Our whittlings of mountain life. like your patience, dear reader, are drawing to a close. Not that the subject is exhausted ; for there is much to observe if a man will only keep his eyes open, but we don't want to impose longer upon your good nature : therefore, v e way of a lastly, as the preacher has it, and conclude. Do you know what hospitality means ?

do not mean horse-pitality, muleology, nor giving away a pony to bring a dollar back. Not that cool, calculating feeling which induces men to slap you on your shoulder in a friendly way, that they may steal the handkerchief out of your pocket, and the bread from your children's mouths. No, no, it is the genuine, honest care for the comfort of the weary stranger, who has neither house to shelter him, a crust to eat, nor a blanket to keep him warm. Go into the mountains poor and hungry, and you will receive lessons gratis. Go into the most distant mine-, where even the necessaries of life are obtained with difficulty, where a single meal is an item large enough to be thought of, and you will see the old leaven of home rising up in a welcome. You are invited to enter the tent, the coarse fare is freely set before you. and a bed and blanket, is divided with you. No questions are asked, if you are rich, or whether you have got a gold watch, a black dress coat and a dickey, at home. It is all the same if you come in a red shirt, an unwashed face, with your toes peeping out of the ends of your boots, like frogs. There is no aristocracy of wealth, no pride of birth. or profession among the hardy mountain freemen. If they are sometimes compelled to refuse a meal to a stranger, it is from sheer essity, because they have not got it for

themselves; and then you may see a blush mantling to their sunbarnt brows-not of shame, but to think a Lagry man must go hungry still. O, the man "may have a rough exterior, but a good, true, honest heart within." I do not doubt but there are exceptions, but in all my mountain rambles, I never was yet denied the rites of hospitality. nor the courtesies of civilized life.

Another trait in a Miner's character is a desire for locomotion. He is continually hearing of new discoveries, richer diggings somewhere else, and as he wants to be in the best place, his patience is not always satisfied with a fair compensation, and it is a common thing for men who are making good wages to pull up stakes and vamos to other localities, where it often ends in disaster. Others labor faithfully for a while until they get a handsome sum, when it begins to burn their fingers, and they act as if they wanted to get rid of it, and they generally succeed I've noticed in the course of a semewhat eventful life, that when men desired to get

gold it came slowly, and with difficulty, but when they wished to get rid of it, the slippery stuff run out as if it was greased

On one of the bars where I was at work, there were companies who were taking out there were companies who were taking out from an hundred and fifty to two hundred dollars every day for many days. At length a monte dealer came into the settlement, and opened a bank. The men had been long at work without excitement or relaxation, and work without excitement or relaxation, and they gathered around the table more from curiosity than a desire to bet. It was not long however, before some began to be interested enough to put down a dollar, then another, and another, losing and winning alternately, increasing their bets, and "keeping their spirits up, by pouring spirits down, till the excitement become so intense that they relinquished labor, and spent two or three days in gambling. When their money was gone, there was one grand spree, one glorious jollification, until nearly a week was passed, when Nature, exhausted, demanded her rights, and the men returned to their senses, but not to their work. A strange desire seemed to possess them to go to other diggings, and within a week after two-thirds of the men were gone from that bar, and some had not money enough to pay up their small debts, out of all ther earnings. This is an extreme case, but the desire to change localities is very common.

I do not know one of these men who made anything by the change, and I do know that thousands of dollars were taken out of theirclaims after they left.

Though miners are so often disappointed. they show a fortitude that is truly commendable, a disposition "To Laugh at all Sorrow when it comes." For eight or ten miles above the mouth of Nelson's creek, a large number of men were at work, with the varied success of mining. Every bar was taken up -- in many places long wing dams were built to shut/off the water from the body of the stream, and while some paid well, others were failures. When a claim failed, the company dispersed, and each one found new diggings: but with a few expletives on mining in general, and their claim in particular, it was a subject of jest.

