CULTURE

Glads may be planted from May 1st to July 1st. They love the sunshine. Do not plant in shaded places, nor near foundation wall.

Ground that will grow smooth potatoes is suitable. Thoroughly work in pulverized sheep manure, wood ashes, well rotted manure, bone meal, or a good potato fertilizer. Never allow fresh manure to come in contact with the bulbs.

Plant three inches deep, four or five inches apart in rows. Add soil gradually until they are covered about six inches. Cultivate frequently. Keep free from weeds. Do not allow the ground to become hard or crusted over.

If necessary to water, do so thoroughly.

Cut the stalk in the morning when first bud opens and place in cold water in a vase in the house. Change the water each morning, remove all wilted blossoms, and slice slantingly about one-half inch from the bottom of stalk each day. Make sure to leave at least four leaves when cutting, to mature the bulbs.

Dig when the leaves turn brown, cut tops off close to bulb and store in light, airy place until dried. Remove all old corms and roots, and store in a light, cool, frost-proof cellar in receptacles not over four inches in depth.
