1. Reference is made to the attached inclosure from the Board of Education, Tottori Prefecture for the use of reparations machinery in technical schools.
2. The vocational education schools are handicapped tremendously because of the lack of machinery. It is felt that the use of this machinery would be greatly beneficial in teaching and guiding Japan's future technicians in the know-how of machinery. Schools at present do not have a large enough budget to buy machinery and the machinery requested would be expensive as well as hard to acquire. The machines in question are in dead storage and the factories concerned do not have any intention of using them.
3. This headquarters recommends that subject machinery be allowed authorized use in the technical schools mentioned in the attached inclosure.
