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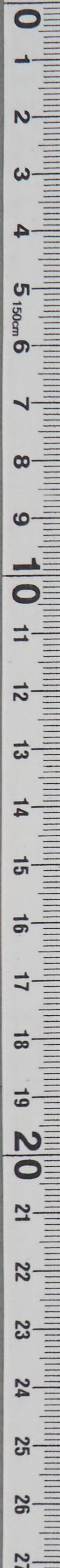

1. The Greek Battalion has arrived in Pusan. This office knows of no recommendations for Liaison Officers accredited to this headquarters. In view of the absence of a Greek Diplomatic Mission in Tokyo, it is considered imperative that at least two (2) Greek Liaison Officers be provided as soon as possible. All armed forces of the United Nations operating in Korea have Liaison Officers present in Tokyo with the exception of Korea and The Netherlands. Liaison Officers for Korea are not considered necessary and The Netherlands Mission is taking steps to appoint Dutch Liaison Officers.

2. Experience to date has indicated that either Liaison Officers or representatives of the Diplomatic Mission are required to handle the many problems arising from the procedure involved in logistical support.

3. It is recommended that the attached proposed radio (Tab "A") to Department of the Army be approved for dispatch.

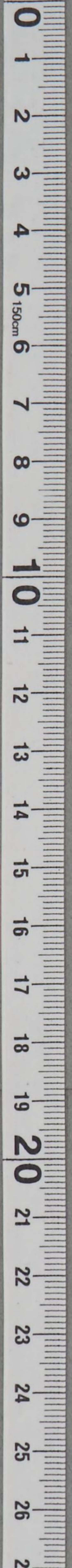

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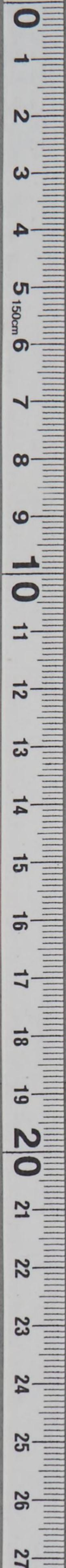
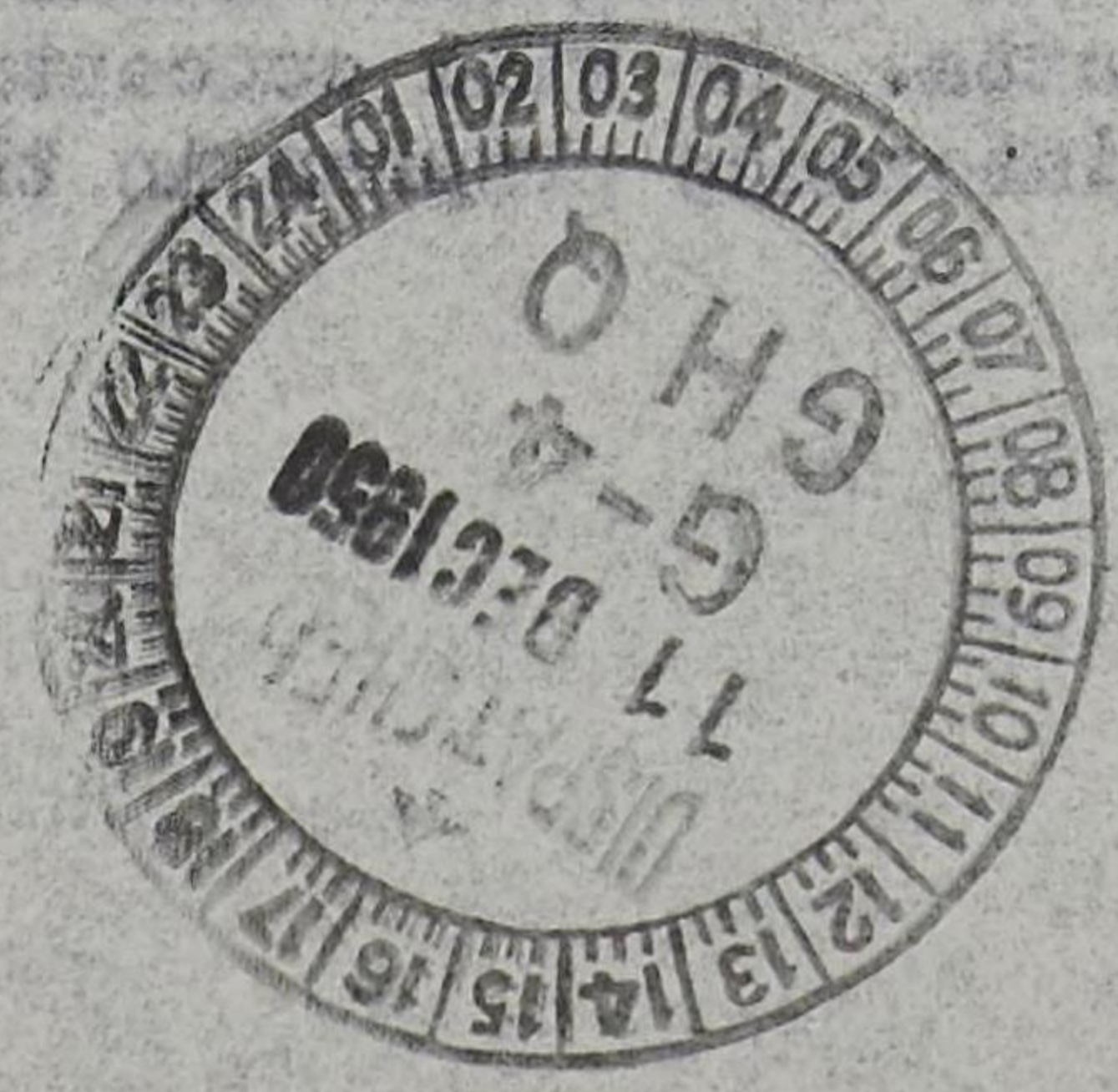

