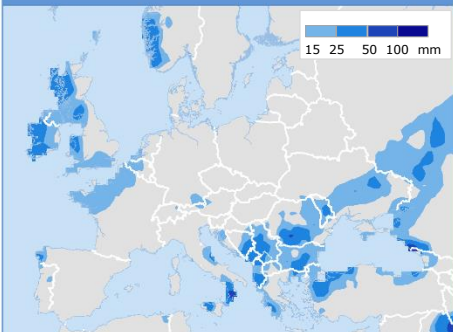


SITUATION

- An intense low pressure system (named **"Storm Katie"**) formed over the Atlantic Ocean and moved over the southern UK on 28 March. **Heavy rains, strong winds and storm surge** affected several areas of the **UK** and northern **France** over **27-29 March**.
- United Kingdom:** Media reported one person missing, several homes damaged and over 100 000 homes without electricity in southern England and Wales, as of 29 March.
- France:** Media reported nearly 60 000 people without electricity in northern France, as well as two people injured in Paris, as of 29 March.
- Over the next 24 h locally heavy rains and winds may still affect southern UK and northern France, as well as some areas of northern Europe (see MeteoAlarm alerts in effect in the map).
