Cabinet Order No. 331

Cabinet Order for Partial Amendments to the Cabinet Order for the Restrictions on Operation Area of Fishing Boat

In accordance with the Ordinance concerning the Orders to be issued in Consequence of the Acceptance of the Potsdam Declaration (Imperial Ordinance No. 542 of 1945), the Cabinet establishes this Cabinet Order.

The Cabinet Order for the Restrictions on Operation Area of Fishing Boat (Cabinet Order No. 306 of 1949) shall be partially amended as follows:

The heading of Article 4 shall be amended as "(Obligation of Reporting of Positions, etc.)" and in paragraph 1 of the same Article, "shall, as may be determined by the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry and the Minister of Telecommunications, report the position of the fishing boat (including the fishing boat trailed by mother ship in case of steamship drawing net fishery) at noon every day to the Director of Fishery Agency or the fishery inspector on the fishery inspection boat through wireless telegraph or wireless telephone" shall be amended as "shall report those matters requested by the Director of Fisheries Agency or the fisheries inspector on board fisheries inspection boat, being deemed necessary to be reported by him from the standpoint of fisheries control, immediately through wireless telegraph or wireless telephone, as may be determined by the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry and the Radio Regulatory Commission."

In Article 5, "five days" shall be amended as "three days"; "seven days," as "five days"; and "ten days," as "seven days."

Article 6 shall be amended as follows:

Article 6. In cases where any case of violation of the provisions of Article 3 has been found, the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry or the governor of To, Do, Fu or prefecture may cancel the license for fisheries concerned granted under the Fisheries Law (Law No. 267 of 1949) for the person who operated the fisheries using the fishing boat concerned, or may order him to anchor the fishing boat concerned, designating its anchoring port and period.

2 In cases where any person conducting the navigation or fishery operation of a fishing boat has been condemned to a penalty on the charge of violation of the provision of Article 3 paragraph 1, if there is any fisheries license granted for the fishing boat concerned, such license shall lose its effect at the time when the decision concerned has been settled.

Article 10 item (2) shall be made item (3); and the following one item shall be added next to item (1):

(2) Any person who has violated the anchoring order as prescribed in Article 6 paragraph 1.

Supplementary Provisions:

- 1. This Cabinet Order shall come into force as from the day after ten days have passed reckoning from the day of its promulgation.
- 2. The application of the penal provisions to the acts committed prior to the enforcement of this Cabinet Order shall be as heretofore even after the enforcement of this Cabinet Order.




