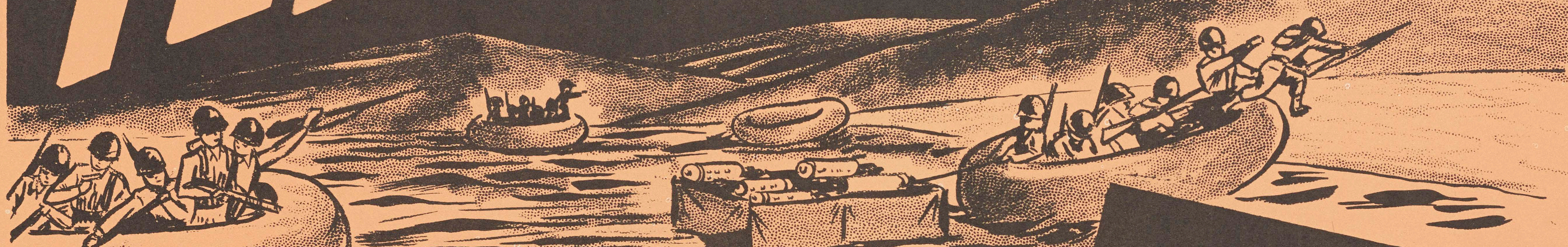


COTTON "FERRYBOAT"
