

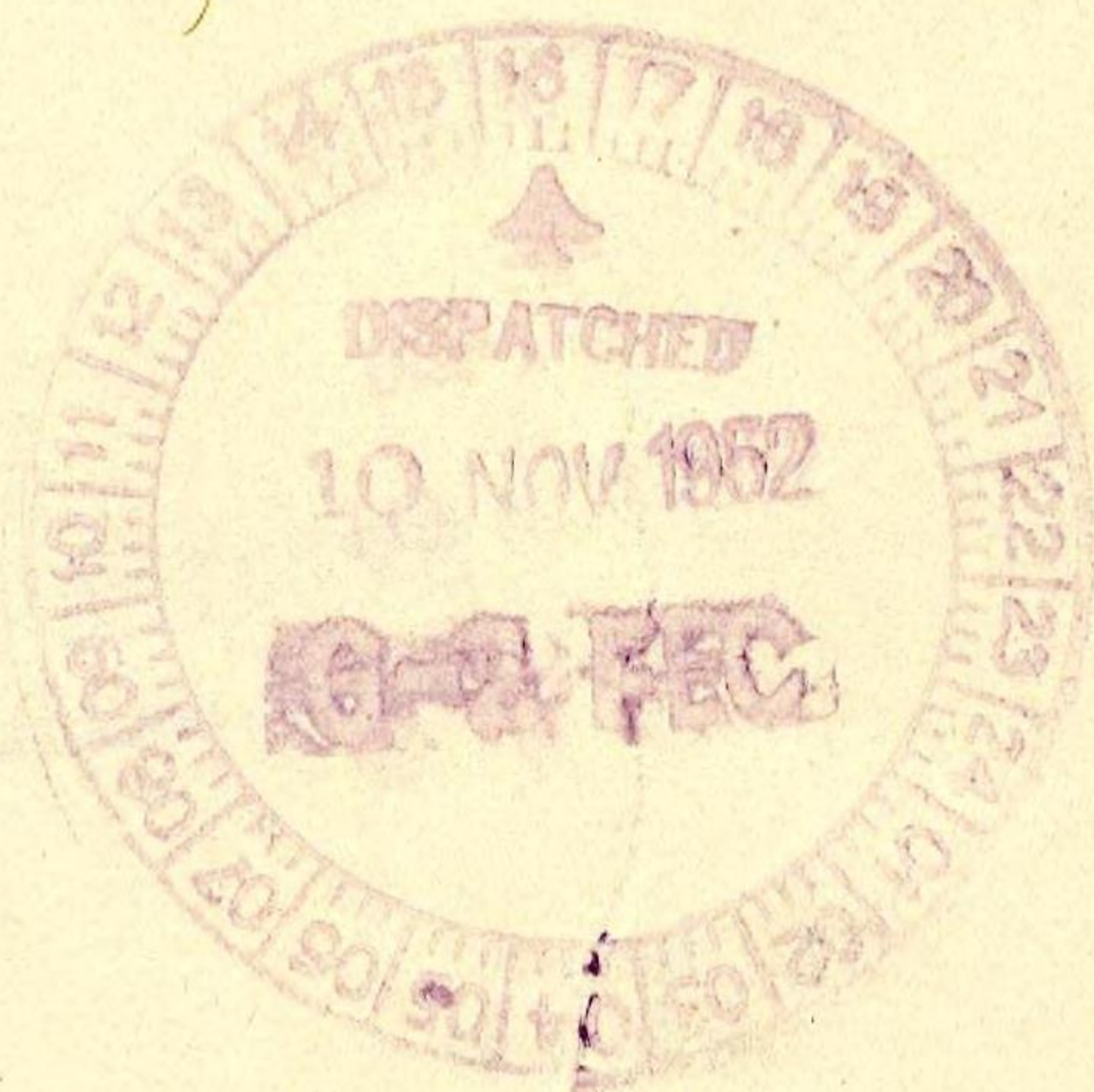
