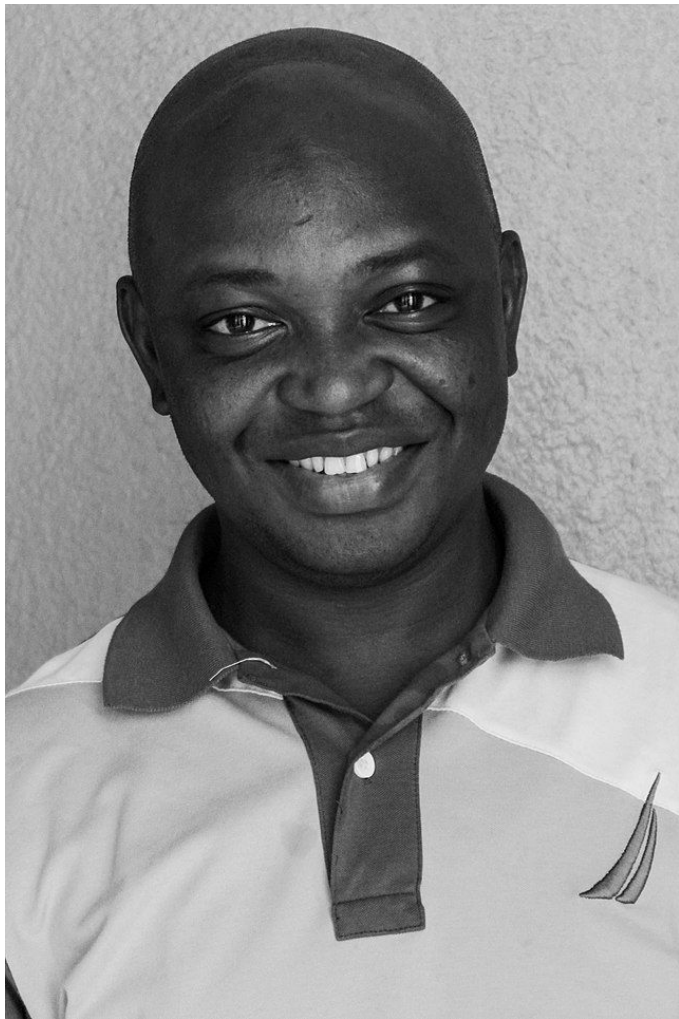

Wikibase expresses relationships in the form triples that use Items (starting with Q) and Properties (starting with P)

Douglas Adams (**Q42**) was educated at (**P69**) St John's College (**Q691283**)
