Myosotis pansa is a species of flowering plant in the family **Boraginaceae**, endemic to the North Island of New Zealand. Lucy Moore described the variety *M. petiolata* var. *pansa* in 1961, and it was raised to species level as *M. pansa* by Heidi Meudt, Jessica Prebble, Rebecca Stanley and Michael Thorsen in 2013. Plants of this species of forget-me-not are perennial rosettes with ebracteate (or partially bracteate) inflorescences and white corollas and exerted anthers.

Taxonomy and etymology [edit source]

Myosotis pansa is in the plant family **Boraginaceae** and was originally described as a variety of *Myosotis petiolata* in 1961 by Lucy Moore.^[3] It was raised to species level as *Myosotis pansa* (L.B.Moore) Meudt, Prebble, R.J.Stanley and Thorsen in 2013.^[4] *Myosotis pansa* is morphologically most similar to the other North Island species, *M. petiolata* and *M. pottsiana*.^[4] These three species are allopatric in their geographic distributions, and can be distinguished from one another by a suite of characters that includes corolla diameter (*M. pansa*: 7.6–14.3 mm; *M. pottsiana*: 5.3–9.8 mm; and *M. petiolata*: 4.2–10.5 mm).



The lectotype specimen of *Myosotis pansa* was collected by Donald Petrie, south of Karekare, Waitakere, Auckland, and is lodged at the Museum of New Zealand Te Papa Tongarewa, Wellington (WELT SP002432).^{[4][5]}

The specific epithet, *pansa*, is based on the Latin word *pansus* which means to spread out. Lucy Moore did not explain why she chose this name,^[3] but it could refer to the spreading petal lobes mentioned in her description.^[4]

Two subspecies are recognized: *Myosotis pansa* subsp. *pansa* and *M. pansa* subsp. *praecipens*.^[4] The subspecies are allopatric, and can be
