 - "Not going to happen" closure of ANI: Ban Wikiproject conservatism, as well as any existing or future politically-aligned wikiprojects


Individual right-of-center editor banning & harassment

WP:RSN

Targeting right-of-center sources

- Numerous sources which are right-of-center listed as non-reliable sources
- Disproportionate compared to left-of-center sources listed as non-reliable sources

WP:RSN Outcomes



- Potential article topics, which receive significant coverage from right-of-center sources likely not to pass Notability requirements
- Potential article topics which receive significant coverage from left-of-center sources likely to pass Notability requirements
- Weight of right-of-center POVs regarding notable subjects likely not to be included unless covered by mainstream media source, or left-of center sources
