Chuo Fogy F.K. (Central Industrial Co.)

I. Introduction:

Chuo Fogyo F.K. (Central Industrial Co.) also known as Showa Seisakusho was established in 1928 with a capitalization of 1,000,000 yen by Okura and Company.

The main products manufactured by Chuo Kogyo, K. . include aircraft and armament parts, general ordnance, machine guns, generator motors, for aircraft and link trainers. Most of the ork is done for Army and Navy arsenals and Army flying schools.

In 1937 the company was greatly expanded for war production. Its capitalization was increased to 10,000,000 ym and several new plants were built. The factories ar located as follows:

1. Tokio, Omori ku, Tsutsumihata machi, 232

2. Tokio, Oji ku Inatsuki, Nishi m chi, 5 chome 1

3. Tokio refecture Kita Tama gun, Kokubunji Mura Honda Shinden

4. Spitama profecture, Mita Adachi gun Niikura Mura Matsu kago, 4500

During the period from January 1,1937 to the beginning of 1941 Chuo Kogyo . . . placed a small number of orders for machine tools in the United Stats. All of these transactions were handled by Okura and Co. except a f w orders thich for placed through Mitsui and Co. Ltd.

During this period inquiries are lso made in Germany and Great Britain. Some of these inquiries are included in the following tabulations. It is quite possible that a large number of machine tools were ordered from Germany and Great Britain in this period. This would explain the small amount of orders placed in the United States.

This report is one of a series being made ofter an examination of the files of the leading Japanese trading companies which are being held in a warehous- at 27 Cliff' Strrrt, New York, N.Y. by the Alien Property Custodian.

1. Letter from Berlin to Tokio, dated August 22, 1939 states that Chuo Fogyo placed an inquiry with Herbert Lindner Co. of Berlin, for 1 als Jig boring machine. Herbert Lindner was not able to quote for this business as the order for the machine had be a already placed subject to Government permission between their Japanese representative and Chuo Kogyo.
