Myosotis pansa is in the plant family Boraginaceae and was originally described as a variety of Myosotis petiolata Taxonomy and etymology [edit source] in 1961 by Lucy Moore.<sup>[3]</sup> It was raised to species level as Myosotis pansa (L.B.Moore) Meudt, Prebble, R.J.Stanley and Thorsen in 2013.<sup>[4]</sup> Myosotis pansa is morphologically most similar to the other North Island species, M. petiolata and M. pottsiana.<sup>[4]</sup> These three species are allopatric in their geographic distributions, and can be distinguished from one another by a suite of characters that includes corolla diameter (M. pansa: 7.6–14.3