that the lessons learned in this relatively new Ordnance field, which is now undergoing its first "battle-test" in Korea, are brought to the attention of the proper authorities.

4. There are two officers presently in the FEC who possess the qualifications set forth above:

Major Lovett has been in command of the 47th Ord IAM Co. and is well qualified to coordinate light aviation maintenance and supply problems. Major Lovett is surplus in grade with the 47th IAM Co. due to his recent promotion.

5. It is recommended that should neither of the officers referred to above be available for assignment to the Ord Section, GHQ, a radio request be dispatched to the D/A requesting a qualified Ord Officer for this position. A vacancy for a field grade officer exists in the Ord Section, GHQ, T/D.

SUBJECT: Duty Officer Coverage

1. For additional background see G-4 Journal No. 15553.
2. In brief the above action concerns the Medical Section request that they no longer be required to maintain a 24 hour duty officer in office of the Medical Section. A check made of all Tech Service Sections showed that each Tech Service was operating on 24 hour duty officer basis. Part 1. For CG Army Eight. Desire all ANC offs who have completed 90 days duty in Korea and who desire rotation to Japan be trfd immediately to JLCCOM upon arrival in Korea of ANC officer repls from JLCCOM. Furnish CG JLCCOM soonest by electrical transmission names, grades, SN, MOS, eligible ANC officers desiring such transfer and request CG JLCCOM furnish assignment instructions, to include unit destinations within his command for each officer.

Part 2. For CG JLCCOM. Upon receipt information concerning ANC officers to be transferred, furnish CG Army Eight detailed assignment instructions indicated in Part 1 above and transfer immediately replacements equal to number ANC officers being transferred your command from Army Eight. Prior to shipping repls to Korea request CG Army Eight furnish assignment instructions, to include unit destinations within his command.

Part 3. For CG Army Eight and CG JLCCOM. To implement these instructions direct communication between your commands is authorized. It is desired that transfer of these officers between your commands under authority contained this message be accomplished in orderly manner, with minimum disruption to medical service, utilizing most appropriate means transportation. In all cases replacements from JLCCOM will arrive at unit destinations in Korea prior to release eligible officers from Army Eight. Furnish CINCFE info copies all messages and Special Orders issued your commands effecting transfer, indicating names, grades, SN, MOS, ANC officers transferred. Authority contained this message expires 1 Dec current unless sooner terminated by CINCFE.