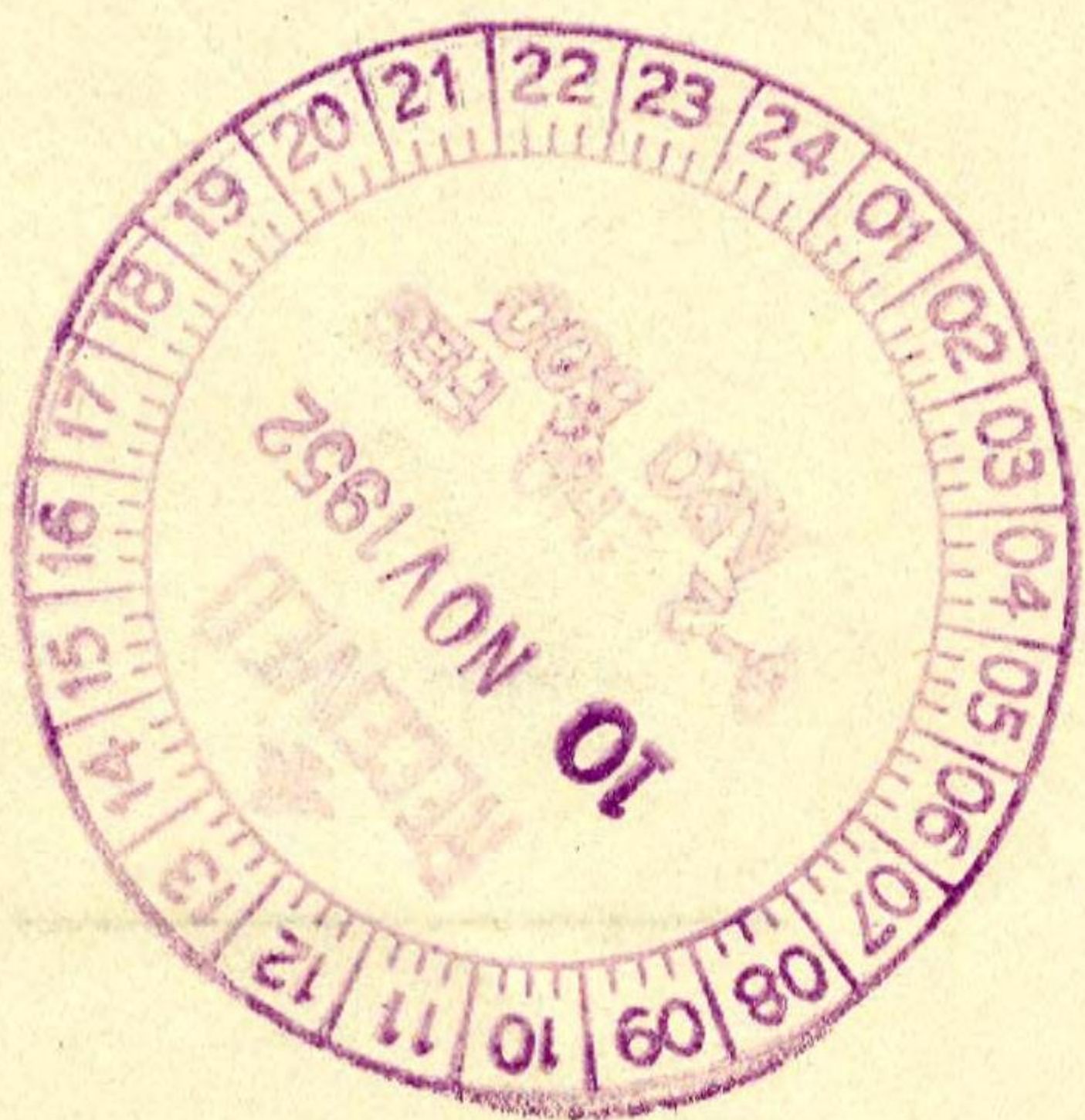

