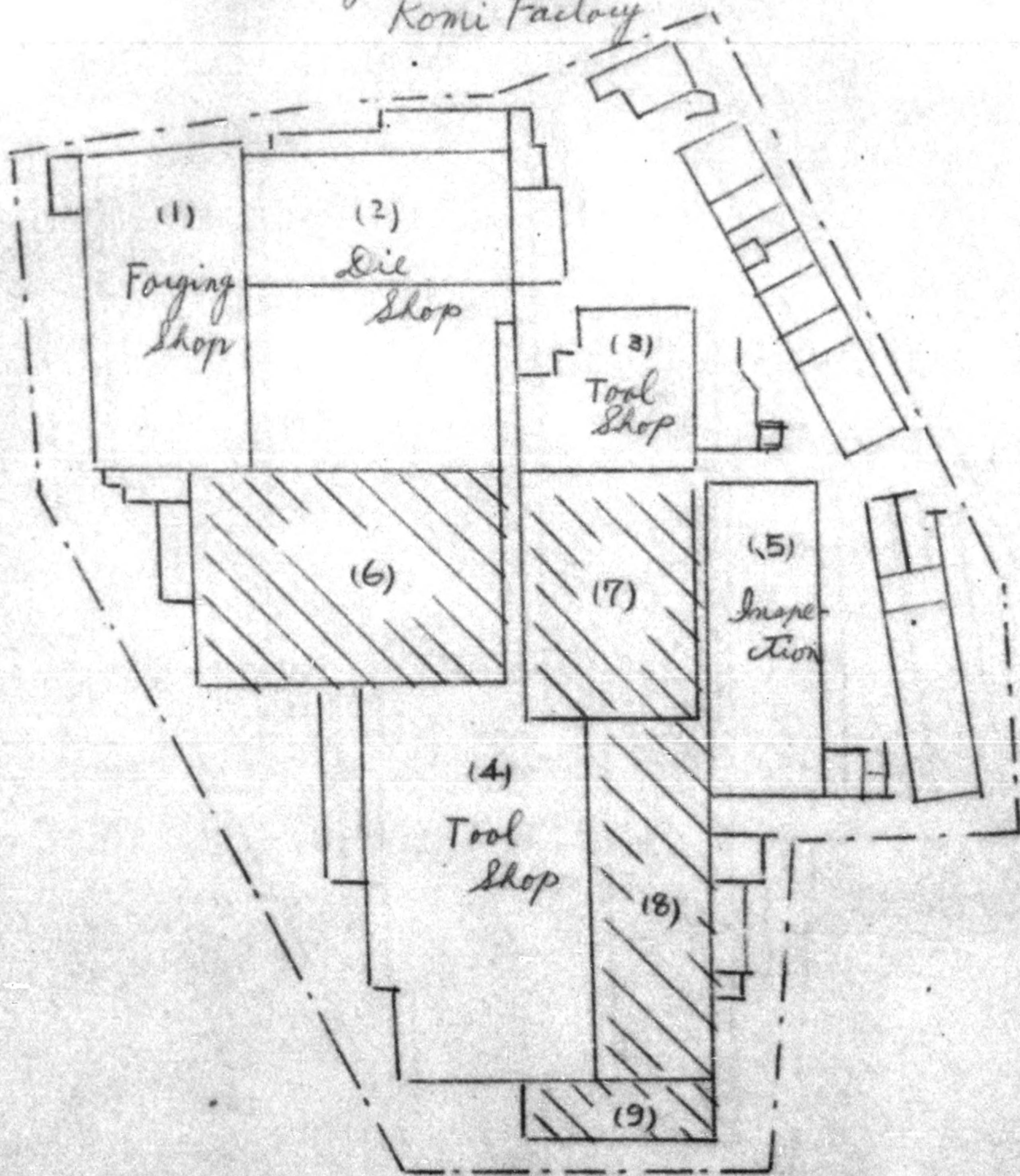

J. Reasons for retention:

1. The subject plant was built by the Okatoku Textile Company in 1921 originally for textile production.

2. In view of the fact that the shortage of tools and dies had been becoming prominent at that time, we leased the plant in 1944 from the owner with the purpose of tool and die production.

3. Because of the limited plant area, the factory had been readjusted and operated gradually as a part of the tool shop of Works No.3.

4. As to the products manufactured during the war, tools and dies had been forged, machined, and finished here. Because of the fact that the forging machinery and equipment were available, the emergency forging of aircraft parts had been done sometimes in this factory. In this factory only forging process was carried on those parts and its unfinished forgings been sent to the main plant to be machined. It amounted average 9-10% of whole production of the Komi Factory.

5. The war has terminated on the way of readjustment of the factory that is about 2/3 of the plant was being used at the time the war ended and the installation of machinery and equipments was not completed.

6. After the conclusion of war, the application for reconversion into peacetime production has been granted by U. S. Army and at present time we are engaging in the production permitted.

7. With the fact stated above we sincerely request that the Komi Factory be exempted from the reparation list.



Writer, employee of MITSUBISHI JUKOGYO K.K., KOMI KOJO (THE MITSUBISHI  
 HEAVY INDUSTRY CO., LTD., KOMI FACTORY), states:

"This factory is now manufacturing 3 horse-powered rice-husk chafing machines which are being tested at AICHI-KEN NOJI SHIKENJO (THE AGRICULTURAL EXPERIMENTAL STATION IN AICHI PREF.) and will be sold to the public in the near future. It is receiving vast orders of the machines from those within and without this prefecture because of its excellence. The price is ¥8-9,000 each. Only less than ten factories throughout the country are manufacturing this, as it is very difficult to manufacture.

This factory is also manufacturing platform scales, auto-tricycles, freezing machines, pumps and tools. The production of bicycles is not permitted by the Occupation Forces yet."

With regard to the application of Komi Factory, the Japanese Liaison Office, Nagoya, wishes to submit to the 30th military Government the following statement supplied by the Aichi Prefectural Government.

It is much appreciated if the permission for operation be given to Komi Factory in manufacturing the following additional items.

## 1. Carpenter Tools (Saw, Drill &amp; Wrench)

The reconstruction of houses on the damaged area and the production of its furnitures should be considered urgently for the stability of the civilian life, but the current shortage of the carpenter tools is very severe. In fact, there is no suitable maker of carpenter saw and square drill in Aichi Prefecture. Because of this fact the Prefectural Government has designated the Komi Factory as the special makers of these tools, expecting about one-third of the demand would be met.

## 2. Repair of Motor Vehicles

The problem of transportation is one of the major obstacles of economic stability. In Chita-gun, the chief agricultural country in this district where the Komi Factory is located, there is no repairing place at the present time. In accordance with the strong demand of the neighborhood, the Prefectural Government requested to the said plant to open repairing service of motor vehicles.
