

# 2. USA - Flash Floods

Heavy rains, flash floods affected refugee camps for children under 5. Missouri, Kansas, Oklahoma, Arkansas, Tennessee. 2 people killed, 5. Nigeria - Floods >100 buildings damaged in Missouri.

### 3. Mali - Refugees

226 returned to Timbuktu from camp in Mauritania. Needs in Timbuktu 6. Bosnia Herzegovina - Fire remain high for the local population.

### 4. Niger - Nutrition Crisis

Riverside county, California: 20% Overall malnutrition rate at 13.3%. 6 injured, 26 homes Severe acute malnutrition at 2.6%; 7. Uganda - Floods particularly affected. Nutritional situation critical in Malian

Hundreds homeless in northern Katsina state, homes and farmland in Somalia and Dabaab in Kenya. destroyed, Kankia Dam collapsed.

Croatian aircrafts operating.

Agadez, Maradi, Dosso and Diffa Unyama river overflowed in Northern Region. 6,000 displaced on 8 August.

### 8. Ethiopia – Health

22 July: 141 cases of yellow fever in 10. Somalia - Security immunization following polio outbreak Shabaab; 1 Turkish security member 13. Philippines - Tropical Cyclone

9. Somalia - Polio outbreak 95 Wild Polio Virus cases plus 3 Acute 11. Pakistan – Floods Jablanica fire still active on 8 Aug, 2 Flaccid Paralysis cases since May.

WHO vaccinated 4 million people monsoon floods since 1 August. 11 against polio. Access to 600 000 relief camps in Punjab, 4 in Sindh. children in south-central areas Rescue and relief activities continue. difficult due to insecurity. Vaccination campaign affected by \$14 million 12. China - Severe Weather shortcut.
