It is considered that the functions of the proposed agencies will be of primary interest to the RI and not to CINCPAC. Within GHO, all General Staff Sections have some interest, with G-1 having the immediate interest, of accepting and accommodating the individuals concerned.

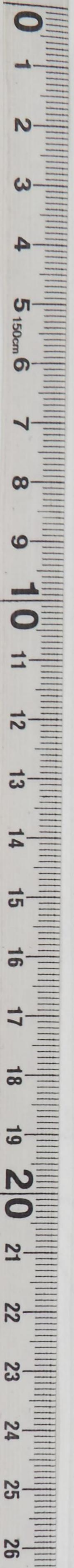
4. If it is desired, G-4 can accept the GHO responsibility for processing reports to Washington with no augmentation at this time. If assigned this responsibility, G-4 propose to make a preliminary review of submitted actions and to refer to appropriate GHO staff agencies. After consultation of G-4 will review to see if of sufficient interest to advise G-4 will forward direct to AG for interest to G-4.



5. G-1 make arrangements as required for reception of personnel concerned.

6. Staff responsibility on CINCPAC interest in Research and Development be assigned.

The JCS have approved, subject to your concurrence, a recommendation by General Hull, Director of the Weapons Systems Evaluation Group, to dispatch to your hq a small number of scientists with operations research experience on military weapons. The purpose of such a mission is to capitalize to the maximum on the opportunity to obtain data on the effectiveness and adequacy of our present weapons and weapons systems under actual combat conditions. The Weapons Systems Evaluation Group is charged by the JCS with the mission of evaluating our weapons and weapons systems with the view not only of determining their effectiveness but to recommend where applicable the trend that research and development should take to correct deficiencies found to exist. In peacetime the only way to judge the effectiveness of our various weapons and weapons systems is through historical and theoretical analysis combined with experience gained through maneuvers and field exercises. Most decisions concerning research and development with the view to obtaining improved or new weapons therefore are based necessarily on theoretical analysis. Under the conditions now existing in the Far East, it is possible to obtain accurate data under combat conditions. These data should be of great value in studies currently underway in the group and may well suggest vital new problems for emergency solution. The Research and Development Board as well as the JCS look to the Weapons Systems Evaluation Group for advice on such matters.

The Weapons Systems Evaluation Group has requested authority to send Dr Edward L Bowles to your hq to establish this agency and to be in charge of it initially. During World War II Dr Bowles was Senior Scientific Advisor to the Secretary of War in

