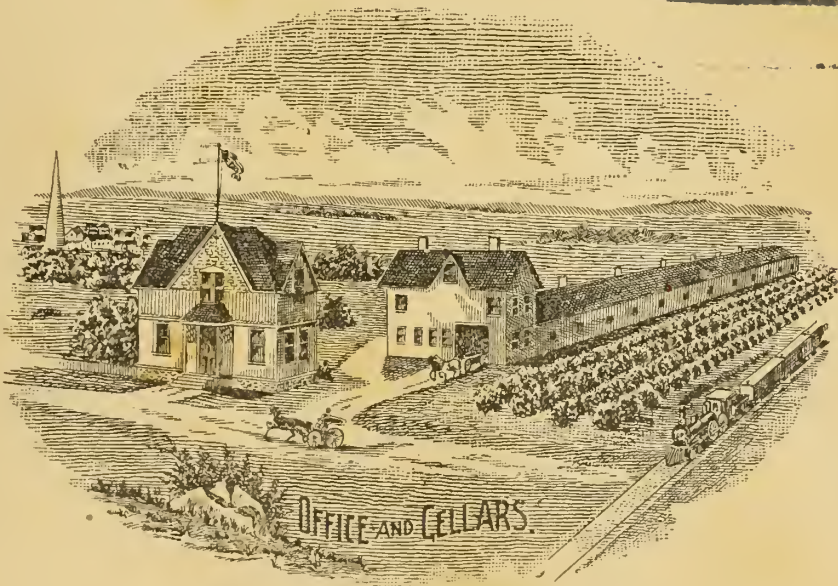

Location—Our office and cellars are located a few rods south of the Nickel Plate Depot, in Portland, $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile from Brocton, the junction of the L. S. & M. S., and W. N. Y. & P. Rail Roads, giving us unexcelled shipping facilities to all points.

It is a conceded fact that the natural advantages of our soil and climate enable us to produce better vines than can be produced in any other section, and twelve years of successful business has developed for us a large and rapidly increasing trade reaching into every State and Territory in the Union.

Our Stock, owing to the unfavorable weather of last spring, will not equal in quantity that grown by us last season, but in quality we guarantee it equal to any we have ever grown.

Shipping Directions should accompany all orders. Where none are given, we use our best judgment, but assume no responsibility. We reserve the right to fill orders for 1 year vines with 2 year vines of same size, unless instructed to the contrary.

Storage. Our vines and small fruit plants, with the exception of Raspberries and Strawberries, are all stored in cellars and can be shipped at any time when wanted, and with the addition of the mammoth new cellar constructed the past season our facilities for handling all business entrusted to us are unexcelled by any firm in the United States.

Personal Inspection. Where it is practicable we invite personal inspection of our stock from all intending purchasers.

We warrant our plants and vines true to name with the understanding and agreement that should any not prove so we will replace free of charge or refund the money paid for them.

Our Packing is done with moss and in the most thorough manner so as to insure safe carriage for long distances. No charges for boxes or packing.

Samples—We invite all intending purchasers to send for sample vines which we mail at hundred rates with 3 cents added for postage on each 2-yr vine and 2 cents on each 1-yr. vine.

Terms Cash. To dealers of known responsibility or furnishing satisfactory reference we will make spring bills payable May 15.

Remit by P. O. Order on Portland, or by Check or Draft on New York. Do not send private check where amount is less than \$15.00.