G1, JLCOM (Lt Col Leigh) states C/S, JLCOM concurred in ppsd plan. CN#2 from G1 to C/S recms apvl in dispatch of inst msg and was coordinated with AG (Lt Col Craig). C/S approved 19 Oct 50.

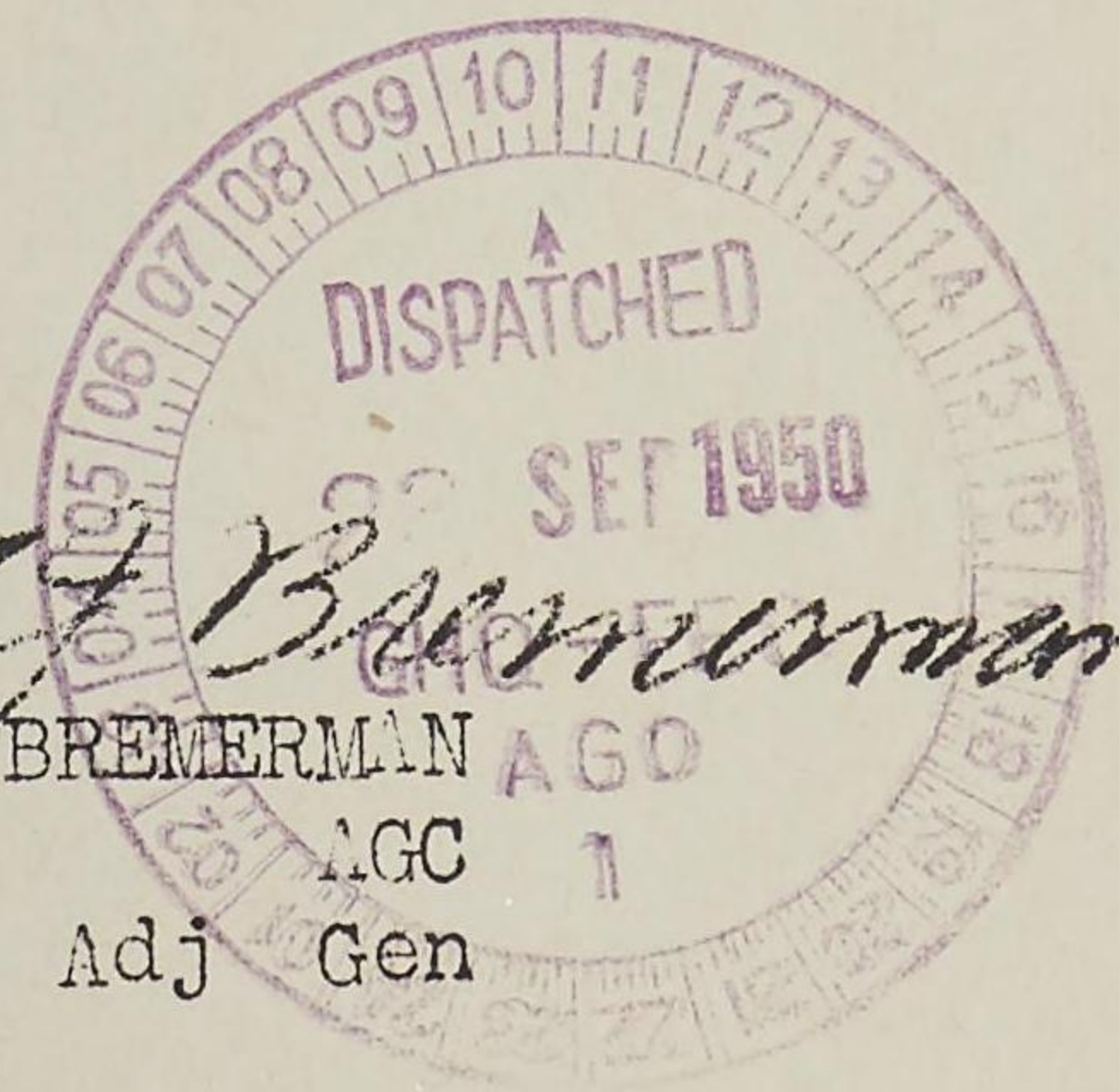

1. Paragraphs 11b and 16c, AR 605-200, are rescinded.
2. So much of the provisions of paragraphs 3b, 10b and 15b, AR 605-200, which are in conflict with the following policy are suspended until further notice. Commanders of oversea theaters and continental armies are authorized to accomplish in accordance with Sections II and III, AR 605-200, the following actions without reference to the Department of the Army, when and only when such actions are recommended by a Board of Inquiry. All other types of cases will continue to be processed as heretofore and forwarded to the Department of the Army for final action:
 - a. Relief from active duty of non-regular commissioned officers.
 - b. Demotion of non-regular commissioned officers from current temporary grade to a lower temporary grade or to permanent grade.
 - c. Demotion of Regular Army commissioned officers from current temporary grade to a lower temporary grade or to permanent grade.
 - d. Disapprove a Board of Inquiry and convening authority's recommendation for demotion to a lower temporary grade or to permanent grade, or relief from active duty, and retain the officer on active duty in current grade. In these cases officer will be reassigned if such action is in the best interests of the service and the individual.
 - e. Disapprove the convening authority's recommendation of retention on active duty in current grade, when the Board of Inquiry has recommended relief from active duty or demotion to a lower temporary grade, or to permanent grade.

3. This authority does not apply to cases involving general officers or warrant officers, nor does it apply to cases involving demotion to a grade lower than the present permanent grade in the Regular Army, Organized Reserve Corps or National Guard of the United States. Such cases will be forwarded to The Adjutant General for final action.