1. Reference is made to your letter of 20 September 1952, in which certain information regarding the Chinese Communist 46th Army was forwarded to this Headquarters.

2. The following comments are furnished regarding the Communist 46th Army.

a. The disposition of the 46th Army has not been reliably reported since July 1952. A few reports, as yet unsubstantiated, have pointed to the movement of this army from South China subsequent to July. Far East Command considers it possible that a portion of the 46th Army has moved towards Manchuria/Korea; however, as yet it cannot be determined how large a portion may be involved. Attention is invited to the fact that troops from the 46th Army have appeared in Korea as replacements; however, no component as such of the army has been accepted in Korea.

b. The unidentified army referred to as moving from the Huiyang region could be the 41st which was reported to have moved towards Luichou Peninsula prior to mid-1952. This Headquarters considers it possible that only detachments of the army were involved in the movement towards Luichou Peninsula and that a portion of the army may have moved towards Manchuria or Korea.

3. It is hoped that the information contained in paragraph 2 above will be of benefit to you. This Headquarters is vitally and intensely concerned with any and all activities of the CCF. Far East Command would be greatly appreciative if the excellent information you have been furnishing in the past would continue to be made available to this Headquarters, as well as Washington, through your channels there and/or ours in Formosa.

4. This information is furnished with the understanding that it will not be released to any other nation without specific approval of the United

It has been the prevailing view in DA G2 that the Chinese Communist People's Revolutionary Military Council (PRMC) is a policy-making body comprised of top military and political figures (plus a few so-called "democratic personages" for window dressing). On the other hand, it has been accepted that the People's Liberation Army (PLA) Hq is the top command and administrative organ charges with responsibility for execution of the policies promulgated by the PRMC. Are these views correct? If not, what is the specific relationship between the PRMC and the PLA HQ?

2. It has been noted here that the New China News Agency (NCNA) press and radio releases identify HSU Hsiang-chien as "Chief of the General Staff of the PRMC", NIEH Jung-chen as "Acting Chief of the General Staff of the PRMC", SU Yu as "Vice Chief of Staff of the PRMC", etc.. These men are also listed as "members" of the PRMC. If the views indicated in para 1, above, are correct, it would seem that HSU, NIEH, and SU would hold the above titled positions in the PLA rather than in the PRMC which appears to have only a Chairman, several Vice-Chairmen, and list of members. Do you have any information which would explain the identification of these positions with the PRMC rather than with the PLA? In other words, why is NIEH referred to as "Acting Chief of the General Staff of the PRMC" rather than "Acting Chief of the General Staff of the PLA"?

Request information relative to the organization of PLA G2 or equivalent (as distinct from Party or political intelligence organs) with names of key personnel, functions of the various sections within the PLA G2 organization, and the relationship between this organization and other intelligence organizations of the Central People's Government and the Chinese Communist Party.

a. Far East Air Forces reports the presence of approximately 350 medium and/or heavy antiaircraft guns in North Korea as determined by aerial photo interpretation. In addition to these guns, which are found principally on the west coast and along rail lines, there is an unknown number of guns on the east coast. These last guns are also determined by aerial photography, but there has been no report of the actual number of guns found in this area.

b. The Table of Organization and Equipment of units presently accepted in Korea in no way reflects the number of known weapons. An attempt to assign nationalities to the crews of these guns has proved impractical since there is little data on record in this headquarters.

c. This Specific Request for Information develops Intelligence Requirements Nos. E-3 and E-54 of Intelligence Collection Directive No. 1, dated 21 March 1952.

2. Specific Request:

a. The addressees are requested to furnish, from data in their possession, any information relative to the disposition, strength, identification, nationality and equipment of antiaircraft artillery units in Korea subsequent to 1 April 1952.

b. In addition to the above, Far East Air Forces is requested to furnish the known current locations of medium and/or heavy antiaircraft positions - stating the number and caliber of the guns - by six digit coordinates, as determined from the interpretation of aerial photographs or by other suitably precise means.

3. Special Instructions:

a. This is a Priority III B request.

b. This is not a continuing requirement. Initial report is desired by 10 November 1952. Final report should be forwarded so as to reach this headquarters not later than 20 November 1952.

c. It is requested that information be forwarded as obtained to this headquarters (ATTN: Estimates Branch, Intelligence Division, G2).
