A short reminder

The mission of GLAM institutions is to grant basic human rights

Access to culture & knowledge

Access to information

And of course this generates tensions with copyright holders

Separation between "huge" GLAM

- Huge collection
 - Huge budget
 - Huge staff

But normally, in our countries most GLAM institutions don't gather not even two of those conditions

Medium and small GLAM

They have the collections, but don't have the budget or the staff to accomplish new tasks

So normally, they can't follow up with what huge GLAM institutions do

GLAM institutions are asked to do more with less