4. Upon demotion of officer to temporary grade lower than temporary grade held 7 August 1947 (effective date of Officer Personnel Act, Section 515c, WD Bulletin 18, 1947), orders will terminate present temporary appointment and any other temporary appointments made after 6 August 1947, and will make new appointment in lower grade. Oath of office is required. Orders will read as follows: "By direction of the President your temporary appointment(s) as (grade or grades) AUS is(are) terminated effective (date) and under the provisions of subsections 515(c) and (d) Officer Personnel Act of 1947, you are, with your consent, appointed and commissioned in the Army of the United States in the grade of (grade) effective (date - one day later than above termination date) and you will continue on extended active duty. This appointment will remain in effect during period of this tour of active duty and will terminate immediately upon relief therefrom. Oath of office (WD AGO Form 71) for this AUS appointment will be executed and immediately forwarded to the headquarters tendering this appointment."

5. Upon demotion of officer to temporary grade the same as, or higher than, temporary grade held on 7 August 1947 orders will terminate all temporary appointments to grades higher than the grade to which demoted and will revert officer to grade to which demoted. Oath not required. Orders will read as follows: "By direction of the President your temporary appointment(s) or (grade or grades) AUS is(are) terminated effective (date) and you will revert to your (temporary or permanent, whichever is applicable) grade of (grade) in the (Army of the United States, Regular Army of the United States, Organized Reserve Corps or National Guard of the United States, whichever is applicable) effective (date - one day later than above termination date), and will continue on extended active duty."

6. Non-regular officers who refuse demotion under this policy will be required to so state in writing and will be relieved from extended active duty.

7. Orders relieving officers from active duty will show as authority Section II or III, AR 605-200, whichever is appropriate, and Section 515(d) Officer Personnel Act of 1947, WD Bulletin 18, 1947.

8. A complete copy of each case on which final action is taken will be forwarded to The Adjutant General, Attention: AGPO-S and will include, as appropriate, three (3) copies of the relief reversion or demotion order, oath of office and one (1) copy of appointment letter. Case will be forwarded by letter of transmittal quoting this letter as authority.

