

## **SITUATION**

- · An intense low pressure system (named "Storm Katie") formed over the Atlantic Ocean and moved over the southern UK on 28 March. Heavy rains, strong winds and storm surge affected several areas of the UK and northern France over 27-29 March.
- United Kingdom: Media reported one person missing, several homes damaged and over 100 000 homes without electricity in southern England and Wales, as of 29 March.
- France: Media reported nearly 60 000 people without electricity in northern France, as well as two people injured in Paris, as of 29 March.
- Over the next 24 h locally heavy rains and winds may still affect southern UK and northern France, as well as some areas of northern Europe (see MeteoAlarm alerts in effect in the map).
