Yonago Aerial Gunnery Range

1. The two fectangular over-water areas whose corners are located at the points indicated by the following coordinates are designated as an aerial gunnery range:

Aroa #1 133° 33' 24" East - 35° 49' 06" North 133° 35' 18" East - 35° 36' 06" North 134° 17' 48" East - 35° 39' 36" North 134° 15' 54" East - 35° 52' 36" North 131° 54' 18" East - 35° 09' 36" North 132° 06' 36" East - 35° 01' 18" North 132° 33' 24" East - 35° 28' 12" North Area #2 132° 21' 06" East - 35° 36' 30" North

- 2. Area #1 will be used during the months of August. through January. Area #2 will be used during the months of Fobruary through July.
- The inhabitants of the ports located in Yamaguchi, Shimane, Tottori and Hyogo Prefectures will be notified prior to each actual use of the range. When the range is used for poriods in excess of fifteen (15) days, warning reminders will be disseminated to the inhabitants concerned. This information will be forwarded through Military Government units to local Japanose civil authorities..