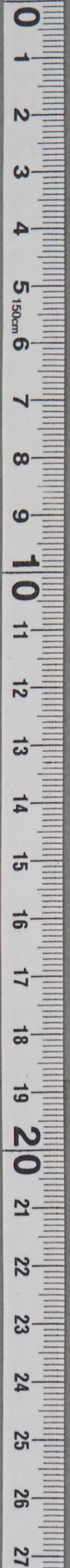

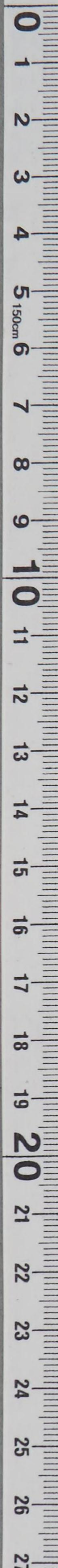

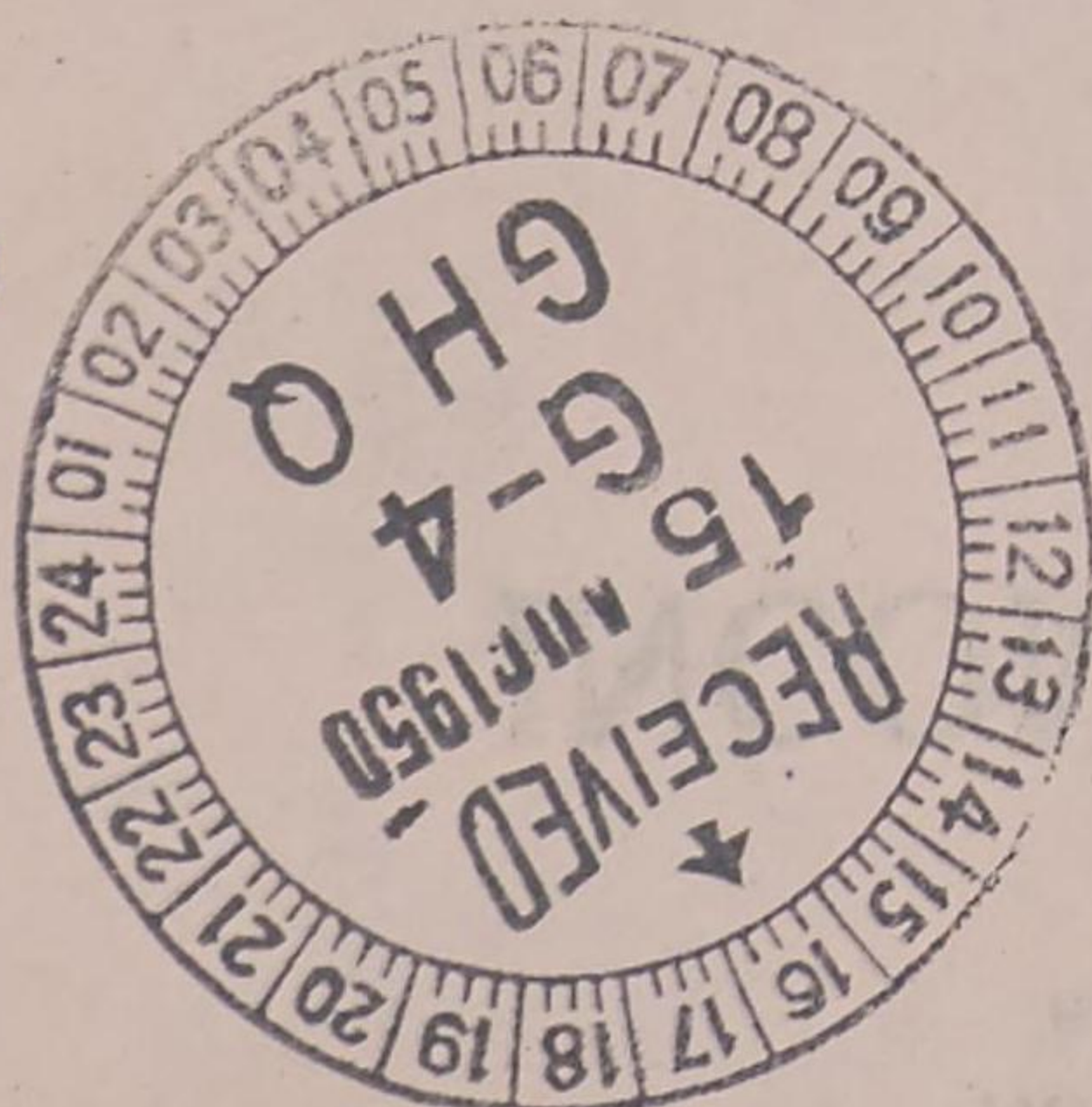

b. Para 6b: Delete 1st sentence.

