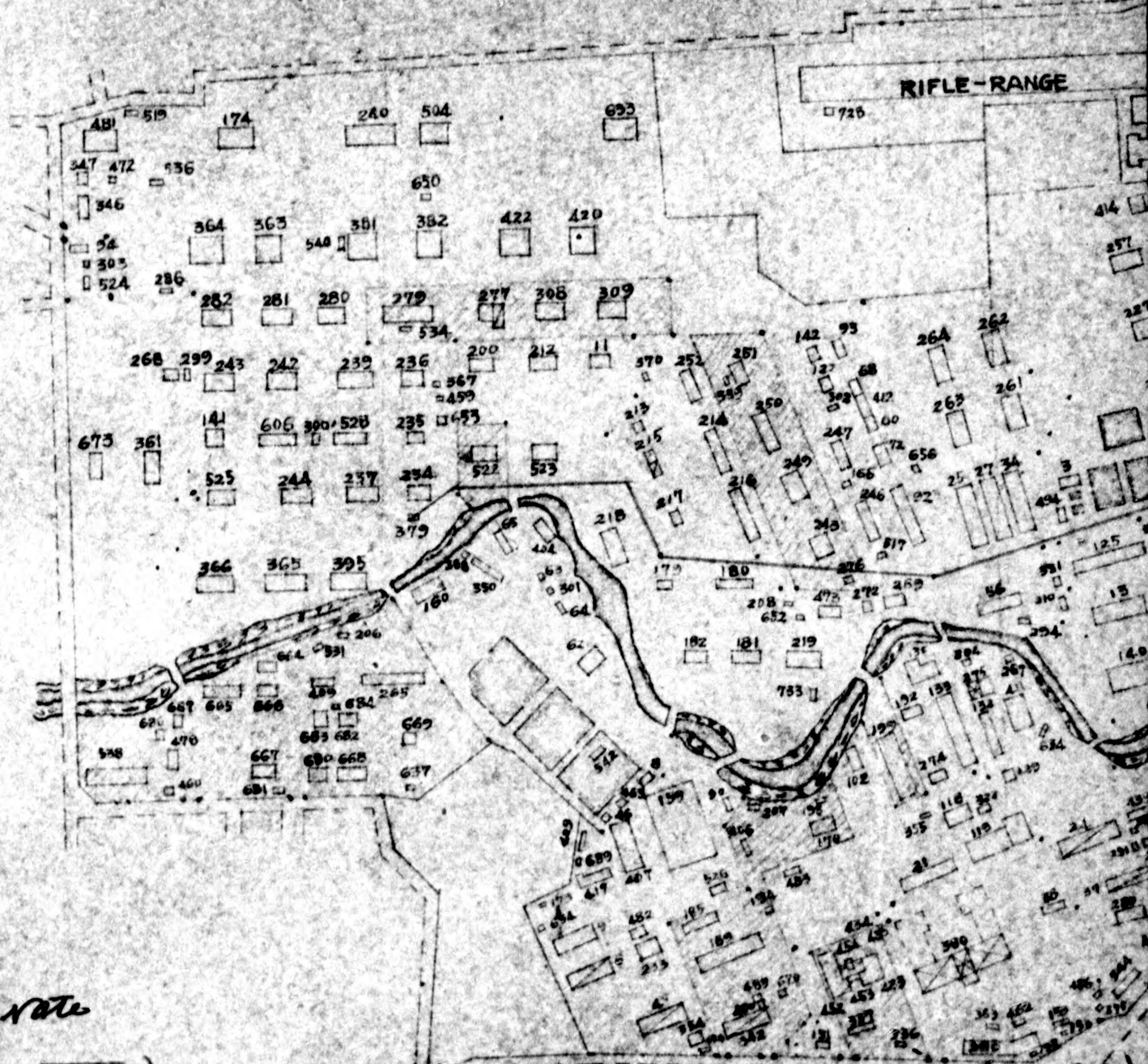

(旧東京第二陸軍造兵廠板橋工場構内図) SCALE - 1:400



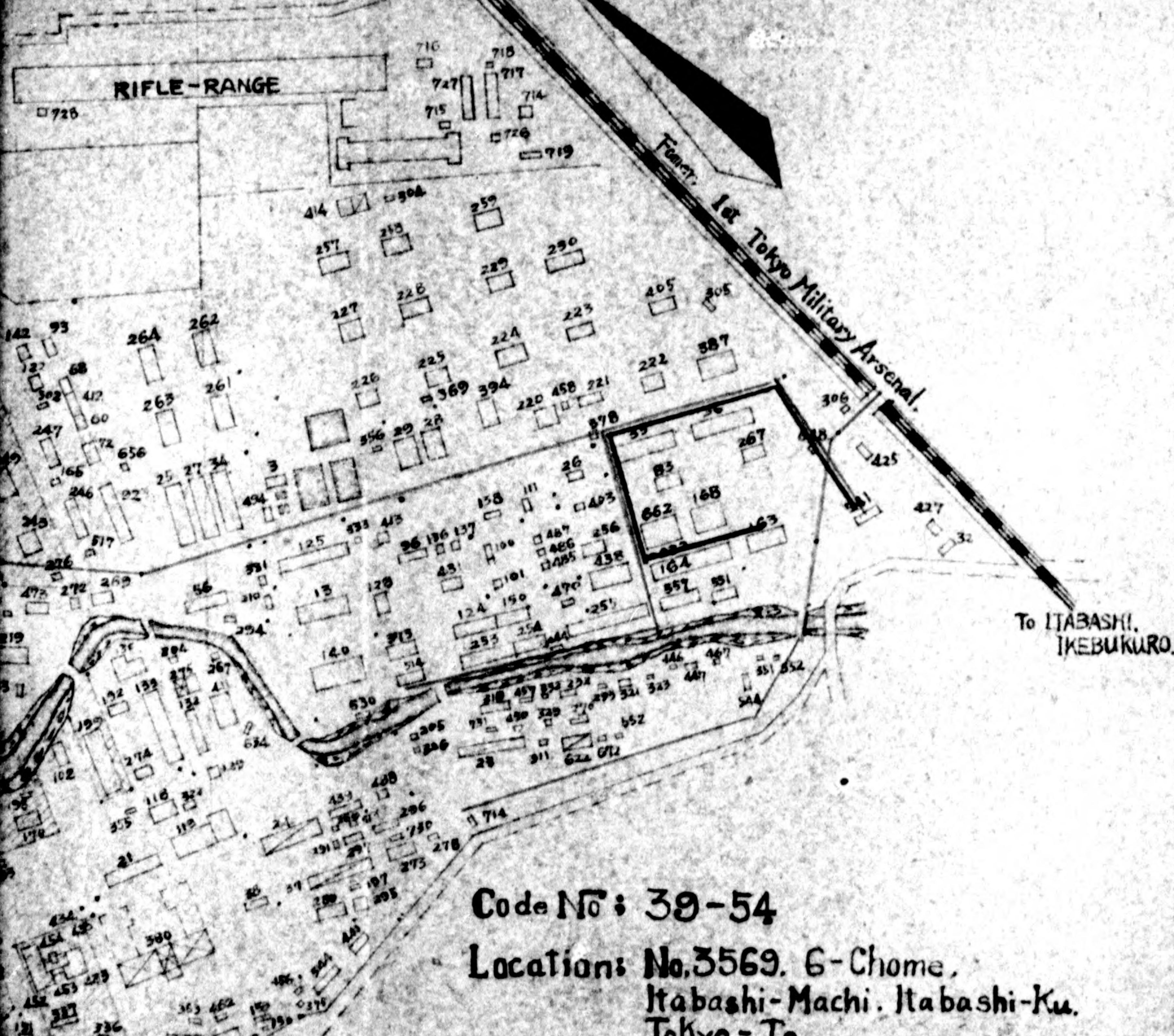




