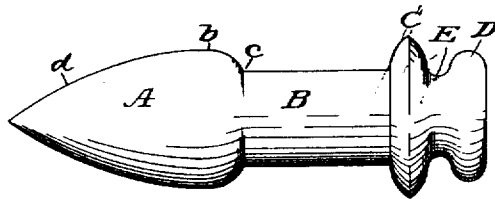

DESIGN FOR A RECTAL DILATOR.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 21,551, dated May 17, 1892.

Application filed April 20, 1892. Serial No. 429,955. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, FRANK E. YOUNG, a citizen of the United States, and a resident of Canton, county of Stark, State of Ohio, have
5 invented and produced a new Design for a Rectal Dilator, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, making part of this specification.

10 This invention relates to a new design for a rectal dilator, which may be wrought in any suitable material.

The figure of the accompanying drawing is a perspective of a rectal dilator, showing a
15 pointed end portion A, circumscribed by a circumferential surface line *d*, diverging to a point, (represented at *b*), from which point the line converges to the line *c*, connecting the olive-shaped front portion with a cylindrical
20 portion B, at the opposite end of which is an

annular flanged-out portion C. The spheroidal handle portion D is joined to the flange C by a neck, as E.

The leading features of this design are the olive-shaped end portion A, the cylindrical
25 body B, and the flanged-out portion C.

What I claim, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The design for a rectal dilator, as herein shown and described, the same consisting of
30 the smooth olive-shaped end portion A, the cylindrical body portion B, and the annular flange C, as set forth.