c. Para 7: Delete

d. Para 8, change to read: Selection lists with RA officers in order of permanent seniority and non-RA officers in order of temporary seniority will be furnished the selection board. Selection lists will contain RA and non-RA officers in direct proportion to the total number of each group serving in the grade concerned. 1. Pending publication of amendment to SR 615-105-1, non-regular officers and warrant officers now on extended active duty who were serving in enlisted status in active federal service on or before 7 December 1941 will henceforth be enlisted, on separation from officer or warrant officer status under honorable conditions, in the temporary pay grade held on their discharge from active enlisted federal service to accept commission or warrant officer appointment. The individual must enlist on the day following separation from officer or warrant officer status to take advantage of this provision. This does not affect the eligibility of an officer or warrant officer to be enlisted under the National Defense Act in the permanent enlisted pay grade held in the Regular Army on discharge, within six months of separation from officer or warrant officer status.

2. In implementation of the foregoing policy, officers or warrant officers who held the grade of first sergeant, whether permanent or temporary, will be authorized to enlist in Grade E-7.

3. Pending publication of amendment to SR 135-215-5, the following changes are effective immediately:

"5. Applications for renewal of category. All officers who are qualified under the provisions of paragraph 4 and who desire extended active duty beyond the expiration date of current category will submit letter of application for new category. The letter will be in sufficient copies so that two signed copies will be available for transmittal to The Adjutant General. Application will be submitted not earlier than 8 months nor later than 6 months prior to expiration of current category, except that should an officer be promoted during the six-month period prior to his separation he may apply for a new category.

"a. Officers' applications will contain the following statement: 'Under provisions of SR 135-215-5, 27 May 1949, as changed, the undersigned desires to serve on extended active duty in Category _____ to be effective _____ and expiring _____. My present category expires _____. I understand that if this request for the renewal of my category is approved by The Adjutant General, such approval is considered to be an official statement of my new category in accordance with paragraph 6f of SR 135-215-5, 27 May 1949 as changed.'

"b. Officers who do not desire to apply for a new category during the prescribed time limits will be required to sign a statement in duplicate substantially as follows: 'I have this date been afforded an opportunity to apply for a new category as provided in paragraph 5, SR 135-215-5, 27 May 1949, as changed, and do not desire to do so. I understand that I may not be permitted to apply for a new category at a later date.' The original state-

ment will be placed in the officer's field military 201 file and one copy will be forwarded to The Adjutant General, Attention AGPO-S-C.

"6. Processing of applications.

"a. Applications will be forwarded as follows:

(1) Department of the Army agencies (reference D/A Memo 230-10-1, 28 March 1950 and commanders of Class II installations will forward two signed copies of each application direct to The Adjutant General, Attention: AGPO-S-C, for final action.

(2) Applications of Army Officers serving with the Department of the Air Force will be processed under the provisions of these regulations, except commands normally commanded by a general officer will forward applications to Headquarters, Department of the Air Force, for transmittal to The Adjutant General.

(3) Applications of Army officers serving with the Department of the Navy will be forwarded to The Adjutant General, Attention: AGPA-A, through the local naval commander and the Army unit of administrative attachment.

(4) Two signed copies of all other applications except those under paragraph 4c above, will be forwarded by the command normally commanded by a general officer to The Adjutant General, Attention: AGPO-S-C. Major commanders may direct that applications be forwarded through their commands.

"b. Applications will be forwarded through channels and each indorsement will indicate a recommendation for approval or disapproval, with detailed reasons in all cases for the latter. Disapproval will be recommended if the officer does not qualify under paragraph 4 above, or is considered undesirable for further retention on extended active duty by reason of relatively low efficiency, inaptness, misconduct, lack of attention to duty, lack of initiative, or other cogent reasons.

"c. After final action each application will be returned through the same channels to the organization having custody of the officer's records for inclusion in his field military 201 file. Appropriate entries will be made in items 11 and 22 of WD AGO Form 66 (Officers', Warrant Officers' and Flight Officers' Qualification Record) and on unit morning report, indicating new category and date of expiration. New categories will be computed as beginning the first day of the month following the expiration date of current categories. Categories I, II, or V signed in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 4b and c will expire on the last day of the month in which the officer reaches the maximum age in grade.

