JIMMY LONGO that she had been visited recently by two Agents of the FBI and indicated that apparently the FBI Agents were hoping to get Mrs. LAZZARA's cooperation against SANTO TRAFFICANTE. Informant remarked that Mrs. LAZZARA had indicated that it had been her duty to contact LONGO and that LONGO had told Mrs. LAZZARA that he and SANTO would soon visit her and in the meantime, she was to tell the FBI Agents to go to hell.

Informant remarked that Mrs. LAZZARA feels that SANTO TRAFFICANTE would have to pay her something to keep her quiet and that apparently after talking with LONGO, Mrs. LAZZARA had contacted JOE MARCELLO concerning her visit from the FBI.
