GENERAL ORDERS, No. 15.

- I. General Orders, No. 137, series of 1863, is hereby revoked.
- II. Supplies of provisions, in transitu to arsenals, armories and ordnance depots, for the use of operatives, under the order of commanding officers of the same, will not be interfered with by officers of the departments.
- III. As the various rail roads of the Confederacy for the transportation of troops, supplies and munitions of war, are under the control of the Quartermaster's department, the orders of Commanding Generals and other officers relating to such transportation by rail road, will be immediately furnished to the Quartermaster General, in order that arrangements may be made in time to harmonize the various routes, so as to prevent accident and delays.
