Excerpt from Statement Made by Major General Konryo Sato at a Budget Committee Meeting of the 81st Session of the Imperial Diet, House of Representatives, February 19,1943.

Just as the Prime Minister had been stating proviously, there is no change in the general policy of dealing resolutely with anyone who carries on arguments which hinder the execution of the war in any way, regardless of their positions or ranks. However, as you know, recently, various informations are appearing concerning peace talks, ANGLO-GERMAN beace, SOVIET-CHRMAN peace, etc., in accordance with the changes in the world situation. I do not have the right to bring up each of these points at the present time, but when we investigate the general source from which they emanate, we find that they are due to enemy propaganda. Therefore, if there are people who believe such propaganda and repeat them, it is as if they are doublecrossing not only the soldiers on the front line, but also the people in the production front at home. They will be resolutely dealt with.
