

Parker 19250753 PSD, CIS, GHQ, FEC, APO 500 I and five of my buddies from PSD were going home to lunch yesterday, as usual. We caught a bus over in front of the Dai Ichi Building to go to the N.Y.K. Building. When we approached the N.Y.K. Building to get off we buzzed for a stop. The buzzer was buzzed two or three times. The driver thought this more than essential and when he stopped he would allow no one to get off. He asked us for our names and we laughed about it. We returned to our seats. Finally after persuasion he let two passengers off. One of the passengers was Miss Lois Pinchard, a DAC who works in an office close to mine. After a while he turned the bus around and drove us to the Provost Marshal's office. He called the M.P. on duty in front of the Provost Marshal's office over to the bus and told him that he had some fellows on the bus that had tried to make a "monkey" of him, and asked him if he would get our names for him. The M.P. boarded the bus and took our names. The M.P. asked the driver for his driving permit. We got his name from that. The driver, Larry Sakoki, then let us off. We think that he was trying to hold us under arrest on a bus, not letting us off at our destination, and taking us in the opposite direction of our destination. Pvt. Merton L. Parker 19250753
