



Earwig's Copyvio Detector Settings This tool attempts to detect copyright violations in articles. In search mode, it will check for similar content elsewhere on the web using Google, external links present in the text of the page, or Turnitin (via EranBot), depending on which options are selected. In comparison mode, the tool will compare the article to a specific webpage without making additional searches, like the Duplication Detector. Running a full check can take up to a minute if other websites are slow or if the tool is under heavy use. Please be patient. If you get a timeout, wait a moment and refresh the page. Be aware that other websites can copy from Wikipedia, so check the results carefully, especially for older or well-developed articles. Zebras (US: /ˈziːbrəz/, UK: /ˈzɛbrəz, ˈziː-/)^[1] (subgenus *Hippotigris*) are African equines with distinctive black-and-white striped coats. There are three living species: the Grévy's zebra (*Equus grevyi*), plains zebra (*E. quagga*), and the mountain zebra (*E. zebra*). Zebras share the genus *Equus* with horses and asses, the three groups being the only living members of the family Equidae. Zebra stripes come in different patterns, unique to each individual. Several theories have been proposed for the function of these stripes, with most evidence supporting them as a deterrent for biting flies. Zebras inhabit eastern and southern Africa and can be found in a variety of habitats such as savannahs,






- Lack of TypeScript typings for OOUI

- Interference from the real world
 - Graduation, and moving to the city













Regular suspected copyright infringements