Strolling by a deserted camp one evening. I observed the effigy of a man on the ruins of a shanty. This caricature of humanity was standing upright, rigged out in an old shirt, a very ragged pair of pants, boots which looked as if they had been climbing rocks since leather was invented, in short, the image represented a lean, worn out, meagre, woe-begone miner. On the shirt was in-

#### The Cancus Project.

The suggestions made in our article of Friday morning, in regard to the proper course to secure harmony and concert of action amongst the Democratic members of the Legislature, meets, as we supposed it would, with the disapprobation of the Whigs. If it had been otherwise, we should have mistrusted the success of the measure. The Custom House organ ridicules the idea of men submitting to "old King Caucus," and talks about legislators wearing the "collar" of party. No true Democrat, however, was ever frightened from his duty to his friends and party, by such clap-trap. meaningless exprestions.

The very fact that the Whig journals, and those who are looking to the election of a Whig U.S. Senator, oppose the caucus suggestions, shows their party weakness and furnishes still better evidence that the Democrats can elect their candidate if they choose to go into the contest upon distinct party grounds. For ourselves, we had much rather be defeated with a straight-out, avowed and recognized Democrat, than be successful with with a no-party, neither Democrat or Whig, candidate, who will vote with us to day, and against us to-morrow. Our party organization is based upon certain.political principles. and as the representatives of these principles, our candidates should stand or fall. They all have opinions upon public measures, and if in harmony with those entertained and long-cherished by the Democratic party, they are entitled to support ; but if holding contrary opinions, more in consonance with federal principles, they should seek in that quarter their countenance, and to such source look for the necessary number of votes to gratify their ambition.

California should send a Democrat to the Senate of the United States, and she has the opportunity of doing so; and the Democratic members of the Legislature owe it to themselves and to the party, to vote for no man who is not distinctly and avowedly an advocate of Republican principles. If the Whigs can succeed in preventing an organization of our friends, on the ground that the question of party should not be brought into the election of U. S. Senator, and thus distract our efforts, they will themselves all vote one way, and may, by a scattering vote or two of the / Democrats, succeed in thrusting a Whig into a position to misrepresent seven-tenths of the people of California.

But we trust they will not be successful : that the Democratic members of the Legislature will act judiciously and decidedly, and termine at an early day upon the candidate they will support : and by sacrificing personal ambition and private preferences upon the altar of the common good, such a man, whoever he may be, can be elected, and the Whig aspirants, whether native or imported, be most successfully defeated.

### San Francisco Pilots.

A bill regulating the duty of Pilots for the Bay of San Francisco, was introduced, on leave, January 22d, by Mr. CARR, of the Asembly

The bill provides that the Legislature shall appoint three resident merchants, and three resident ship-masters, who, with the harbor master, shall constitute a Board of Pilot Commissioners ; the persons so appointed shall hold their office for one year, and shall keep

an office, and appoint a Secretary, who shall keep a record of the arrival and departure of the pilot boats. The commissioners shall

have power to appoint six pilots for the port and bay of San Francisco, and the straits and bays to Benicia, but shall have no power to grant licenses to pilots for the harbor of San Francisco, nor for any of the rivers tributary to the Bay. They shall appoint none but American citizens, and only aften a strict examination as to their ability. The license shall continue for twelve months, unless on

proof of misconduct or incapacity, when the ommissioners shall have power to remove. The following fees shall be charged for pilot-

"For bringing in a vessel from or within a line of San Pedro, Farallones, and Point de los Reys, six dollars per foot draught. For bringing in beyond the above mentioned line, eight dollars per foot draught. outward pilotage, six dollars per foo For

draught. Foreign vessels not entitled to equality by treaty, one-fourth more than the above rates. American or foreign men-of-war, nine dollars

per foot, inward or outward. Pilots boarding or offering their services shall be entitled to half pilotage."

Every neglect of duty on the part of the pilots shall be punished by a fine not less than one hundred, nor more than five hundred dollars. They may also be suspended or expelled at the discretion of the commissioners. All monies so collected shall go towards defraying the expenses of the State Hospital. The pilots now holding commissions shall retain the same until the first day of May next, when this act, in the event of its pasage, shall take effect, and the "Act to establish Pilots and Pilot regulations, approved February 25th, 1850, is hereby repealed, to ake effect on and after the 15th of April. 1851," and the "Act in relation to the appointment of Pilots for the different ports and harbors of California, approved January 8th, 1850, so far as it relates to the port of San Francisco," is also repealed by the passage of this law.

#### Suit for a "Gold Medal."

### A New Party Name.
