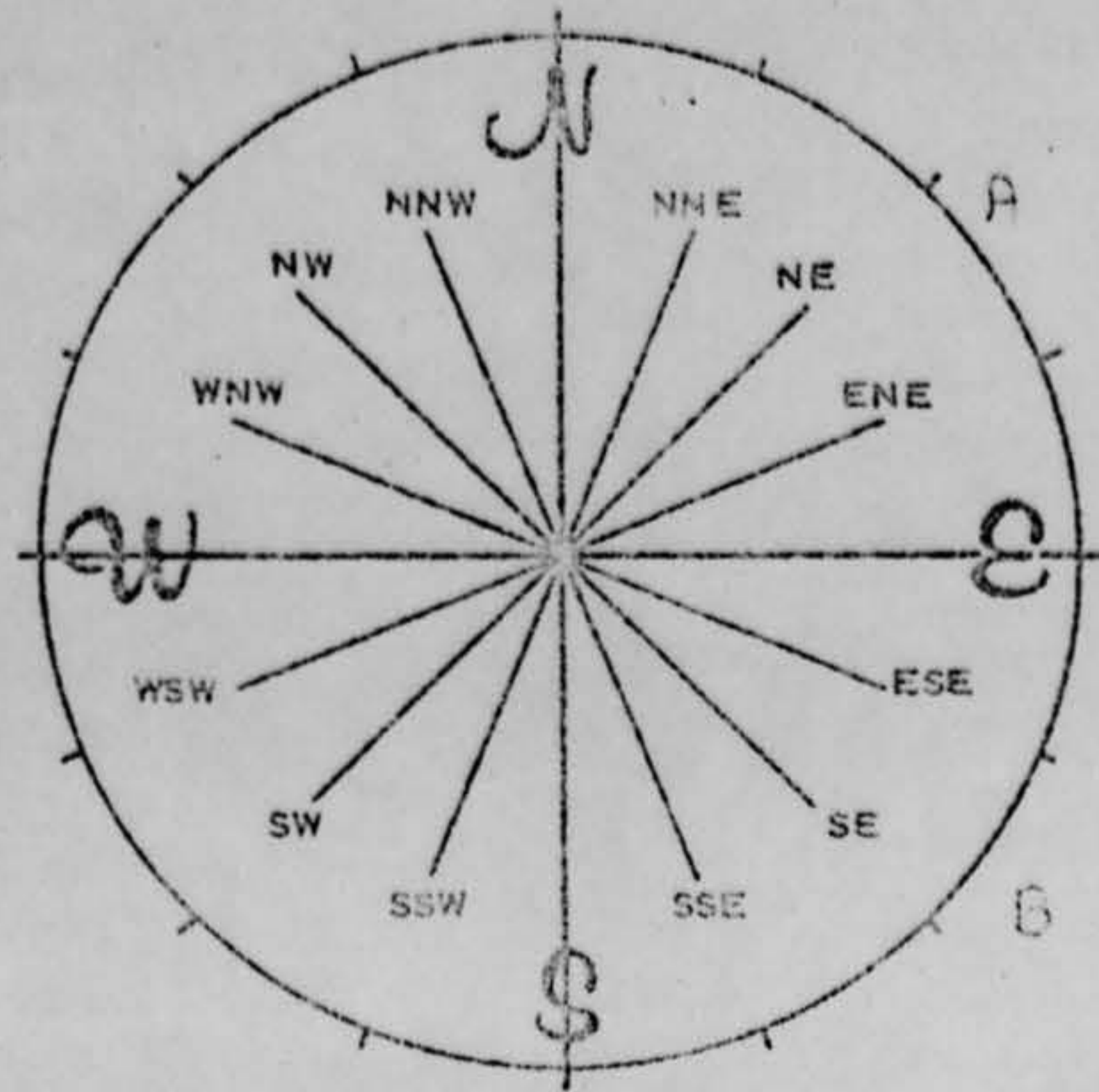
