- → We collaborate with schools and universities on education and vocational training regarding these subjects





Wiki loves monuments

- ---> Ranked 3rd internationally by number of photographers; 7th by uploads
- → 301 authorisations
- Tuscany ranked 1st in Italian region with the highest number of photos and photographed monuments, followed by Lombardy, Basilicata and Emilia Romagna
- ---> Collaboration with Deborah De Angelis (Creative Commons Italia) on giving legal assistence to municipalities, organisations and archaeological superintendences
- ---> Local editions in Abruzzo, Basilicata, Lake Como area, Liguria, Apulia and Tuscany.

4 • Education and vocational training, and cultural activities of social interest and with an educational purpose

(WMI Articles of Association, article 3)

- Wiki-imparare contest: 3,000€ to 15 institutes for the purchase of technological equipment that allows education and training activities on the Wikimedia and OpenStreetMap platforms to be completed in the school year 2020/21.
- Revised MIUR (Ministry of Education, University and Research) protocol: 3 accredited training courses for teachers that took place online between October and December 2020 with 100 teachers and 11 wikimedian and OSMer instructors.
- Diventa wiki-docente contest: for the continuing professional development of teachers during the pandemic period, proposing Wikimedia and OpenStreetMap projects as learning environments. 135 candidates from 17 Italian regions; 60 teachers completed the training course and received the course certificate.






