Since Mar. 1936, possessed of 4 factories and 1,546 sets of Wide Cloth Weaving Machineries.

In 1943, in accordance with the Enterprises Adjusting Ordinance, submitted 1,006 sets of Machineries and 3 factories (one of which was ordered to be sold to Kansai Seikan Yugenkaisha).

At present: engaging in Cotton Cloth weaving for Export with the only available factory (Taki Factory) equipped with 540 machineries and other equipments.

Remarks: Machineries (belonging to Kansai Seikan, and installed in the above building, viz:- Lathe 8: Drilling Machine 1: Planer 1: Slotter 1: Milling Machine 1) have now been removed to a building as indicated in the attached sketch.

3. Reason for Application:

Since the termination of the war, we have acquired allotment of 24,360 Pcs - 439.75 Bales Cotton Cloth Production against import of American Raw Cotton, and the above mentioned Taki Plant has not enough capacity to fulfil the allotment within the time named, having actual workable machineries of 380 sets (as we had to dissolve 160 sets, out of the total 540 sets, and store away in order to install 2 Starch Slushers in their spaces).

We have, therefore, asked Kansai Seikan to let us have the use of a part of their factory (as this factory was our former main factory and was built as a Starch Preparing Factory) and they have agreed to our proposal and the contract of lease have been made between us. (as per copy attached).

When we have nearly completed the removal and installation of 2 Starch Slushers to this factory, Kansai Seikan was designated as O. D. 5 Plant on 21st Aug., 1948, and, consequently, we are now obliged to give up our plant unless we are given permission for the use by the kind consideration of the authorities of the Military Government.

4. Report on our Status:

a. Employment at present: Male Workers 54.

b. Quantity allotted to us for Export Purpose:

24,360 Pcs - 439.75 Bales Cotton Cloth.

c. Planned for the present and future:

160 Weaving Machineries, which had been stored in our Taki Factory, are now being installed.

Starch Slushers have been removed to the said Kansai Seikan's factory, and nearly completed installation.

We are negotiating to purchase some idle factories to expand our capacity, as our second plan.

C O N T R A C T .

This contract is made this day between Kansai Seikan Yugenkaisha, Lessor, and Minami Orimono Kabushiki Kaisha, Lessee, concerning the object described in the attached sheet, under terms and conditions as herein stated.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS.

1. The lessor hereby agree to let the lessee use the object on lease.
2. The term of lease shall be 10 years, subject to special circumstances arise in the management of the Lessee.
3. The lessee shall use the object with good-will during the said term, and return the object, in the state as at the time of contract made, when the term expires.
4. The lessee shall pay ¥4,440.- per year, as rent, to the lessor, payable partically half the amount at the end of June and December respectively every year.
Tax, fire insurance premiums and other public levy concerning the object shall be paid by the lessor.
5. Repairing expenses for the building during the said term shall be paid by the lessee.
6. Rent shall be started payment from the time when the lessee's producing operation commenced.

1. In accordance with the provisions of paragraphs 3a and 3b of Directive No. 3 from the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, dated 22 September 1945; memorandum for the Imperial Japanese Government, Subject: Reconversion of War Production Plants to Peacetime Production, dated 28 October 1945; and under authority granted this Headquarters by Cincapac Radio Zax 6197 dated 3 October 1945, you are authorized to commence operation of your plant, and to manufacture the essential civilian commodities listed in Annex No. 1 to this permit.

2. This permit grants authority only to operate. The acquisition of materials, parts and sub-assemblies, as well as the disposition of finished products and establishment of sales prices, will be in accord with the regulations of the Imperial Japanese Government.

3. At the end of the first month of operation, and at the end of each three-month period thereafter, until notified to the contrary by this Headquarters a report will be made to the Commanding General I Corps, Headquarters Osaka, attention: Military Government Section. This report will be written in English and will list each item, by name, type and quantity produced by each factory, subsidiary, or sub-contractor operating under the provisions of this permit. This report will be delivered to Corps Headquarters not later than fifteen (15) days after the conclusion of the period to which the report pertains.

