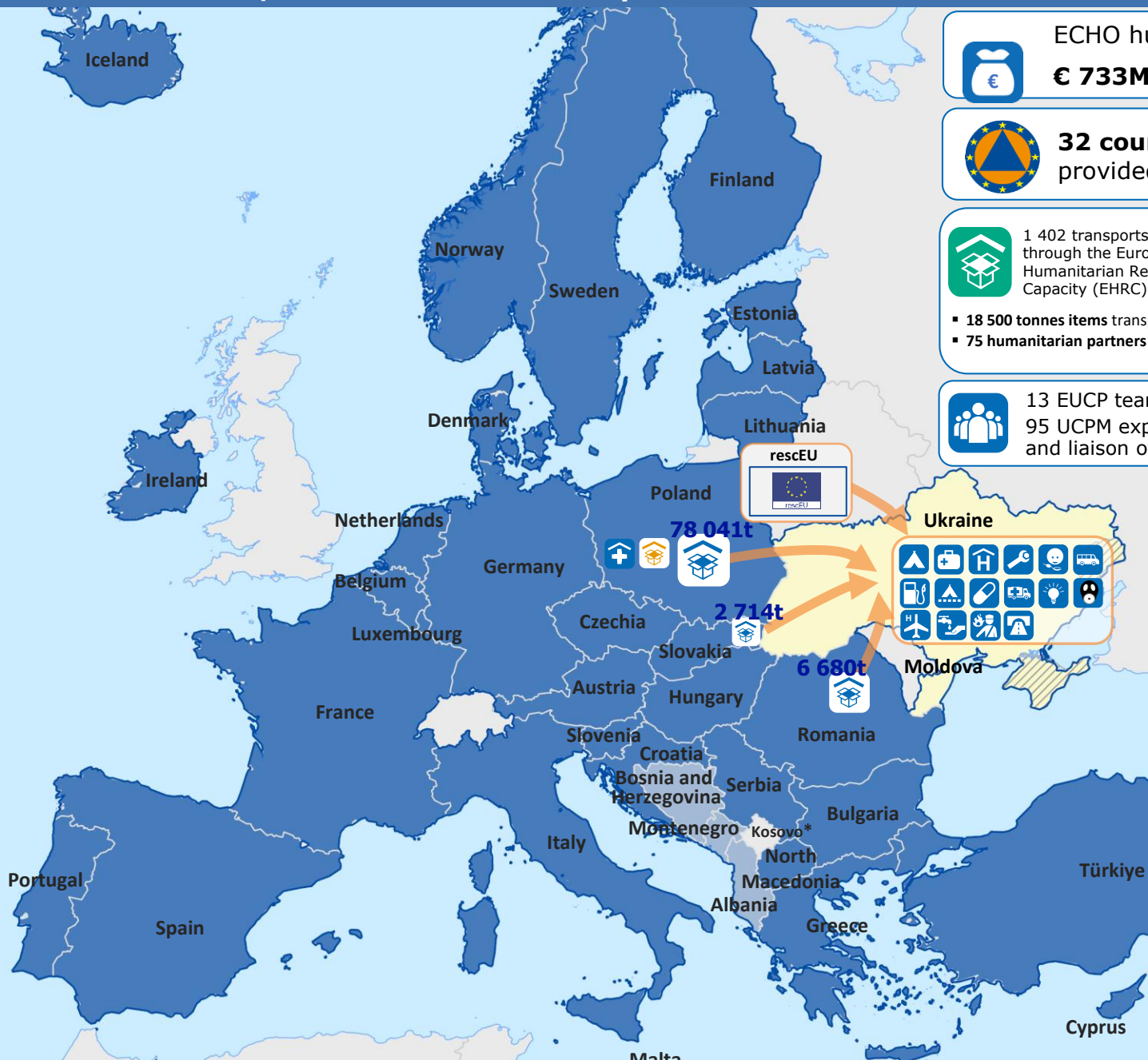


Russia's war on Ukraine | EU Civil Protection Response and Humanitarian Aid to Ukraine



ECHO humanitarian aid:
€ 733M (of which € 48M for Moldova)

32 countries (all 27 MS and 5 PS) provided civil protection assistance

1 402 transports executed through the European Humanitarian Response Capacity (EHRC)

- 18 500 tonnes items transported
- 75 humanitarian partners supported

€647M assistance value

89 800 tonnes delivered

2 208 MEDEVAC completed operations
