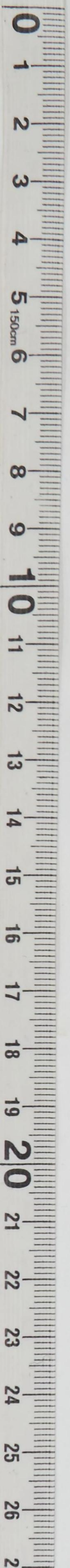

1. Reference is made to draft of Operations Instructions submitted for comment by C/N #1 above. The following comments are made:
 - a. In view of this being operations instructions the need for designation as Operation HEDGEROW is not understood. Reference to Operation HEDGEROW should be eliminated from heading and paragraphs 3a(11) and 3b(2).
 - b. Reference paragraph 3d of draft O.I. Assignment of general courts martial jurisdiction to Commanding General, Marianas-Bonins Command appears to consider traffic density being heavier between MARBO and Philippine Islands rather than true condition as being heavier between RYCOM and Philippine Islands.
2. Except as noted in paragraph 1 above, G-4 concurs in draft of Operations Instructions submitted by C/N #1 above.
3. Every effort will be made to submit Logistic Annex by 20 May 1949.

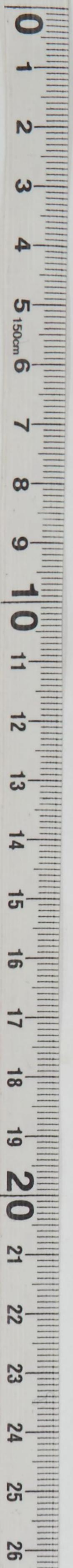

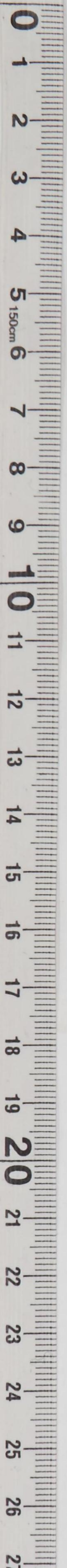

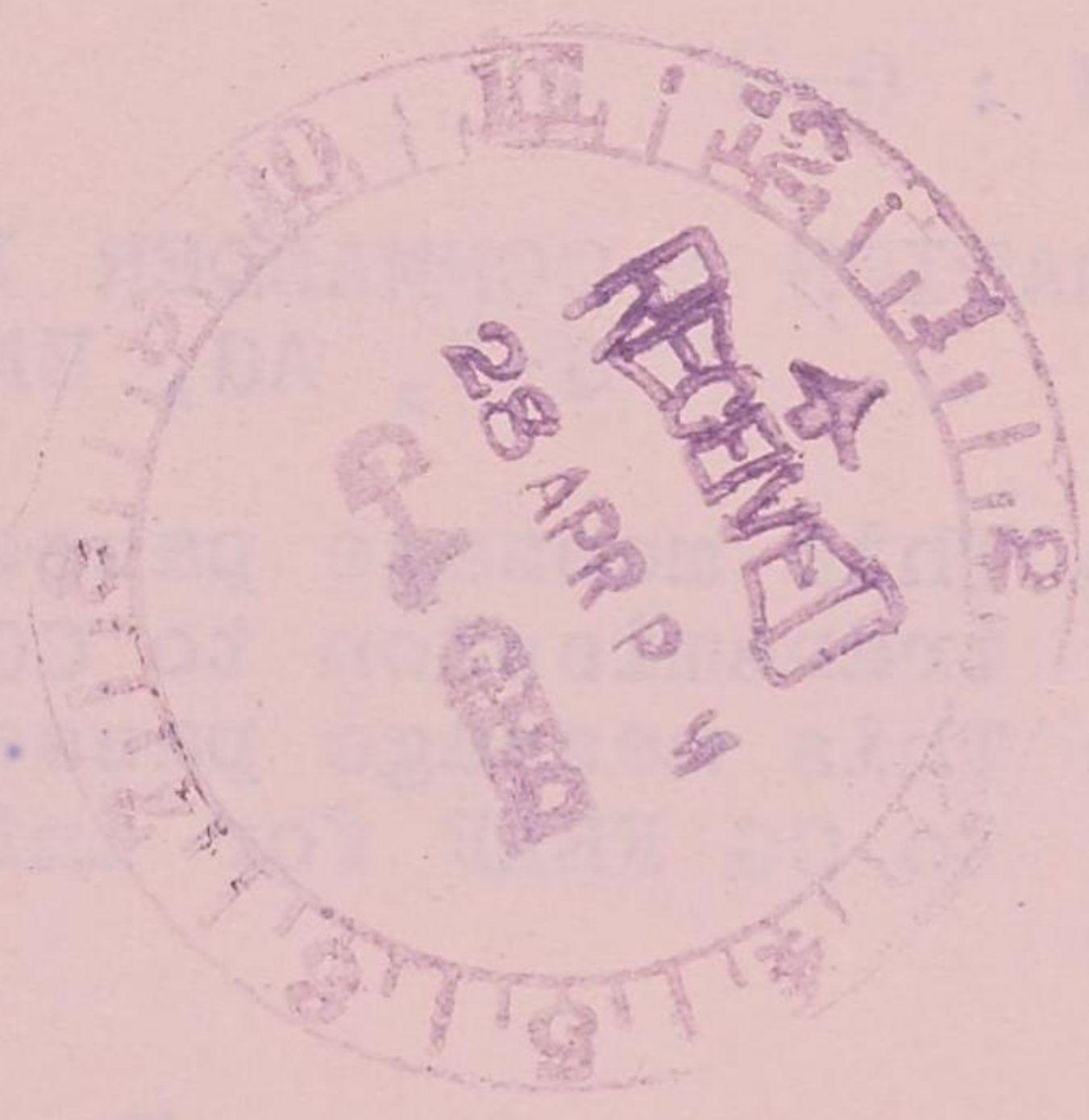
