Dear Sir:

It is with considerable reluctance that I address another Circular to the patrons of our School, in order to recall that of the 20th of November.

Upon a review of our accounts for the past Session, and an estimate for the future, based on present prices, it has become quite evident that at sixteen dollars per month for Board, Washing, &c., we must sustain a heavy loss....

With corn and wheat at four and five dollars a bushel, pork at 30 cts. a pound, and the prices of all other things in proportion, and daily rising, we are compelled to increase our charges.

It is proposed therefore to charge twenty dollars per month, for Board, Washing, &c. This will make our terms seventy-two dollars per Quarter, for Board, Washing, and General Tuition, or one hundred and twenty dollars for a Session of five months. These rates will be charged on all Quarters falling due after January 1st.

Patrons who are in the least dissatisfied with these new terms, are earnestly requested to remove their children at once.
