

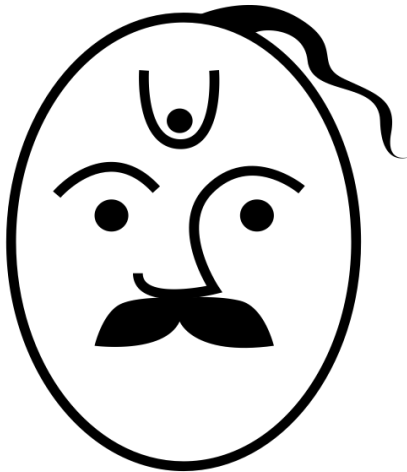
**“WikiTungi’s effort in localising the

What is Tungi?

The word Tungi is derived from an ancient practice of Odisha used for sharing the knowledge of scriptures among the villagers. A village scholar (Pandit) will read the Holy books (written in Sanskrit) translate it into Odia and explain the villagers.

 - Which helped in gathering Odia Wikipedia volunteers from different parts of Odisha and India.
 - The major outcome of these conferences is the digitisation drive by the community members.
 - The community has collaborated with 2 libraries in Odisha and is digitising books in there.

Relicensing Works



- Inspired from Euro Vision Contest, We thought to replicate the same in Asian Athletics Championships 2017.
 - Website relicensedd under CC-BY-SA 4.0
 - Many articles got their first images.
 - 268 images were acquired.
 - Collaborated with BDA for QRPedia projects.

 - After the first anniversary of Bhubaneswar WikiTungi, we adapted some new policies.
 - Inviting Global leaders for a hangout talk to share their projects.

 - We're failing to invite Wikipedians.
