Donald; and is butting and bounding, Northwardly, on the other moiety or half part of the said Lot, devised by the said Samuel Wainwright to Richard Wainwright, Eastwardly on the Presbyterian Church Yard, Southwardly on a Lot belonging to Miss Catherine Cox, and Westwardly on the said Street.
