

Shipping Directions should accompany all orders. Where none are given, we use our best judgment, but assume no responsibility. We reserve the right to fill orders for 1 year vines with 2 year vines of same size, unless instructed to the contrary.

Storage. Our vines and small fruit plants, with the exception of Rasp-berries and Strawberries, are all stored in cellars and can be shipped at any time when wanted, and with the addition of the mammoth new cellar constructed the past season our facilities for handling all business entrusted to us are unexcelled by any firm in the United States.

Personal Inspection. Where it is practicable we invite personal inspection of our stock from all intending purchasers.

We warrant our plants and vines true to name with the understanding and agreement that should any not prove so we will replace free of charge or refund the money paid for them.

Our Packing is done with moss and in the most thorough manner so as to insure safe carriage for long distances. No charges for boxes or packing.

Samples—We invite all intending purchasers to send for sample vines which we mail at hundred rates with 3 cents added for postage on each 2-yr vine and 2 cents on each 1-yr. vine.
