The citizens of floud County, Illinois, have memorialized the Legislature of that State to repudiate her public debt, which is not far from 13 millions. The ground assumed is, in the first place, that they cannot pay either principal or interest, for want of the ability to do so; and secondly, that they are not constitutionally bound to pay, the Legislature having acted rashly and without authority in creating the debt.

B_r The bad debts due to the Bank of the State of Abdana and its branches, are officially reported by a committee of the Legislature to amount to the very enormous snar of \$5,640,761 59? This Hank belongs to the State, and has been governed by officers elected by the legislature, because of their devotion to that party. The loss will, of course, be suffered by the State.