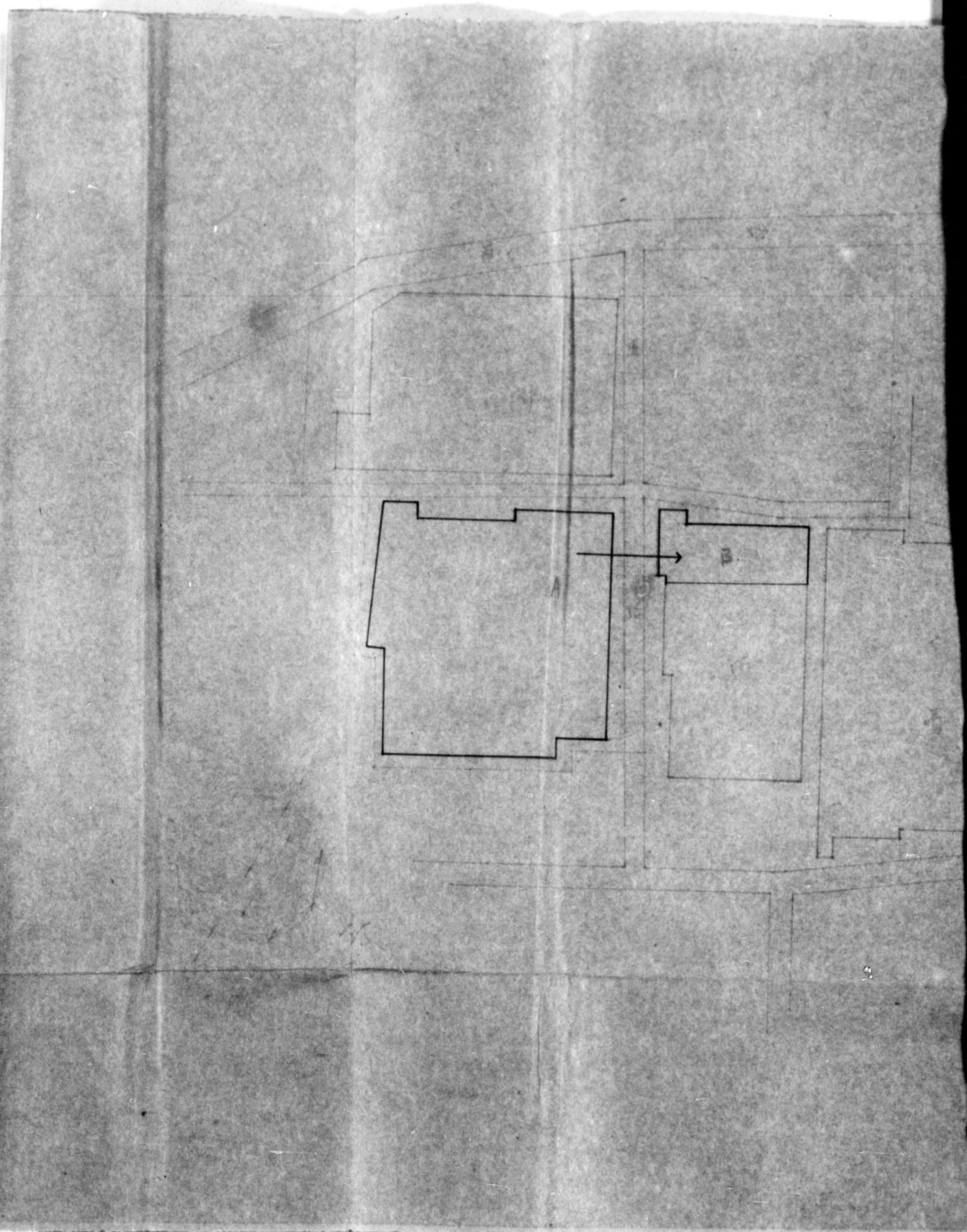

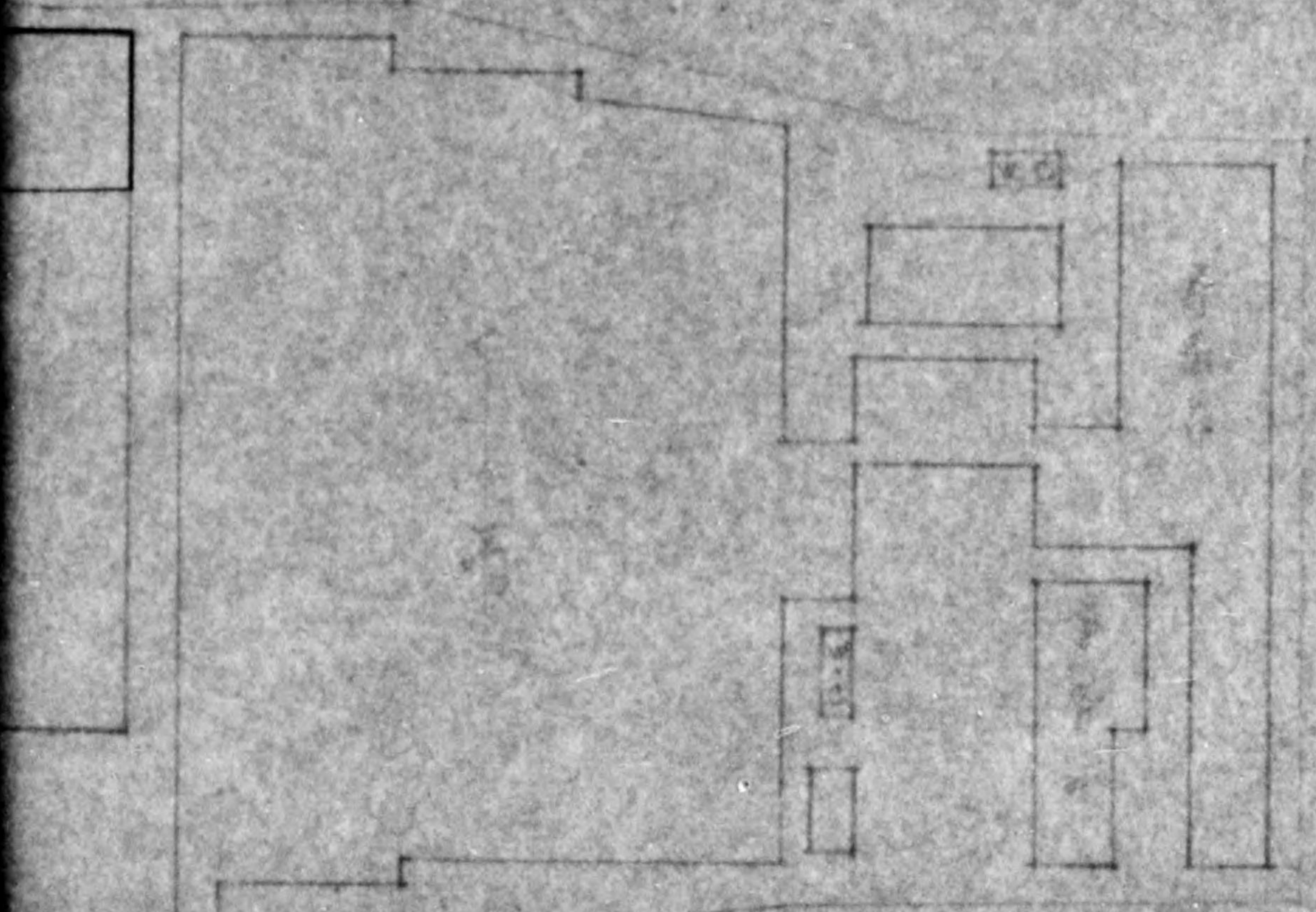

a. Vehicle Training Ground of Ex-Tank, 19 Regiment, Kawai-mura, Kato-gun (Incl 8): This installation comprises a portion of Aonogahara Maneuver Area, currently in use by the 27th Infantry as a tactical training area, and under consideration for similar uses by 25th Infantry Division. Retention is desired.