"d. A signed copy of action taken under paragraph 4c above will be forwarded to The Adjutant General, Attention: AGPO-S-C.

"8b. An officer with less than 1 year to serve in his category before arrival overseas will not be given an oversea assignment. When the rotation policy requires that such an individual be selected for oversea assignment, he will be given an opportunity to apply for a new category. Officers who do not desire to apply for a new category during the prescribed time limits will be required to sign a statement in duplicate in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 5b.

"d. An officer with less than 6 months to serve in his category who is not eligible for renewal of category or who does not desire to apply for a new category (par 5b) will not be reported for reassignment prior to return from overseas, but will be returned to the ZI, upon completion of his overseas tour, for separation. However, oversea commanders and commanding generals of military missions may approve applications to extend oversea tours of such officers to retain them until expiration of categories.

"e. An officer serving in an oversea command who will have more than eight months to serve in his category upon departure from the oversea command but will have less than six months upon reporting for duty at his assigned station in the ZI will apply for a new category or sign a statement in accordance with par 5b prior to his departure from the oversea command. Application will be processed as outlined in paragraph 6.

"13. Enlistment in Grade E-7:--The opportunity for each officer who was on active duty on 22 March 1948 to enlist in Grade E-7 is extended. If this extension is at any time terminated, all officers affected will be protected until the expiration of the category in which they are then serving or until separation prior to its expiration under other provisions of regulations. Such officers may enlist in Grade E-7 upon relief from active duty under honorable conditions upon expiration of category or prior to expiration of category provided such enlistment occurs the day following separation. Under the provisions of Public Law 350, 80th Congress (WD Bul 19, 1947), accrued leave will be carried over into enlisted status and will not be liquidated by lump sum payment. An officer who received lump sum payment for accrued leave upon separation will not be enlisted in Grade E-7. This does not affect the eligibility of an officer who holds a permanent warrant in Grade E-7 to return to that pay grade within six months of separation, under the National Defense Act."

1. TM 12-406 titled "Officer Classification Commissioned and Warrant" provides a single unified system whereby classification of military occupational specialties of commissioned officers may be achieved. By making maximum use of education, training and aptitudes possessed by officers, it properly classifies them and places them in a position where best advantage is made of their knowledge. An examination of TM 12-406 will show that most of the subjects listed in the inclosure to C/N 1, giving the three fields, Engineering, Physical Science and Social Science will assist materially in providing the qualifications needed in many of the MOS's described therein.

2. Specifically, the G-4 Section is concerned with the functional groupings in this manual of (1) Procurement, Supply, Maintenance and Repair Service, and (2) Professional Engineering and related Technical Services. A check of MOS numbers in these groupings discloses for instance that a 4010 (Supply and Evacuation Staff Officer) can be much more valuable if he has had some work in the Automotive field or Communications Engineering. Similarly in the social science field an officer with Business Administration, Industrial Engineering, or Economics graduate work is better fitted for the best solution of staff problems that present themselves in the G-4 Section.

3. It is not believed necessary to list specific positions as this is already done in the TM 12-406. Complete job requirements are described in detail. It is noticed that this paper has been given wide distribution and presumably those sections listed will present data of immediate concern to themselves.

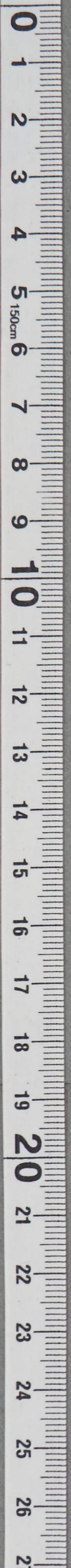

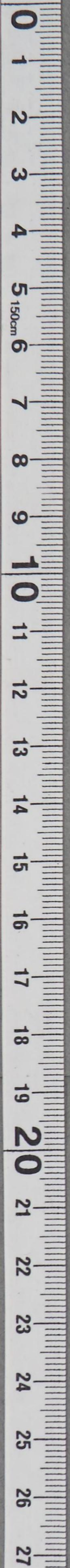