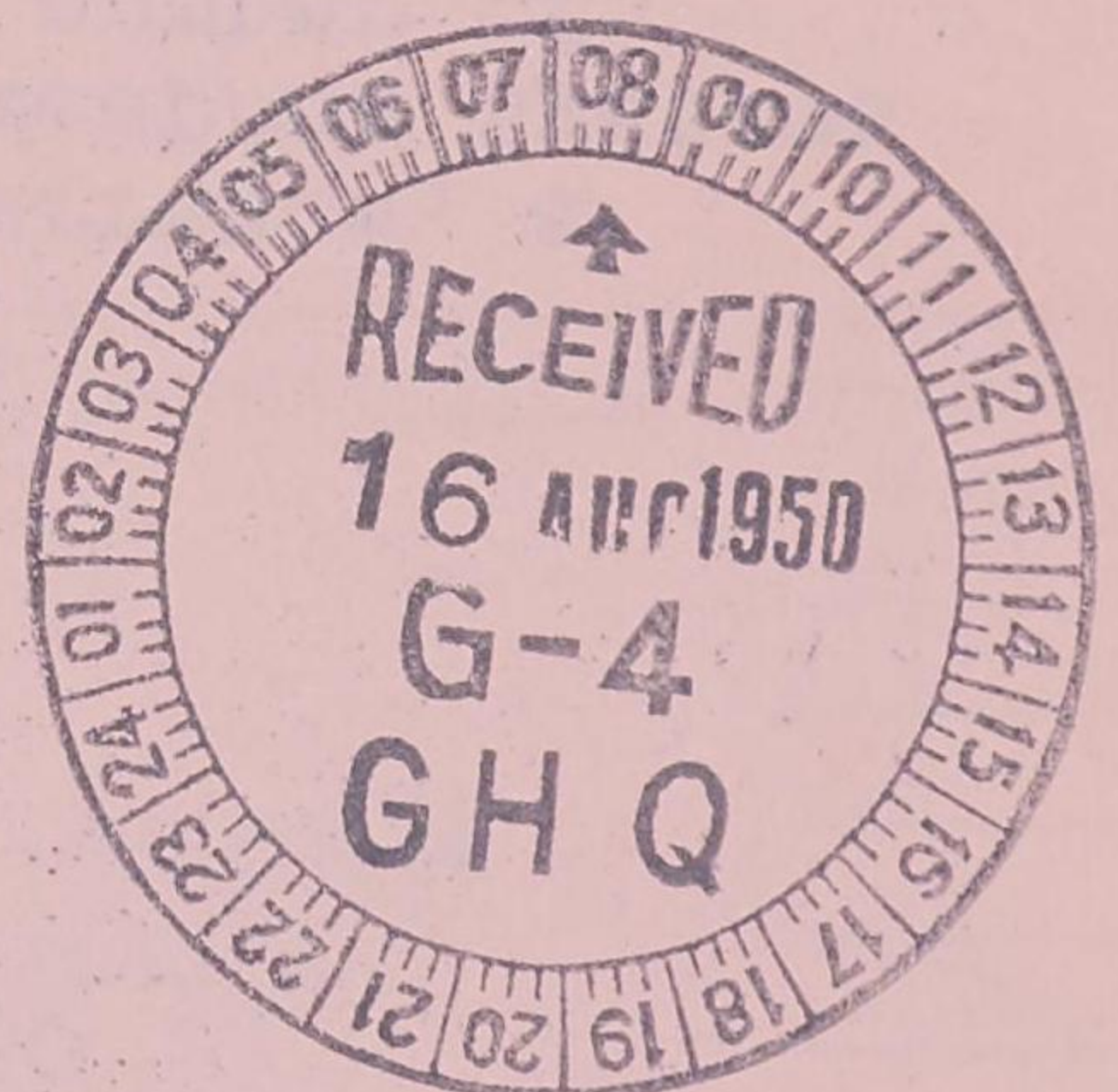

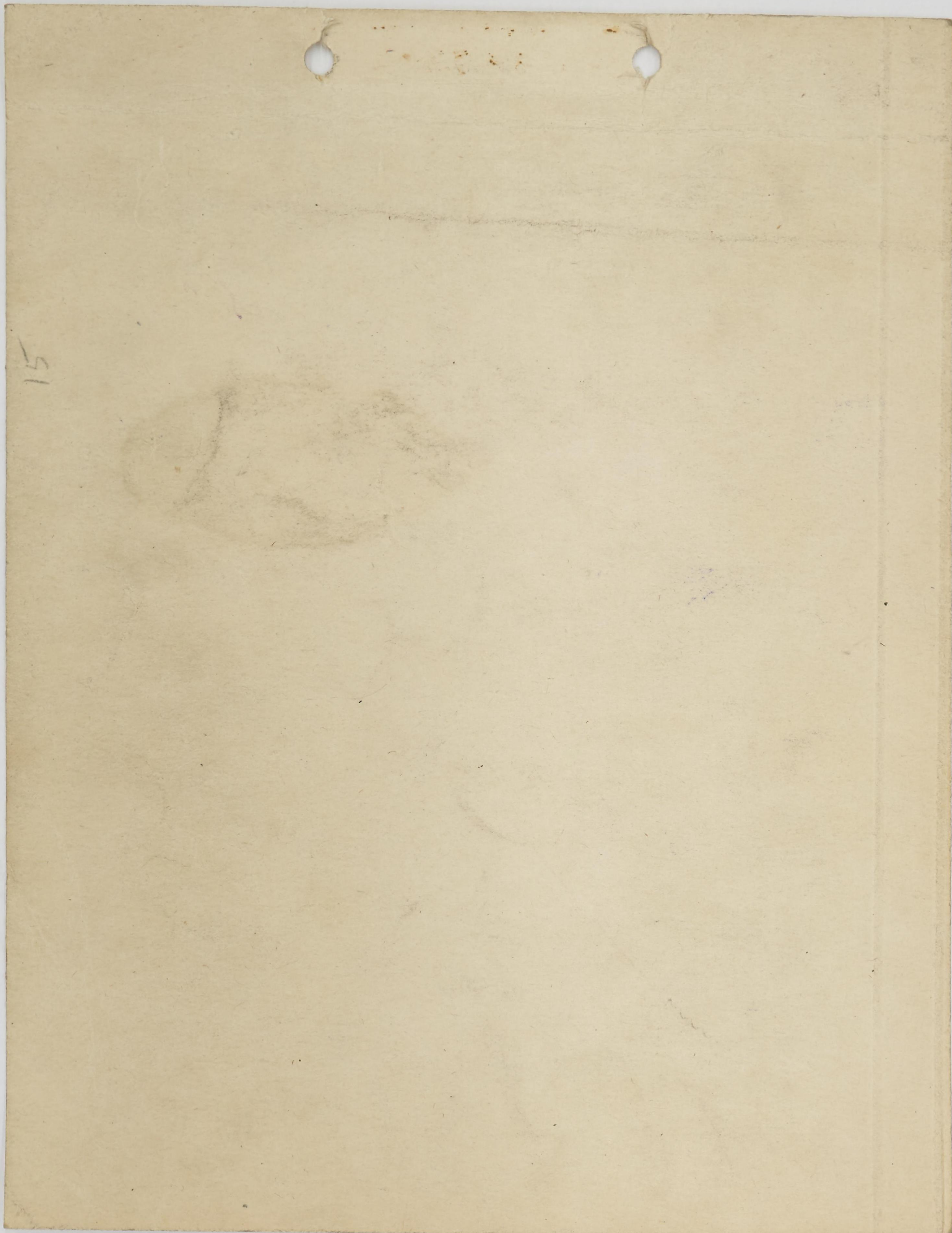
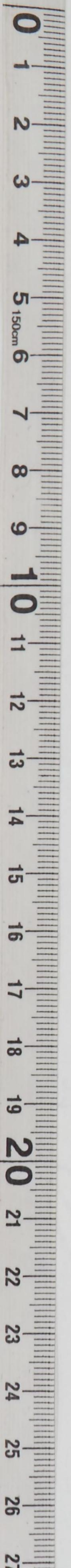
