SUBJECT: Morris BLOCK, American Delegate to the Sixth  
World Youth Festival

1. During the debriefing of Agency-sponsored American delegate to the Sixth World Youth Festival, <sup>D4</sup>[George ABRAMS], the following information was obtained concerning Morris BLOCK, a delegate at the Youth Festival.

2. <sup>D4</sup>[ABRAMS] reported that BLOCK had originally applied to Barbara FERRY for a position on the American Delegation to the Moscow Youth Festival. His application was so pro-communistic that Perry rejected it because she wanted no Communists on the American Delegation.

3. <sup>O4</sup>[ABRAMS] also reported that Jake ROSEN with Fred JEROME had obtained a Chicago post office box under the alias of Walter HIRSCH. Selected Americans whom FERRY rejected as delegates were in turn contacted by ROSEN and JEROME through the Chicago post office box. An article to this effect appeared in the 19 July, 1957 issue of The Washington Post & Times Herald.

4. <sup>O4</sup>[ABRAMS] stated that after BLOCK had been rejected by FERRY, ROSEN had contacted BLOCK and had arranged for BLOCK to go to the Festival with a Canadian group. [ABRAMS] speculated that perhaps all the Americans who went with the Canadian group might be more pro-communist than the rest of the Festival delegates.
