1. Inspection and survey was made for reconversion of the above mentioned company.

2. Under paragraph 3 the main shareholders are Yoshihiro Sugawara, Hideo Motoyama and Yoichiro Nakanura. The balance of stock is owned by small individual stockholders.

3. Under paragraph 5 date of foundation, Mr. Sugawara started this company 7 years ago individually. In 1943 additional capital was needed and the company was reorganized that time. The items manufactured prior to 1943 were exactly the same as the items they wish to convert to under paragraph 11. Under paragraph 7 individual list of machines were not listed on application. On inspection a complete list was made and is herewith attached. Under raw material the figures listed are an error and actually should read round bar steel 69 tons and steel plates 30 tons. Company claims material belongs to them and have records to prove same.

4. Under paragraph 11 the list of future production is listed and it is recommended that the application be approved and permission be granted for reconversion.
